Though I have not the honour of being personally acquainted with you, I take the liberty of addressing you for a matter in which I am most interested.

I am a professor of Modern History at the University of Rome, and my physical condition does not allow me to accomplish my activity of teacher without a transportation. I owned a car which has been requisitioned last July by New Zealander Edqs. (requisition receipt note No. 475402, dated 8/8/44)

The car is a Lancia Aprilia marked Roma 68780 and, as far as I am concerned, it is still in Rome. The car was requisitioned exclusively for military purposes, and since the war in Italy is now completely over, I would deeply appreciate your personal interest in the matter so that I could finally have my car given back to me.

As for my health condition you can inquire directly with H. E. Bonomi or with the University Director. In case you believe it necessary to discuss the matter personally, I would be most grateful if you would make an appointment for me.
