Dear Sir:-

When I applied in Washington for permission to come to Italy, I was told that my request had to await the decision of the Joint Chiefs of Staff in the Theater. Mr. Dorsey, of the Liberated Areas Section of the State Department explained that the delay and difficulties involved were mainly due to the conditions prevailing in Italy where food and lodging are not available without assistance from the Army. I gathered from the above that if and when such Military Permit would be granted, there would be extended the minimum privileges necessary to discharge an assignment of this nature, until normal facilities become available in the open market.

The purpose of my visit to Italy is to help restore and coordinate the manufacturing facilities of Corn Products Refining Co. of New York, which are used for the processing of foods, agricultural products and ingredients essential to the textile industry, all of which are necessary to the economic life of Italy.

New pay legislation effecting United States citizens employed in foreign countries is subject and applicable to all American civilian employees this theatre paid on per annum basis. For increasing basic salary rates for positions effected by this act follows this formula

Pay tables will be forwarded upon receipt, 20% of the first 1200 dollars per annum, 10% of the next 3400 dollars per annum, 5% of the remainder. Percentage rate of increase should not be applied on any existing allowance on overtime currently authorized within the theater, but should be based on United States classification rate of pay for similar positions

That the new overtime legislation of 1 July 1945 be made applicable to all federal employees who are United States citizens and are paid on a per annum basis wherever located is the desire of Congress. Overtime compensation to be computed on the basis of true time and one half up to 2980 dollars per annum for hours worked in excess of 40 hours per week. For salaries 2980 dollars and over the rate of overtime will be computed in accordance with the following formula

For basis salaries between 2980 dollars and 6440 dollars per annum the overtime rate for 416 overtime hours for any basic rate of compensation is computed by subtracting from 894.00, 7.6782 per centum of the amount by which such basic rate is in excess of 2980 dollars per annum.

For salaries in excess of 6440 dollars the overtime for 416 hours will be 628. 334 dollars per annum.

Example number 1. Basic salary 3000 dollars per annum less 2980 dollars equals 20 dollars difference times. 076782 equals 1. 5356 dollars. 894 dollars less 1. 5356 equals 892. 4644 dollars overtime rate for 416 overtime hours on 3000 dollars per annum.

Example number 2. Basic salary 4080 dollars per annum less 2980 dollars equals 1100 dollars difference times. 076782 equals 84. 4602 dollars. 894 dollars less 84. 4602 dollars equals 809. 5398 dollars overtime rate for 416 overtime hours on 4080 dollars per annum.

This act prohibits any officer or employee affected by the act from earning during any pay period basis compensation on basic compensation plus additional compensation at a rate in excess of 10000 dollars per annum. WAR DEPARTMENT CFC-75, dated 29 June 1945 will be furnished in near future.

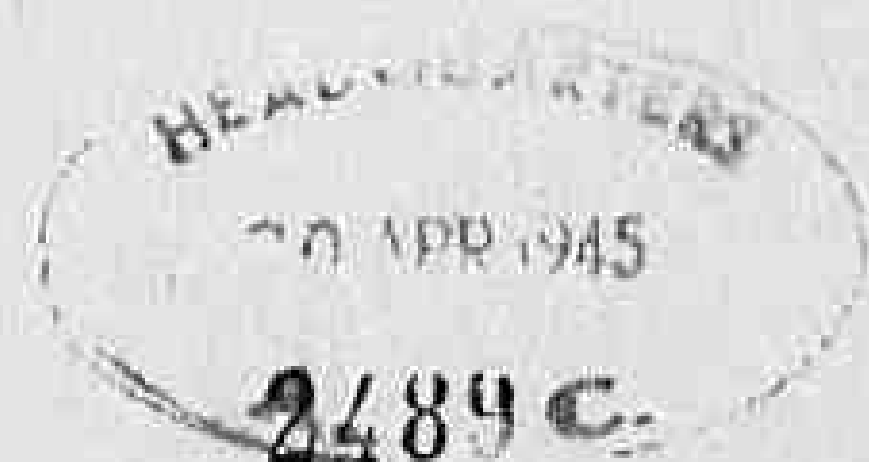

2. General Hume telephoned last night to say that Mr. Rook Ferris was doing excellent work and he very much wanted him to continue as his PRO. He explained that Mr. Ferris was "on loan" from PWB who have informed him that they would not be able to keep him indefinitely on their pay-roll unless arrangements could be made for A.C. to take him on.
3. General Hume asked that immediate action be taken to place Mr. Ferris on the staff of A.C., assigned as his Public Relations Officer. He said that Brigadier Lush and Colonel Fiske were familiar with the antecedents of these arrangements.
4. Major Bullock has intimated that the main difficulty of the transfer lay in the discrepancy of pay previously received by Mr. Ferris from PWB and that offered to him as PRO, A.C. Perhaps the Establishment Section could look into this aspect of the case.

