TO : Officer Commanding, Maintenance Group  
Allied Commission (Italian Army Personnel)

1. Letter this Headquarters, 90.4/15/EST of 12 April 1945, is hereby cancelled.

2. Establishment Memorandum No. 33, dated 15 December 1944, lays down specified limits to the power of certain officers to authorize AMG/AC expenditure. In particular paragraph 3 (b) limits the authorizing power of a Regional Commissioner to Lire 200,000 for any one item or related group of items.

3. In view of the fact that the Maintenance Group is a special organization, the authorizing powers of a Regional Commissioner as laid down in paragraph 3 (b) of Establishment Memorandum No. 33 are hereby extended to you as Commanding Officer, Maintenance Group; that is to say, you are empowered to authorize "housekeeping" expenditure up to the sum of Lire 200,000. Subject to paragraph 4 below, any expenditure in excess of Lire 200,000 will require the authorization of the Executive Commissioner.

4. Paragraph 3 above is not intended to apply to the special expenditure, under contract, which will be incurred by the Maintenance Group for the assembly of imported motor vehicles. In this case, although the expenditure is, of course, far in excess of Lire 200,000, the power to authorize this expenditure is delegated to Commanding Officer, Maintenance Group.

Establishment Memorandum No. 33.

TO : Executive Commissioner, Headquarters, Allied Commission.

1. Reference is made to your letter 90.4/15/EST dated 12 April 1945.
2. On the instructions contained in A.F.H.Q. letter AG 537/177 C.D.S.-O dated 13th May 1945, Motor Transport Group, as such, has ceased to exist. In its place, on 1 June, 1945, two Groups were formed as follows:-
  - a. Truck Operating Group;
  - b. Maintenance Group.
3. In accordance with the policy to hand over to the Italian Government the load carrying vehicles previously operated by A.C., the Truck Operating Group is now in the process of disbandment.
4. It will be appreciated, however, that the expenditure authorized to the Commanding Officer of the Motor Transport Group by you was undertaken exclusively on behalf of the Maintenance side of the Motor Transport Group, i.e. payments to civilian Firms for assembly and Maintenance of vehicles, etc.
5. With the setting up in various places in Italy of 3rd and 4th Echelon shops, where maintenance and repairs will be carried out by civilian labour, accounts as rendered by the respective Firms will have to be settled by this Headquarters until such time as the Finance officer of the Italian Government can assume this obligation.
6. It is requested therefore that the powers authorized to the Commanding Officer of the Motor Transport Group be transferred to the Commanding Officer of the Maintenance Group as and from 1st June 1945.

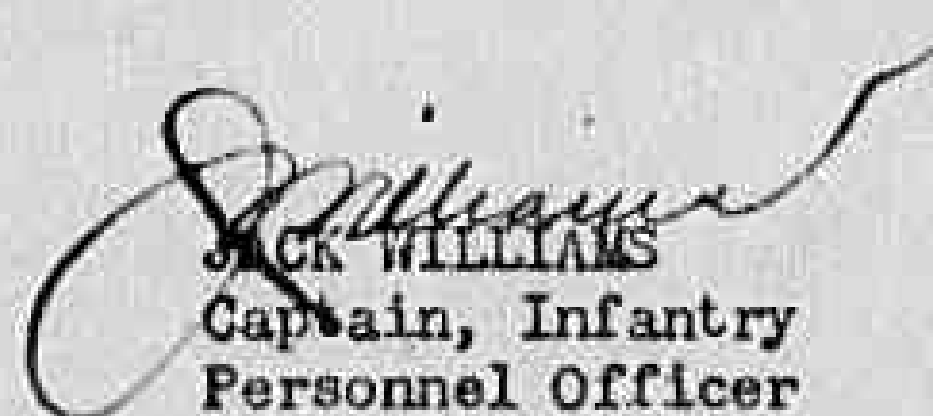

1. Reference is made to letter, this headquarters, file AG 537/177 GDS-O, dated 13 May 1945, subject: "Organization of Truck Transport and Maintenance Groups, AC".

