The following extract from the minutes of the Executive Commissioner's meeting of 21 September is passed to you for your information:

"6. Handover of Territory. The CA Sec said that the normal time for the handover procedure was twenty-one days. He said, however, that it could be done in ten to fourteen days. It was agreed by all that to rush the handover was a mistake and that it might be necessary to make the date say 10 October. Polada said that at least we should get out an announcement of the handover in September. Ex C agreed that this was desirable. CA Sec would go ahead with the preparations and Ex C would discuss with CU.

With regard to Udine, a press release should be drafted, and Ex C asked PRO to coordinate with CA Sec on this. This, and the handover announcement, should be studied by Polada, and would then be passed to CC for approval."

"6. Handover of Territory. VP CA Sec said that the normal time for the handover procedure was twenty-one days. He said, however, that it could be done in ten to fourteen days. It was agreed by all that to rush the handover was a mistake and that it might be necessary to make the date say 10 October. Polada said that at least we should get out an announcement of the handover in September. Ex C agreed that this was desirable. CA Sec would go ahead with the preparations and Ex C would discuss with CO.

With regard to Udine, a press release should be drafted, and Ex C asked PNC to coordinate with CA Sec on this. This, and the handover announcement, should be studied by Polada, and would then be passed to CO for approval."
