2. WITHDRAWAL OF REQUISITIONED VEHICLES.

a. Sardinia

- (1) There are no requisitioned vehicles available from this Region since they are property of the Italian Government.

b. Sicily

- (1) Class "A" vehicles necessary for the continued operation of A.C. in Sicily will be transferred to the Italian Government. The remainder of Class "A" vehicles which can be utilized in the Northern Regions will be transferred to the G-4 (A) Pool at Hq., Allied Commission, for re-allocation.
- (2) Unserviceable vehicles, Class "B" and "C" will be transferred to the Italian Government. Prior to transfer of these vehicles they will be stripped of ALL WAR DEPARTMENT parts and accessories.
- (3) The Motor Officer of the respective Regions will be held responsible for the classification of requisitioned vehicles and will coordinate with the Requisitioning Officer for transfer.

c. Southern Region

- (1) Class "A" vehicles necessary for the continued operation of A.C. in Southern Region will remain; the remainder will be transferred to G-4 (A) Pool.
- (2) Class "B" and "C" vehicles disposition is now under discussion.

- d. Lazio Umbria and Abruzzi Marche are now under discussion as per Para. c. (1) and (2).

3. All T/E equipment will be collected by the respective Company Commanders prior to departure and will be turned in to the Regimental Supply Officer for re-allocation, as follows:

a. Sardinia, Sicily and Southern Region

(1) All T/E Equipment

b. Lazio-Umbria

(1) Seventy percent (70%) of all T/E Equipment.

c. Abruzzi-Marche

(1) Fifty percent (50%) of all T/E Equipment.

4. It is further suggested that the Motor Officer and the Requisitioning Officer of the respective regions be the last ones to move out in order to tie up whatever loose ends may be found at the last moments.

MEMORANDUM

TO: Deputy Executive Commissioner, Allied Commission, APO 394, US Army

1. Proposed T/E's have been submitted by Liguria, Piemonte, Lombardia, Venezia, and Venezia Giulia Regions and it is agreed by G-4 (A & B) that their requirements are not excessive to carry out their duties.
2. Suggest Abruzzi Marche submit their requirements for the Region, after consolidation, so they can be considered by G-4 (A & B).
3. Allocation of available or WD transportation to become available has been made to Regions proportionately to number of Officers and the size of the Regions. Therefore no more WD vehicles are forthcoming and the balance will have to be filled with Civilian Requisitioned Vehicles.
4. Civilian Requisitioned Vehicles are also being allocated from Southern Regions to Northern Regions on a proportionate basis. In as much as Abruzzi-Marche Region has ninety eight (98) civilian requisitioned vehicles, (see attached memo from Requisition vehicle Section), no civilian requisitioned vehicles can be made available until Northern Regions are brought up to a par with Abruzzi-Marche Region.
5. AFHQ has continually turned down authority to requisition and hire. These two problems are still being considered by higher authority and until they are clarified, transportation now in Allied Commission will have to be utilized to the maximum.

SUBJECT: Withdrawal of Civilian Requisitioned Vehicles from Lasio-Umbria Region.

TO : Regional Commissioner,
Lasio-Umbria Region,
Allied Commission,
APO 394.

1. Upon the withdrawal of Allied Commission personnel from Lasio-Umbria Region, the following will govern in connection with the removal and transfer of all civilian requisitioned vehicles now held in your Region.
2. Since this Commission no longer has authority to requisition civilian vehicles and due to the critical shortage of V.D. vehicles available for issue to Northern Regions, it becomes necessary to utilize all the available civilian requisitioned transport now held by Regions of Allied Commission. Therefore all civilian requisitioned vehicles in Lasio-Umbria Region will be transferred to G-4 (A), Headquarters A.C. and reallocated on an equal basis to Northern Regions as needed. The G-4 (A) pool will consist of vehicles turned in by Sicilia, Southern and Lasio-Umbria Regions.
3. Regional Commissioner will take the necessary steps to prevent all officers from taking North any vehicle now assigned to such officer and any violation of this instruction will be the subject for disciplinary action and officers will be held pecuniary responsible for any such vehicles lost through negligence. It should be brought to the attention of all officers in your Region that requisitioned vehicles are charged to this Commission the same as V.D. vehicles and must be treated similarly.
4. Regional Commissioner will submit in writing to G-4 (A), for approval, a list of vehicles needed in Provinces which remain in operation in Lasio-Umbria.
5. The Requisitioning Officer, Lasio-Umbria, will without delay submit a list of all vehicles in your Region which are beyond economical repair that might be returned to their original owners. G-4 (A) will request authority to derequisition these vehicles unless the parts from these vehicles are needed to service others.