2. Withdrawal of Allied and Italian Military Personnel.

The phased withdrawal of military personnel as laid down in paragraph 8 (final two sentences) of the above-mentioned letter is cancelled. Allied military, US-ITI and BR-ITI personnel will now be withdrawn as follows:

a. Truck Operating Group.

- (1) By 1 July - 25%
- (2) By 15 July - 25%
- (3) By 1 August - Remaining 50%

b. Maintenance Group.

On 1 October 1945.

3. Provision of Allied Military Personnel for Maintenance Group.

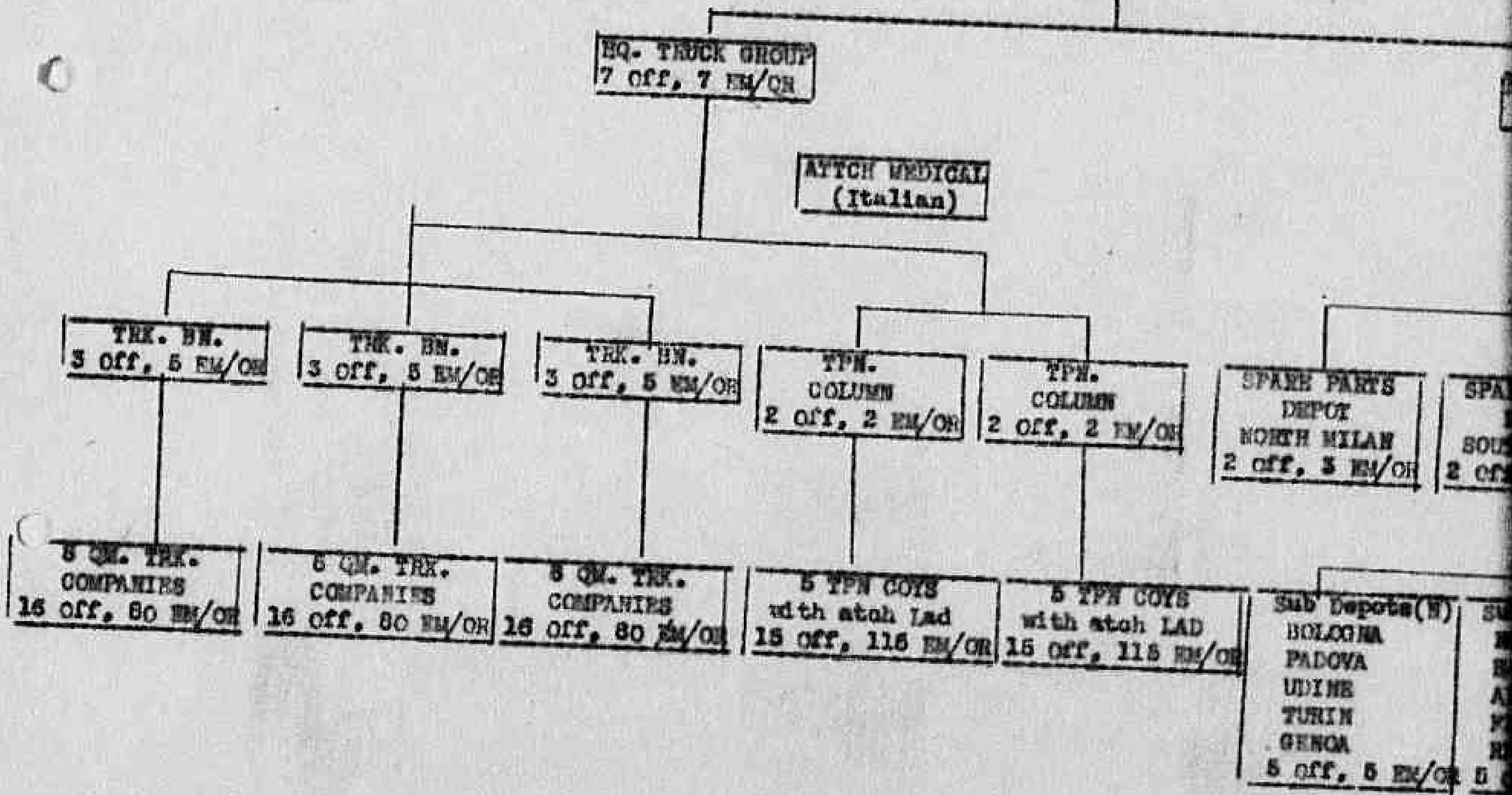

  - (ii) In this status he, like a Regional Commissioner or SQAO, is not permitted to communicate direct with higher authority. He must address all correspondence on subjects requiring reference to higher authority to the appropriate office at this Hq in accordance with the procedure established in Office Memorandum No.17, copy of which is attached. Matters in Group 'A' will be dealt with by the Executive Commissioner, in Group 'B' by the Economic Section, and in Group 'C' (the routine technical or administrative material) by the Transportation Sub-Commission or appropriate Branch in the Establishment Section.
4. I shall be obliged if you will confirm that the above procedure is clearly understood by yourself, the Director of the Transportation Sub-Commission and the O.C. Motor Transport Group, and that in future it will be followed.

1. Establishment Memorandum No. 33, dated 15 December 1944, lays down specified limits to the power of certain officers to authorize AMO/AC expenditure. In particular paragraph 3(b) limits the authorizing power of a Regional Commissioner to Lire 200,000 for any one item or related group of items.

2. In view of the fact that the Motor Transport Group is a special organization, the authorizing powers of a Regional Commissioner as laid down in paragraph 3(b) of Establishment Memorandum No. 33 are hereby extended to you as Commanding Officer, Motor Transport Group; that is to say, you are empowered to authorize "housekeeping" expenditure up to the sum of Lire 200,000. Subject to paragraph 3 below, any expenditure in excess of Lire 200,000 will require the authorization of the Executive Commissioner.

