SUBJECT: Personnel - Officers.

TO : G-1 (A).

1. This is with reference to Lieut. Theodore's request of this morning for the names of those American officers who could be replaced by suitably qualified civilians.

2. All American officers in Finance Sub-Commission, both in HQ and in the field, will be required to staff adequately the northern regions of Toscana, Emilia, Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia, and Venezia. It is the considered opinion of the Joint Directors of the Finance Sub-Commission, and of all other officers familiar with the financial problems of Italy, that only military personnel are in a position to deal with the Army and cope with the problems that will be encountered in forward AMG areas. Obviously, when this territory has been turned back to the Italian Government, conditions would have changed and undoubtedly at that time a considerable number of military personnel in those Regions could be replaced by civilians.

3. It must be remembered that Finance Sub-Commission is responsible for the supplying of currency to the Allied armies, navies, and air forces in Italy and must establish branches of the Allied Financial Agency wherever the Armies need such branches. One-half of the American officers in Finance Sub-Commission HQ (5 out of 10, excluding two ear-marked for Austria) are in the Allied Financial Agency and will probably have to be assigned to northern branch offices of AFA not yet established (e.g., Milan).

4. The other American officers at HQ, as well as those few left in AC Regions, will undoubtedly have to be assigned to northern Regions when they are occupied. In this connection it must be remembered that 10 American officers in Finance Sub-Commission have been ear-marked for Austria.

5. Having recently returned from the United States, I have ~~very~~ ^{grave} doubts that even a few American civilians adequately qualified can be recruited for service in Italy, to say nothing of the numbers that would be necessary to replace all American officers in Finance Sub-Commission. It is also apparently over-looked that the U.S. Treasury deliberately picked a group of experts, formerly in the Treasury and then in the armed services, to staff the Finance Sub-Commission. The Treasury has heavy demands on its few remaining civilians and there is no other source from which personnel with the requisite training and experience could be obtained.

6. To sum up, I have no American officers who could be replaced at the present time. When they can be replaced I am prepared to do so only when adequately trained and qualified civilian personnel have arrived and learned their jobs.

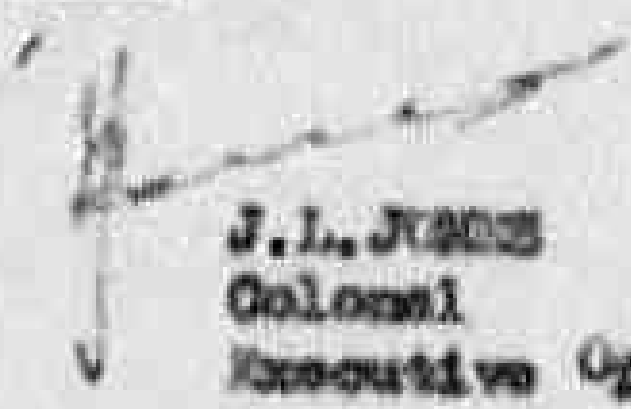

1. Reference your G-1B/83/A of 6 February 1945.

2. I attach hereto a copy of a memorandum addressed by Comdr J.J. Lawler, Joint Director of the Finance Sub-Commission to G-1(A). The points made by Comdr. Lawler on replacement of American finance officers apply with even greater force, if that is possible, to the question of the replacement of British officers. All of the British and American officers on the list attached to your memorandum were designated to work in forward areas and neither Comdr. Lawler nor myself considers that this is work that could be performed by civilians, even if the qualified civilians, by a manpower miracle, were available.

1. Attached herewith is a nominal roll of officers who have been provisionally earmarked for military government in AUSTRIA. The nominal roll is divided into five parts as follows:-

- 1-5 EXPERTS

2. It is proposed that 1-5 AP HQ shall periodically (not more frequently than once a month) leave a new nominal roll to bring the previous one up to date in the light of possible alterations.

3. Arrangements are well advanced for officer replacements where deemed necessary with priority to the regions of PINEMAN, LINDHILL, COMBAMILLA, VERMELA and AMSTERDAM.

4. Except for a small number of officers who will be required for planning it is not anticipated that there will be any movement of officers on a permanent basis until officer replacements are either in position, or have been recruited.

5. Many of the officers mentioned for AUSTRIA will be called upon to attend a Course of Instruction on AUSTRIA. The Course will be of approximately 14 days' duration, after which they will return to their duty stations.

6. Nothing in this letter or the attached nominal rolls will be taken as meaning that an officer will finally be selected for the appointment for which he has been provisionally earmarked. The fact that an officer's name appears against an appointment of a higher grade than his present rank, does not mean that the officer has been, or ever will be, recommended for such promotion.

7. There has been some misunderstanding regarding Military Government Plans for AUSTRIA. It is desired to set it clear to all concerned that they are of an operational organization, and the question of whether an officer should remain in the service at the risk of mobilization does not arise.
