1. It is notified that the Allied Financial Agency Sub-Section of Finance Sub-Commission have closed all AFA branches in Italy with the exception of the offices in Rome and Florence. It will be necessary to maintain the AFA branch in Florence after 1st September 1945 in order that the armies situated in the north can draw funds.
2. Major E. H. Bray (B) is the officer in charge of the Florence branch and he will remain there after the handover of the northern Regions. It is felt that Major Bray's assignment to ASD Livorno Zone for duty in Florence is a clumsy arrangement especially in view of the probable closing down of ASD in Livorno.
3. As Major Bray will act under direct control from this HQ, it is requested that approval be given to reassign this officer to Finance Sub-Commission, HQ AC for duty, rations and billeting in Florence.

1. A serious situation has arisen in the Sardinian coal industry. It will be realized that production of Sardinian coal at the present moment is of the greatest importance in order to save imports of coal from Allied sources and increase industrial capacity in Italy. On account of labor troubles and political and other causes, the Sardinian coal production has fallen to a dangerously low level and it is possible that Allied Commission may have to control the mines again.

2. As a result of discussions with Coal Section, AFHQ, it has been decided that it is imperative that Major Max A. Matthews O-253846 (A) return to Sardinia. Major Matthews was the officer in charge of Sardinian Coal Production from October 1943 to April 1945. He is the only officer in Allied Commission with the necessary experience of the operation of the mines under AC control.

3. Unfortunately Major Matthews has been placed on the list of officers scheduled to go to Austria and is now awaiting orders to report. For the reasons stated above it is requested that he be removed from this list and assigned as Chief Mining Officer, Sardinia.

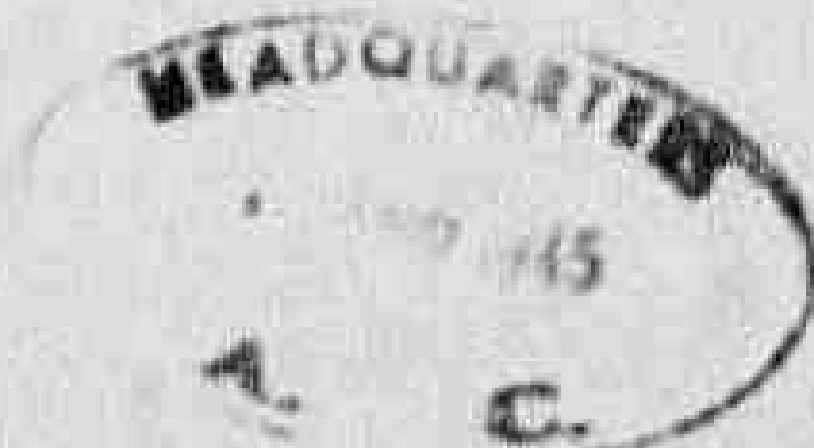
