Reference policy outlined in VAN 536 paras 1 to 5 following sent after consultation with BERNON. Consider it necessary provide for additional provincial officers for VENETIA GIULIA and frontier province UDINE also called FRIULI. Present estimate 23 additional officers required bringing total regional establishment to 88 provincial officers. Up to date 40 provincial officers have reported to this Region for duty. Understand 8 ARMY spearhead officers going to AUSTRIA will probably be withdrawn for concentration in 14 days by which time operations VAN 536 will be in progress. Position is therefore urgent. Consider that proportion of extra officers could be semi-trained as could use in dilution in other provinces releasing trained officers for frontier. Majority should if possible be Americans to restore present unbalanced composition Region. Glad to welcome staff officer from your HQ for discussion. HQ opens ARNO south of PADUA 5 or 6 May dependent on move of MAIN 8 ARMY.

Transportation Sub-Commission Officers - Northern Italy

1. When AC/ASD take over in N.W. Italy, it is proposed to establish an Advanced Echelon of the Transportation Sub-Commission. Its duties will be as follows:

a. To coordinate, on behalf of the Director of the Transportation Sub-Commission, movements and transportation work in the regions of Piemonte, Liguria, Lombardia, and such other provinces as may be considered as "N.W. Italy" from time to time.

b. To coordinate movements and transportation work with the military authorities.

c. To control the general distribution of AC and civilian transport in N.W. Italy.

d. To see that movements programs are carried out in accordance with established priorities, particularly programs affecting more than one region.

2. a. Regional Transportation Officers will arrange all local movement within N.W. Italy as far as possible from their own local resources; they will contact each other as necessary; and they will also work closely with military movement officers.

b. Demands for local movement within the N.W. area that cannot be met as outlined in (a) above and movement to or from places outside N.W. Italy will be referred to the Advanced Echelon of the Transportation Sub-Commission, who will try to meet such demands (1) by adjustment of AC controlled capacity, (2) by further contact with military movement headquarters in N.W. Italy, and (3) by reference to Transportation Sub-Commission, Rome.

SUBJECT: Telecommunications Officers

TO: Deputy Executive Commissioner

Reference the letter of the Regional Commissioner, EMILIA Region to you, No. RIX/DO/1 dated 12th March, 1945.

1. So far as this Sub-Commission is concerned, the Regional Commissioner may rest assured that his Region will be covered as adequately as any other of the Northern Regions.

2. The strength of the Sub-Commission does not allow of a Telecommunications officer or a Postal officer with each Region. The officers to cover EMILIA Region have been assigned to other Regions, but it has been made abundantly clear to the officers concerned and has also been formally notified by order that the EMILIA Region forms an equal part of their duties.

3. The Telecommunications Officer for EMILIA Region is Major R.H. AXRE, assigned to TOSCANA Region. He is nominated as a member of the Telecommunications Board for Bologna and will make BOLOGNA his head office as early as possible. A copy of the original telegram stating this case is attached; to clear the matter finally an order will be requested for publication in HQs. Allied Commission Special Orders in the usual way. He will be transferred to EMILIA Region on his move to BOLOGNA, and Lieut. RUSHING from HQs. will be moved to TOSCANA Region.

4. The Postal officer for EMILIA Region is Lieut. A.J. ALLEN assigned to ABRUZZI-MARCHE Region. A copy of the order for him to cover EMILIA Region is attached.

My dear Colonel,

You have stated that Establishment Section will, in the next several weeks, prepare a table showing by name, the distribution of specialist officers to Regions, and will thereafter submit draft copies of such table "to all interested regional commissioners for them to shoot at", this table to be the subject of further clearance at a meeting to which I shall be invited.

I am therefore taking the liberty, in this letter, of pointing out some of the respects in which I feel that the proposed numerical allotment of specialists set forth in the addendum to your letter C-18/31/3/A, "Ceilings-Officers", 7 March 1945, are most illogical and inadequate as regards this Region. I hope that you will refer to it in the course of your discussions with the sub-commissions and that modifications which will produce a more equitable and workable allocation, will result.

I shall refrain from discussing over-all numbers (also inadequate), resting the security of Emilia in that regard on informal assurances from you and the Executive Commissioner that additional bodies, as such, up to a reasonable, workable ceiling, will be forthcoming from (1) officers earmarked for Austria but not taken into account in preparing the chart (2) additional officers to be "barrel-scraped" out of Headquarters, and (3) other sources. This letter relates solely to numbers allotted to specific special classifications--specialists, who cannot be pulled out of a hat or picked up casually in just any group of assorted officers. With even more emphasis, it relates to heads of special divisions.

Preliminarily, I call attention to the following pertinent basic facts upon which judgment of the needs

of Emilia must presumably be to some extent predicated, and which I feel must have been overlooked in the preparation of the table above referred to:

1. Emilia Region is still, as such, totally non-operational to exactly the same extent as Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia and Venezia. By grace of the Eighth Army, a certain amount of emergency work has been done in one-and-a-half provinces, but the regional job proper is still ahead.

