- 1 It is recommended that the duties and responsibilities in connection with warehousing and transport of American Red Cross Clothing now handled by the Clothing Section, National Supply Branch be transferred to the Warehousing and Forwarding Section, Transportation Sub-Commission.
 - 2 The functions of this Section are now those of storage and transport of Red Cross Clothing. Warehouses are located at Simpson and Leghorn. Mr. Ford of the American Red Cross maintains all records on this clothing and approves any requisitions for transfer from warehouses to provinces.
