Para 1. Estimates of monthly requirements for Finance Department Officers by Mos only for the months of December 45 through June 46. Requirements will exclude replacements for those officers who volunteer for the duration of 30 June 1947 (Class "A" Volunteers) and regular Army Officers who agree to remain in key position for any period of time.
Para 2. Complete inventory of Officers having Mos 6201 or previous disbursing experience in the following categories :

(a) Regular Army. (b) Volunteers. (c) Officers having adjusted service rating score 72 or over 51 months service. (d) Officers having adjusted service rating score 72 and under by point score in 1 point intervals down to 60 and in 10 point intervals thereafter within length of service groupings of 3 months each beginning with the Group between 51 and 48 months, then between 48 and 45 months, etcetera, down to 24 months, and then final grouping of under 24 months. Unknown adjusted service rating scores and unknown length of service are to be shown in separate groups. Para availability of Finance Department Officers critically limited. Desire that estimate be reduced to minimum and that inventory be complete. Every effort must be made to encourage Finance Officers to remain on their assignments for limited periods after becoming eligible for separation to relieve critical situation.