2. The devastation in the portions of Emilia already liberated exceeds anything experienced north of Cassino, and there is every indication that the remainder of the Region has been, or will be, hit equally hard.

3. Emilia has eight provinces--the same number as Piemonte; twice as many as Liguria. Except for Torino and Genova, respectively, the Emilian provinces are not inferior in importance or population to those of these Regions. In fact, the provinces of Liguria other than Genova are not comparable with Forli, Bologna, Modena, Parma, Piacenza, etc., in strategic and industrial significance.

4. Bologna is the transportation, communications, and commercial "hub", of all of northern Italy, and is an important industrial area.

5. There will evidently be more troops stationed in Emilia for a long period of time than in any other comparable area in northern Italy.

6. There is some indication that up to one million German military and civilian personnel will be concentrated, unconfined in Emilia.

Bearing these facts in mind, I submit that the following typical comparative figures from your chart speak for themselves as to the inadequacy of the provision made for this Region:

Thus, in this group of important Economic Section divisions, we find that (excluding officers earmarked for Austria) personnel provision per province is, for Liguria, 400%, and for Piemonte, 250%, of that for Emilia.

The fact that the most glaring inequities and impartialities (though there are others I shall not here belabor) all relate to Economic Section classifications, leads me to wonder whether the advice and counsel of the Economic Section have been asked and considered in connection with these allocations. I have not, and do not wish to, press this inquiry, but I have learned by chance that the Transportation Sub-Commission did recommend an allotment of twelve (12) officers to Emilia, and that Commerce Sub-Commission planned to provide a minimum of two (2) commerce officers.

I cannot believe that those to whose hands the economic aspects of A.C.'s mission are entrusted really regard Emilia as of so little importance industrially and commercially, as your proposed personnel chart would imply. If they do, I should be glad upon another occa-

sion to attempt, with the aid of Lt. Cashman's "Hand-book of Basic Information", to show them their error. For the present, knowing that the allocations are completely out of line with the recommendations of at least two of the Directors of Economic sub-commissions, I prefer to believe that the true answer lies either in a failure to consult the sub-commission at all or in giving insufficient weight to their recommendations.

The only other possible explanation, would be that Emilia Region officers are regarded as so much more efficiently trained, indoctrinated, organized and directed, than those of other regions, that one of them can do the work of two to four ordinary people. Flattering as I might find this hypothesis, it is rejected as unfair to the individual officers of Liguria and Piemonte.

As far as names are concerned, I assume that the basic rule will be that those officers now assigned to Emilia and who have participated in our operations and planning for up to eight months now, will in any event be retained. Except in a few cases where the training and qualifications of officers assigned are ill-adapted to Emilia's special needs, I shall find it necessary to resist any measures to move officers indoctrinated in our methods to Regions farther forward, replacing them with new officers whose integration into the regional team must start from scratch. This is particularly true of the heads of special divisions. Even as things stand now, heads of (and sole members of) two of our specialist divisions are "assigned" to northern Regions and heads of two very important others (Public Safety and Transportation) "earmarked" for Austria.

I submit this letter in the hope that the product of your further labors with the sub-commission during the next two weeks may offer a less vulnerable target to be "shot at" at the promised round-table of regional commissioners to be held in a fortnight.

I am confident that it will receive sympathetic consideration and favorable action.

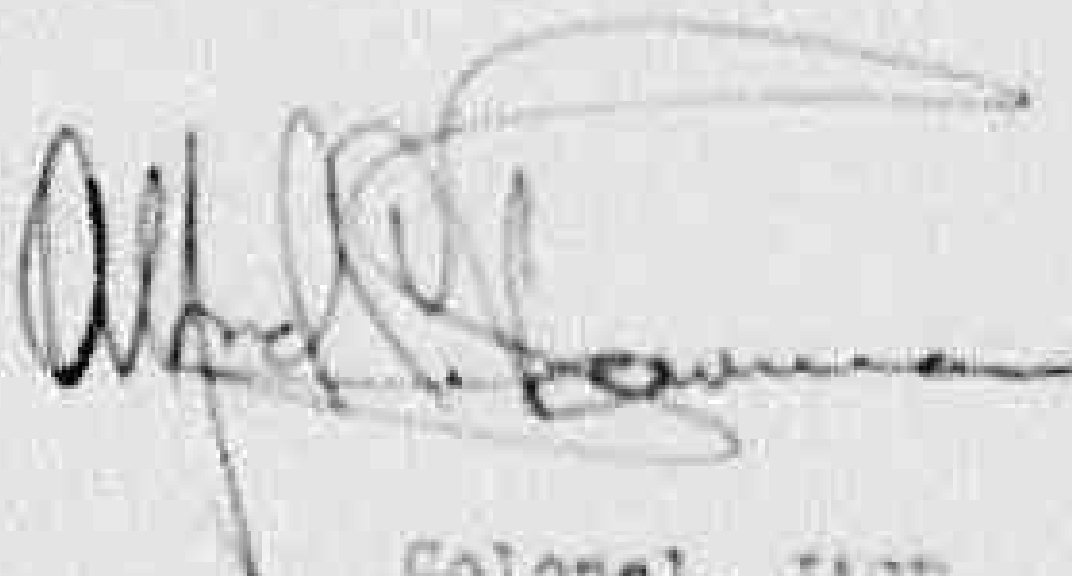

4. It is believed that a few British officers may be made available to the Legal Sub-Commission, but in order to fill the deficiency, some 10 American officers are required.

