





1. The following are my very provisional suggestions for appointments as AC Liaison Officers. They have been made on the principle that the Regional Commissioner should not become the Liaison Officer in his late Region. Another principle which I think should be followed is that in no case should the AC Liaison Officer continue to occupy the office of the Regional or Provincial Commissioner:

- MILAN - Colonel FISKE (A), at any rate to initiate the turnover. Gen Sec will provide a strong economic coordinating officer to head the Economic Group under the AC LO.
- TURIN - Colonel ROBERTS (A), now PC, GENOA.
- GENOA - Colonel MILLER (B), now AC LO at SARI.
- VERONA - Lt. Col. BRIDGEMAN (A), now CAC, MILAN, or Lt. Col. MURPHY (A), PC, BULGARO.
- BULGARO - Lt. Col. KENNEDY (B), now Deputy Regional Commissioner, FIRENZE.
- FIRENZE - Lt. Col. WALTERS (B), lately PC, PISA.
- PISA - Lt. Col. HAMILTON (B), now LO with No. 2 District, an appointment which will be absorbed by AC LO, MILAN.

2. I repeat that these are entirely provisional and subject to amended suggestions on my return.

SUBJECT : Personnel - LIGURIA Region

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commissioner.

1. With reference to the meeting of Regional Commissioners held at your Headquarters on the 14th July, if there is to be no Allied Commission phase my views are as follows as regards personnel that should remain in LIGURIA Region when the Italian Government assume jurisdiction over it.

2. I consider that the following Officers should remain:-

(a) With 60 Sub Area, GENOA: One Liaison Officer (Br) of the rank of Major.

(b) In IMPERIA Province: One or more Liaison Officers with Allied troops stationed on the frontier. The present South African Unit in IMPERIA Province has recommended three Liaison Officers to cover their three detachments at IMPERIA, SAN REMO and MONTECARLO. Any Officers approved should be British and not above the rank of Major.

(c) Such Transportation and Warehouse personnel as are required to operate A.C. supplies passing through the Ports of GENOA and SAVONA. The strength of this personnel is, I consider, a matter which must be decided by the Transportation and Food Sub-Committees of your Headquarters because I am unaware as to what is the policy proposed as regards the responsibility for handling and warehousing of supplies. For instance if all existing AMU warehouses were to be handed over to Italian control then presumably there would be no need for any A.C. warehouse personnel.

2. I consider that the following Officers should remain:-

The strength of this personnel is, I consider, a matter which must be decided by the Transportation and Food Sub-Commissions of your Headquarters because I am unaware as to what is the policy proposed as regards the responsibility for handling and warehousing of supplies. For instance if all existing AKS warehouses are to be handed over to Italian control then presumably there would be no need for any A.C. warehouse personnel.

The same remarks apply to Truck Pools - Officers to supervise would be required in any instance where such Pools have not been taken over by the Italian Authorities.

(d) One Railway Transportation Officer. This recommendation is made on the assumption that some supervision over railways by A.C. will be necessary at that stage. At present the responsibility is solely one of Q Movements.

(e) Such personnel of the Displaced Persons and Refugee Sub-Commission as are required to supervise the administration and movement of Allied Nationals. I recommend that responsibility for Italian refugees should be assumed by the Italian Government though some special

special arrangements might be necessary to facilitate the use by the Italian Government of any transport agencies which were still under Military or A.C. control or supervision.

3. As regards the question of the supervision of the preparation of the Electoral Lists which is raised in your E.Q. letter AC/45/A/LG of the 20th July 1945, in my opinion supervision by Allied Officers of the preparation of these lists could not be carried out effectively once AMG is withdrawn and would be unnecessary after the preliminary supervision exercised up to the date of handing over to the Italian Government.

In the event of it being decided to have Officers assigned for this supervision I consider that two Officers (not above the rank of Major) per Province would be necessary. Liaison Officers with the Military Authorities if present in the Province could act as supervisory Officers. Each Officer would require a car and a driver.
