1. At the present time the War Department is engaged in a Contract Termination and Surplus Property Disposal Program. This program is of vital interest to the War Department and has a tremendous bearing on the postwar economic conditions of the United States. It is estimated that an additional 1500 officers and 2500 enlisted personnel must be assigned to this duty to properly discharge the War Department responsibility.

2. It is desired that the names of officers and enlisted personnel, accompanied by duplicate Form 55-1 or Form 55, qualified in accordance with the enclosed schedule of qualifications be submitted as soon as possible to The Adjutant General. The following conditions will govern submission of names by your headquarters.

- a. Military necessity prevails.
- b. Preference will be given to:
 - (1) Officers over-age in grade for duty with troops.
 - (2) Enlisted men over 35 years of age.
 - (3) "Limited Service" personnel regardless of age.
 - (4) Military personnel returned from overseas theaters under rotation.

It is desired that necessary action be taken to permit the submission of individual applications of qualified personnel.

3. You will be advised of the personnel that are acceptable for assignment to this program with the Army Air Forces or Army Service Forces. Personnel

TERMINATION NEGOTIATORS - OFFICERS

Proposed Duties: Termination negotiators assist and may act as representatives of the contracting officer in negotiating settlements of terminated contracts and in investigating and recommending approval of settlements with subcontractors and vendors, and otherwise investigating and recommending the approval or disapproval of steps taken by contractors in connection with the termination settlement as such approval or disapproval is required of the contracting officer. They will confer with contractors, advise them with respect to procedures, examine their claims and settlement proposals, obtain accounting review and further accounting assistance if desired, conduct negotiations and make recommendations to contracting officers.

Qualifications:

Education: Four years college or broad business background.

Civilian Background: Officers who have had substantial positions in either financial, manufacturing or mercantile firms or in legal practice and preferably with broad business background and familiarity with financial statements.

Comments: Officers are desired in the grades of Captain and above. It should be explained that these officers will handle negotiations involving complicated claims running into large sums of money. Good judgment and discretion are essential. "Know-how" derived from considerable experience in arranging complicated business transactions is desirable.

CONTRACT TERMINATION AUDITING PROGRAM - OFFICER

Proposed Duties: Render accounting and auditing advice and assistance to contracting officers in termination units in areas and districts; assist in the determination of the extent of the accounting work to be done on contractors' proposed settlements; determine type and extent of accounting reports to be submitted to contracting officers; analyze and review contractors' proposed settlements in the prescribed manner and render appropriate reports to contracting officers; make special investigations and studies of the most difficult accounting problem.

QUALIFICATIONS OF AUDITORS

1. Certified Public Accountants.

2. College graduates with accounting degrees and some practical experience,

or

3. Controllers or chief accountants of industrial concerns,

or

4. Public accounting experience of at least three years,

PROPERTY DISPOSAL PERSONNEL - OFFICER

Assigned Duties: In general the Property Disposal Officer will assist or represent the Termination Contracting Officer in all matters relating to the disposition of property resulting from terminated contracts. In addition, Property Disposal Officers will be responsible for arranging the disposition of other classes of property in the hands of the War Department which may become excess or surplus. These officers supervise the receipt, classification and disposition of serviceable property and scrap, including raw materials, work-in-process, and miscellaneous property; they classify materials and decide whether they are salable or disposable as scrap; supervise distribution of salable materials to various manufacturers or to Arms and Services where it can be used; advertise and solicit bids for sale of material and serviceable property and arrange for the disposal of non-salable material; prepare reports, maintain records; and are responsible for salvage activities.

Qualifications: The primary qualifications for a Property Disposal Officer are that he be a business man with several years of general business experience; those who have had broad experience as plant engineers, production executives, purchasing executives or practical experience in industrial or mercantile concerns and who are familiar with business management are preferred. Familiarity with commercial methods of classifications of property and sorting and selling of scrap and surplus stocks is desirable.

Education: Graduate of recognized college preferred; engineering training and experience would, in some instances, be desirable although is not required and/or broad business background.

Comments: Officers are desired in all grades.

S. SECRETTERMINATION LEGAL PERSONNEL--(OFFICERS)

Proposed Duties: Termination Legal Officers will assist the Termination Contracting Officer and his representatives in all matters relating to the termination of contracts and the settlement of claims arising therefrom. They will be familiar with all provisions of law and regulations pertaining to this subject; will investigate, examine and review the facts of termination cases when called upon for advice and assistance; will prepare agreements embodying negotiated settlements and other documents relating to termination procedures and practices. They will advise with respect to property disposal procedures and prepare any contracts of sale or other documents connected with such transactions.

Qualifications:

a. Education: Graduate of college of recognized standing; graduate of a law school of recognized national standing or admission to bar.

b. Professional Experience: Depending upon the age and grade of the officer concerned, certain professional experience is required. For younger officers of lower grade a minimum of two years practice is desired. For officers of medium grade a minimum of five years practice is required. For officers of the grade of major a minimum of ten years experience in handling important legal matters is required. The type of experience required of all Legal Officers is corporate or contract law. Those who have not handled this type of work but whose practice has been mainly in trial work are not desired.

Comments: Officers in all grades are desired for these assignments.

MEMORANDUM OF THE SURPLUS PROPERTY DISPOSAL

13

FPA has been designated as the Federal Agency for all surplus disposal of property outside the United States.

Gen. O'Dwyer has, to date, been designated as Special Representative of FPA to handle SURPLUS in this theater. Mr. Antolini has been acting for him in his absence.

The War Dept - thru AFHQ - has informed the Army Service Forces and the Army Air Forces to refer surplus matters to the "LOCAL" FPA office. These military agencies have been pressing this office as to what organization and procedures have been established for the disposal of their surplus property.

FPA surplus disposal activities will also include the Navy and all other US agencies that have property to dispose of in this theater.

Within FPA (Washington), surplus activities are handled entirely separate from other economic matters, and hence function thru independent administrative machinery. They, in all cases, are connected with "COMBINED OPERATIONS" like the matters which pertain to AC. A separate set up of FPA personnel will be required here to work as a counterpart of the Washington Surplus office. Surplus activities and AC operations are too different and far apart to be handled by the same personnel.

FPA surplus activities will be conducted primarily with the Army Navy, US Embassy (Diplomatic Representative) Italian and other Foreign Governments and private business interests. Also dealings will be had with USSR. (Latest advice from Washington FPA indicate that USSR is to participate on the receiving end of surplus disposals). These activities require closest alignment with AC.

Col. Murphy has been in sole charge of surplus matters and is one who has a knowledge of current and proposed operations. He has been in consultation with FPA representatives who have visited this theater. He has sent a proposed (initial) organization to FPA Washington to be considered in connection with Washington's plans for operation in this theater. FPA Washington now indicates that the plans and procedures are under study, and that Col. Murphy's presence is desired in order to consummate the action under which permanent and routine activities will be conducted.