3. Paragraph 2 above is not intended to apply to the special expenditure, under contract, which will be incurred by the Motor Transport Group for the assembly of imported motor vehicles. In this case, although the expenditure is, of course, far in excess of Lire 200,000, the power to authorize this expenditure is delegated to Commanding Officer, Motor Transport Group.

Subject: Historical Report, Company "T", February, 1945.

To : Commanding Officer, 2575th Regiment, Allied Commission (Overhead),  
APO 394, U. S. Army.

1. During the month of February, additional plans were made by the 1st Truck Battalion, (Italian Personnel), supervised by officers and men of Company "T", for increasing the unit and activating additional companies.
2. Civitavecchia was established as the area for the tentative 2nd Truck Battalion. Italian soldiers, (400), were received there, and our 7th Detachment of Co. T, consisting of 2 officers and 8 enlisted men were the initial American Group with them, to start their activation.
3. A new American unit, the 2596th Technical Supervision Company, (Ovnd), a PBS organization, was attached to Company T for rations and quarters. Their purpose is similar to our duties. They also will supervise Italian Units. At present the officers and men are being trained by our men as to the importance of their work and acquainting them with the tribulations facing them in the early stages of training Italian personnel.
4. At present the strength of this unit is nine officers and sixty enlisted men. More than half of the men are with our detachment in Civitavecchia.
5. The First Company moved from Rome to Leghorn. The area used by the First Company is now used as an additional Training Detachment. Our units in Florence were highly complimented by AMG officials for the splendid assistance and co-operation AMG has received under the trying conditions our men had to face in carrying out their jobs in the forward areas.
6. Losses in strength in our organization has been, one officer and one enlisted man transferred to other units out of the Regiment.