1. Under conditions as prescribed in Civilian Personnel Circular 59, 1943, civilian employees of the War Department are entitled to transportation at government expense between the United States and overseas stations. Questions have been raised by certain overseas commands as to when travel time for personnel traveling between the United States and overseas stations is to be considered regular duty and when it is to be charged to annual leave.

2. The following statement of policy on this matter is furnished for your information and guidance:

a. Employees authorized transportation at Government expense.--Employees authorized transportation at government expense to overseas stations, or return transportation to specified destinations in the United States, will be carried in a regular duty status during such travel time, except when granted leave while enroute. Waiting time for transportation while on official travel status will be considered as regular duty for pay purposes. 2464

b. Employees not authorized transportation at Government expense.--

(1). Employees separated at the overseas station.--Employees separated at the overseas station are paid total salary due and a lump sum for leave, computed as of the effective date of separation. Travel time to the United States for such personnel will not effect the computation of payments for salary or leave.

(2). Employees granted leave from the overseas station.--Employees granted leave from the overseas station to return to the United States will be charged leave for all periods of absence from the overseas duty station, except travel time will not be charged to leave when leave is granted for not less than 60 days to a United States citizen for purposes of visiting the United States. The running of such leave shall be between the dates of arriving in and leaving the United States. This privilege may not be applied more often than once in 3 years. (See CPR 75.2-13 b (3).)

3. The provisions of this letter do not alter in any way the procedures to be followed in effecting lump sum payments for annual leave.

AGWAR cable W-36812, 13 February 45 is paraphrased for your information.

"BRUCE SMITH came to WASHINGTON subsequent to General SPOFFORDS departure and was interviewed. He stated at this time \$1500 per month was the least salary at which he could make himself available.

We attempted to try to procure his service by letter at the current top salary plus allowances being paid in ITALY of approximately 11,600 dollars to MR ANTOLINI and requested that he recommend qualified substitute if he were not available at that salary. SMITH did not accept this proposal but made 3 recommendations:

(1) Colonel JONATHAN H HARWOOD, who has been for last 20 years Executive Officer to RHODE ISLAND State Police. He holds a Bachelor Degree form HARVARD and is highly recommended by Captain VANDERBILT USNR (former Governor of RHODE ISLAND under whom he served). His age is 52 years.

(2) Colonel LYNN G ADAMS, formerly Provost Marshal of PARIS during last war, Superintendent and later Commissioner to the PENNSYLVANIA State Police, age 60 or slightly over. Since retiring from PENNSYLVANIA Police has acted in matters pertaining to State governments war time activities as aide to Governor MARTIN.

(3) Colonel DON SAIL STIVER, for 10 years superintendent of INDIANA State Police and who resigned December 1944 upon change of state administration. Was chairman of state and provisional section of

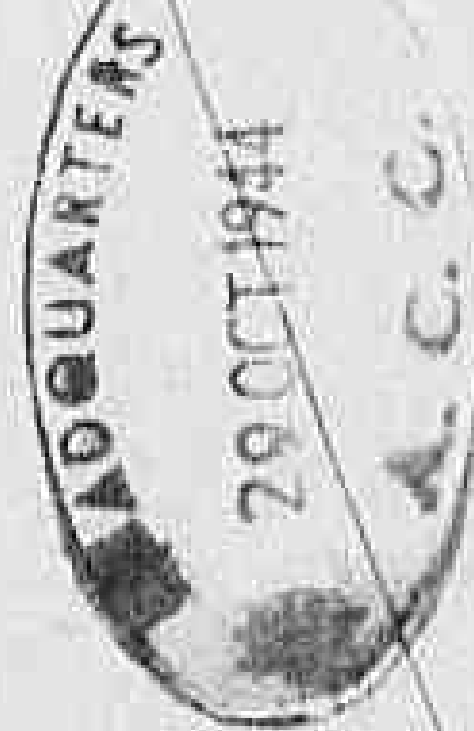
