1. The Chief Commissioner has been approached by the Italian Government with reference to an officer who is referred to as Town Major designate of Trieste believed to be R Major Revelly, and who was Town Major of Bari.
2. It is stated that this officer has as Secretary a woman of Yugo Slavic antecedents whom he intends to take to Trieste.
3. You will be aware of the extremely delicate political situation in Venezia Giulia and if this report is accurate it is feared that if this Secretary is transferred to Trieste it would create an unfortunate impression and in the eyes of the Italians would be magnified out of all proportion.
4. It would appear that the officer referred to is Major G. R. Revelly and it is requested that you will make inquiries into the matter and if the statements are confirmed the appropriate action be taken.
5. Will you please treat the matter as urgent and notify this H.Q. of result.

1. Reference your 56.1/20/EST dated 16 April 45.
2. There is a small number of civilian personnel employed as Executive and Administrative Assistants, who have been working for this Region for the last six months. These men are all trained personnel and are essential for the work of the special divisions by whom they are employed. They are either men associated with or having expert knowledge of the Departments of YUBIN or senior members of important engineering works situated in the Region.
3. Their Schade Personnel have all been approved some months ago. They have been vetted by Public Safety, and this H.Q. is in possession of passes issued by Fifth Army permitting them to move forward. One of the Executives was employed in AMG Eighth Army before coming here.
4. These male assistants have now been fully trained to take their part in their respective departments, and if this order is enforced, the work of months will be wasted. It is submitted that these civilians should be allowed to move in to the North with this H.Q. and that the employment of all such persons should be left to the discretion of the Regional Commissioner.
5. It is not intended to move any interpreters or clerks forward. There will, of course, be a number of Italian drivers who will be necessary to move this Region forward, and it is suggested that the authority to use them should also remain with this H.Q.

As I was telling you over the phone, there is at present in the Industry Sub-Commission of A.C. a man who might be of much interest to the Regional Commissioner for Trieste, or whomever is doing the planning for that area.

This man is Mario Cosulich, a member of that family whose name has been one of the most prominent in Italian shipping circles for years. Before the war he was a Department Manager of the local Selenia Vacuum company of which I was a Director and I have, therefore, known him for some years. We all had a high opinion of him and I would consider him entirely satisfactory and reliable from a political point of view. It occurred to me that his connections in the Trieste area, which was of course the "seat" of the Cosulich family and its industrial activities, might make him a useful person to consult or possibly to take in with one of the early groups.

As I explained to you over the phone, it is not a question of getting Cosulich a job - he already has one. I just thought it might interest you to know about him in view of his special connections in that area.
