 - (c) His work has been very well done. He is normally the Manager of the largest Allied-owned business in Piemonte, the Michelin Co., His presence makes it possible for him to assist Military Authorities and others in connection with the badly needed production at Michelin.

Dear Admiral Stone

I have delayed answering your wire 1368 of 7 July re Liaison officer until I had had a talk with Col. Fiske.

We discussed the matter this morning and we are both of the opinion that a Liaison officer attached either to my HQ or to Fiske's is essential.

As you probably know, my HQ are at MONZA 12 miles from MILAN. There is a danger of loss of contact between us unless I am kept fully informed of developments on the Military Government side, and similarly if Fiske is not kept informed of what the military are doing.

Fiske recommends Lt Col Hamilton now at MUCCA for the post. I know Hamilton and I think he would be most suitable. Fiske is writing to you asking if Hamilton can be appointed and I hope you can see your way to do this.

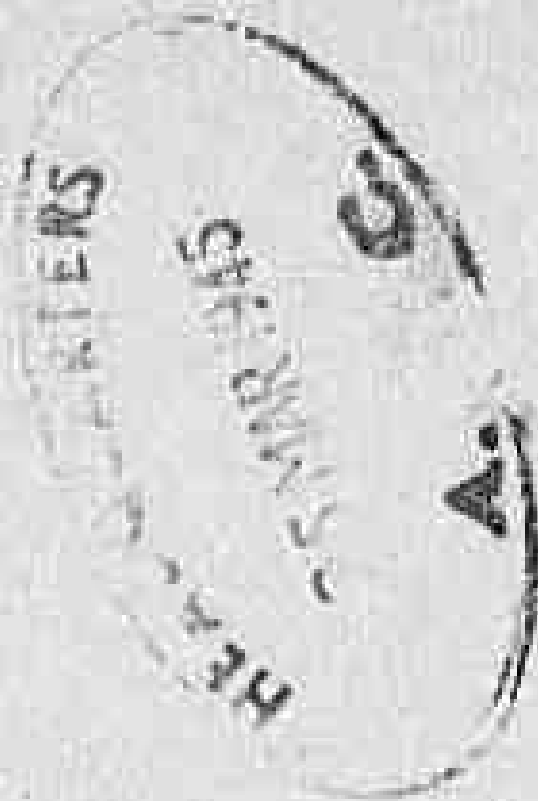

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Print plainly or type. DO NOT WRITE.
2. Prepare form in DUPLICATE.
3. Request for Orders involving travel on temporary duty status only, shall be forwarded direct to the Adjutant, Hq AC.*
4. Requests for Orders involving travel on a permanent change of station shall be forwarded to the Adjutant, Hq AC, through G-1 ("A" or "B" depending on nationality).
5. Copy to Dispatch Office is only required in the case of motor transportation.
6. Requests will be forwarded at least 48 hours prior to the date of departure. Orders are closed at 1530 hours each day. All requests received after this time will be published the following day.
7. Travel performed under the provisions of para 2, Estab. Memo #4, dated 19 Feb 44, does not require travel orders. However, if travel into hazardous area is contemplated, orders should be secured.
8. It will be the responsibility of the officer or personnel concerned to insure that travel arrangements are made with Dispatch Office before or after publication or orders.
9. Full particulars must be submitted. Failure to include necessary and pertinent information will be cause for return to originating office.
10. In order to insure efficient handling of order request, it is requested that special care be given to the correct spelling of names, ranks, serial numbers and branch of service.
11. In indicating assignments or attachments of personnel, (e.g. Public Works, Finance, etc.), be sure to include parent unit, i.e., Headquarters AC, or the various Regional Headquarters.
12. If rations are required for proposed journey, be sure to indicate, under item 5, number of persons for whom rations will be required and approximate number of days for which rations will be drawn. (e.g. Rations required for 2 men for 5 days.