5. These officers will be needed for posts as provincial Legal Officers. Their main duties will be as judges in, and otherwise supervising the conduct of, Allied military courts. They should not be above the rank of Major, and should preferably be Captains or Majors.

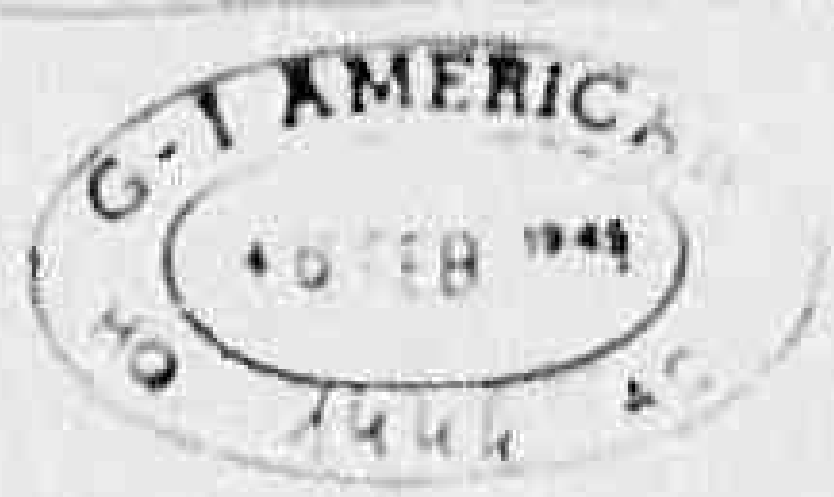

1. Your 504/III/003 of 1 January was forwarded to me by Colonel T.N. Page, Acting Regional Commissioner, Venetia.
2. I have been studying the implication of this letter and I wish to put forward to you a suggestion which, I have already had an opportunity of discussing with Colonel Blake and Lt. Col. Shipp.
3. This proposal is submitted, on the assumption that I shall return to Venetia Region when the northerly move takes place. I believe that to be your present plan.
4. Based on this assumption, I wish to suggest, for your consideration, that Tactical H.Q. Venetia, move from its present H.Q. at Mendicino, near Rimini, to Naples.

4. Based on this assumption, I wish to suggest, for your consideration, that Tactical H.Q. Venezia, move from its present H.Q. at Mondino, near Rimini, to Naples.
5. In making this suggestion, I wish to make it absolutely clear beyond any doubt, that I have complete confidence in Colonel T.N. Page, and that I should most willingly endorse any plans made by him. I feel, however, that Colonel Page himself will feel, in the weeks to come, that many points arise in which some will wish to consult me.
6. Such a move South of Tactical H.Q., would have the disadvantage of loss of contact with 8 Army, and 3 Army (contact with the latter is by difficult roads). It would have the advantage of closer contact with H.Q. A.C., with A.F.H.Q., with Austrian Planning Group at Portici, and with the Yugoslav Division at Bari.
7. You will also appreciate that many officers who will hold important positions in Venezia, such as, Lt. Col. Orsedo, Lt. Col. Armstrong, and possibly Colonel Howell are, or will shortly be working in Southern Region.
8. My suggestion would be that only a planning H.Q. should move South. This to consist of Colonel T.N. Page, Mr. Cdr. Proby, possibly one P.V. officer, and two or three clerks with necessary transport for a quick move. Main Headquarters would remain, with all stores, at its present location at Mondino.
9. I suggest, that unless he is required by Rome, Lt. Col. Arnold should be the Liaison Officer at N.A. No. 1 District.
10. In this connection, I wish to bring to your notice, the desirability of settling, as far as possible, the key personnel of Venezia Region. We have already lost Colonel Geyers, Lt. Col. Greig, and I understand that we shall lose other officers for Austria, with all respect to all the important problems of that

I do feel that the frontier provinces of Venezuela, nearly as many difficult problems and nearly as much explosive material as exist in Austria.

11. I should therefore appreciate it, if the make-up of Venezuelan Regional Teams could be settled as soon as possible. You know how far below strength we are. If reinforcements are to be available from A.A. and other units, I should like to have them as soon as possible. We could train them in Southern Region on the olive oil campaign.

12. I am sending this letter forward in triplicate so that, if you think fit, you can forward one copy to Colonel T.N. Page with your views.
