It transpires that she called on one firm "La Centrale" Via Durini Milan with reference to Electrical Equipment.
 - b) Senior Admin. Assistant qualified to take charge of the office in the absence of the Supply Officer and therefore qualified to represent him.
 - c) Signora Solari had no authority from this Sub-Commission to visit Como.
3. Disciplinary action has been taken and Signora Solari ceased to be employed by this Sub-Commission w.e.f. 23 July 45 for wearing an unauthorised uniform with badges of rank of British Major whilst on a mission to Milan.

1. The Regional Commissioner Lombardia Region has reported to the Executive Commissioner that the above named Italian civilian recently appeared at his Headquarters in possession of Special Orders, authorized by the Public Works and Utilities Sub Commission, covering travel to Milan for the purpose of attending a Conference on behalf of the Supply Officer of the Public Works and Utilities Sub Commission. Furthermore on arrival this lady asked for transport to take her from Milan to Genoa. The period of her temporary duty was seven days.

2. In addition to the Special Orders Signora Solari was in possession of a Certificate which purported to confer Officer Status on her (in the rank of Major) and declaring her to be " a fit and proper person to be allowed admittance to any Club in Genoa Area and to enjoy the privileges of those Clubs ". This Certificate was signed by a Major L.G. MELONI, P.W. of the Electrical Division of the Public Works and Utilities Sub Commission.

3. Signora SOLARI arrived at N.C. Lombardia Region dressed in American slacks, sandals and adams headgear, wearing the badge of rank of a British Major on her shoulders.

4. It is requested that the Sub Commission concerned be directed to furnish a written report immediately to this office giving the following information:-

- (a) The nature and scope of the conference which Signora SOLARI was to attend in Milan.
- (b) The qualifications of Signora SOLARI to represent the Supply Officer of the Public Works and Utilities Sub Commission at such a Conference.
- (c) The nature and scope of her visit to Genoa.

5. It is further requested that the Sub Commission concerned be directed to instruct Maj. MELONI to report to this office for interview forthwith to furnish an explanation on his authority for issuing the Certificate referred to in para 2 above.

1. The a/n Italian Civilian, an employee of HQ Allied Commission (Pub. Works & Uts. Sub Commission) is now on a visit to Area Milan under authority of a Special Order issued at home within the last few days, which order incidentally authorises aircraft travel.
2. This person has visited Regional N., for the purpose of obtaining transportation to Come where, for a period of approximately seven days (according to her orders), she is to attend a conference in connection with Pub. works & Uts. activities.
3. The informal and sophisticated appearance of this girl having attracted attention at this HQ. (American slacks, sandals and sinus headgear), it was noticed that she was wearing on her shoulders badges of rank of a major (British). On being questioned she volunteered the information that she had been granted officer status and was under the impression that she was entitled to wear the badges of rank appropriate to a major. This impression, it might be mentioned, she no longer holds.
4. Attached is a copy of a certificate which she claims was issued at HQ. Allied Commission. The authenticity of this document, in view of its wording, is naturally in doubt. It does not seem possible that an officer of field rank would have signed such a document.