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Ltr. Hq AC, dtd 27 Feb 45, file GH/41/A, sub: Withdrawal of Civilian Requisitioned Vehicles from Lazio-Umbria Region.

6. All Lazio-Umbria requisitioned vehicles on loan or being used by Italian Government agencies will be retrieved and transferred to G-4 (A).

7. It is absolutely necessary that Lt. O'Donnell, Requisitioning Officer and Sgt Di Mattai, H.Q.C. in charge of records, remain in Rome to satisfactorily complete the transfer of all vehicles and until the transmittal of the consolidated records on all of your requisitioned cars has been accomplished.

8. In order that Headquarters have the necessary maintenance facilities and space to service and accommodate all vehicles coming from Sicily, Southern and Lazio-Umbria Regions, before reallocation of these vehicles is made, the Region IV Garage (Public Safety) will be turned over to Headquarters Commandant, Headquarters A.C. It is requested that a complete inventory of all vehicles and equipment in the garage be taken before such transfer is effected.

9. Your utmost cooperation in complying with the instructions set forth is requested.

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2. WITHDRAWAL OF REQUISITIONED VEHICLES.

a. Sardinia

- (1) There are no requisitioned vehicles available from this Region since they are property of the Italian Government.

b. Sicily

- (1) Class "A" vehicles necessary for the continued operation of A.C. in Sicily will be transferred to the Italian Government. The remainder of Class "A" vehicles which can be utilized in the Northern Regions will be transferred to the G-4 (A) Pool at Hq., Allied Commission, for re-allocation.
- (2) Unserviceable vehicles, Class "B" and "C" will be transferred to the Italian Government. Prior to transfer of these vehicles they will be stripped of ALL WAR DEPARTMENT parts and accessories.
- (3) The Motor Officer of the respective Regions will be held responsible for the classification of requisitioned vehicles and will coordinate with the Requisitioning Officer for transfer.

c. Southern Region

- (1) Class "A" vehicles necessary for the continued operation of A.C. in Southern Region will remain; the remainder will be transferred to G-4 (A) Pool.
- (2) Class "B" and "C" vehicles disposition is now under discussion.

d. Lazio Umbria and Abruzzi Marche are now under discussion as per Para. c, (1) and (2).

SUBJECT: British W. D. Vehicles

TO: Regional Commissioner,
Southern Region.

Reference your MEM of 7th February, 1945. It is agreed that such British W.D. vehicles as are to go from Southern Region to Venezia Region should be transferred direct from one Region to the other in Naples, as and when the Regional Commissioner, Southern Region considers it convenient.

On each transfer, vehicles and equipment should please be checked, AB 406 and AB 412 properly completed and handed over with the vehicle, and AF G.1033 signed by both parties and a copy sent to this Headquarters.

As you know, a certain number of vehicles will have to remain in Southern Region for Provincial Headquarters at Naples and the Liaison Officer at Bari, and instructions as to the number and type of vehicles to be left will be sent as soon as possible.

Although G-4 (B) is not directly concerned with the transfer of requisitioned vehicles, (which is an American responsibility), it is affected inasmuch as the number of requisitioned vehicles transferred to Venezia Region will lessen the number of British W.D. passenger vehicles to be provided.

It is therefore requested that as soon as possible you will kindly inform this Branch what requisitioned vehicles are to be transferred to Venezia Region, and what requisitioned vehicles will be left with A.C. officers remaining in Naples or Bari.
