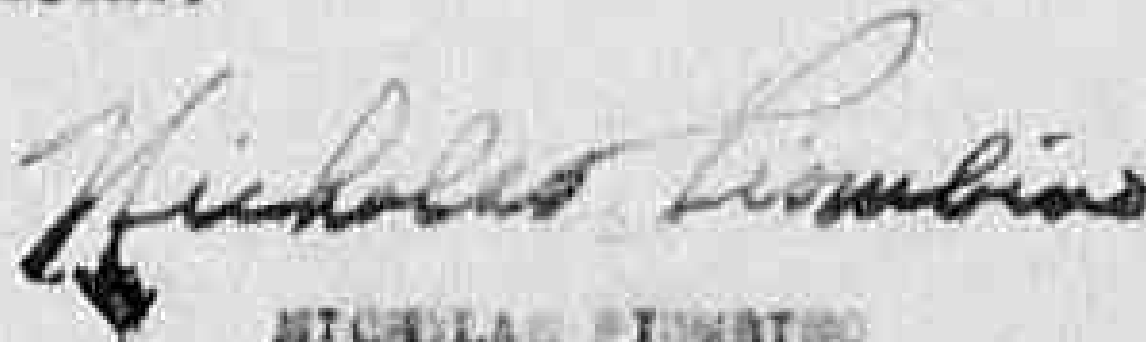

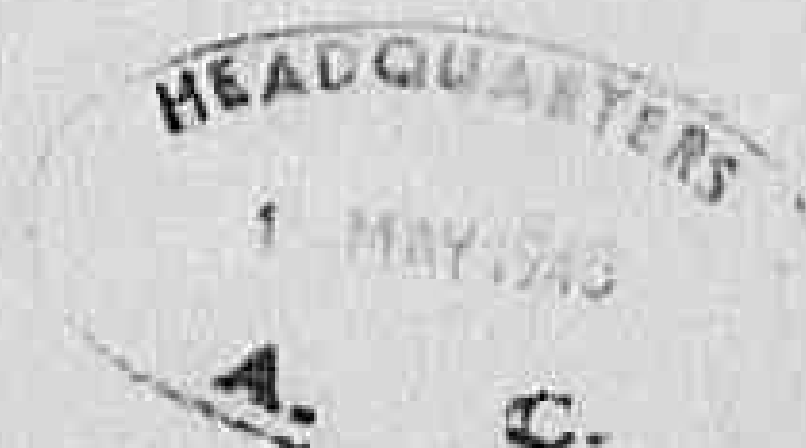

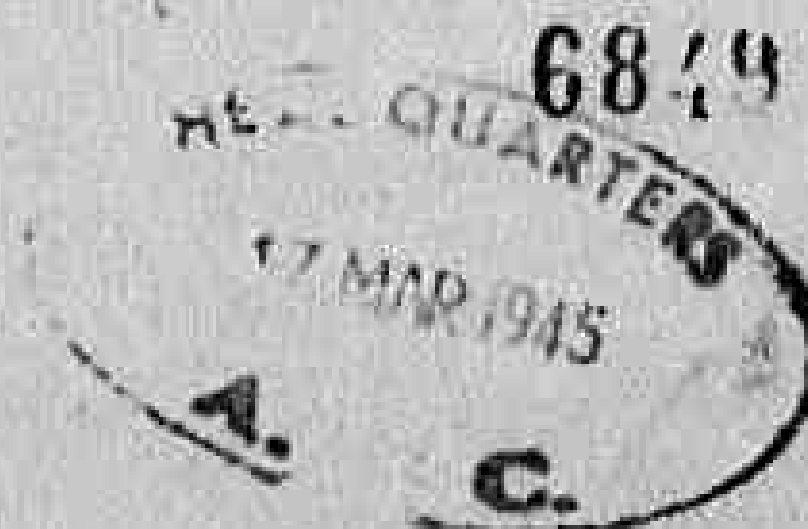

Doubtful cases should be referred to FEA, but cash reimbursement procedure may be used for any transportation in interest of war effort on behalf of a Lend Lease Government if final determination of eligibility for straight Lend Lease would involve delay of essential travel. If investigation shows such travel was eligible for straight Lend Lease, no collection will be made in Washington.

b. We are forwarding by pouch detailed instructions respecting criteria of Lend Lease ability for air transportation. ATO and State Department officials will receive similar instructions. 2. In accordance with paragraph "1a", the attached cable, FEA, Italy, is requesting the Consul General of the State Department at Naples to act on FEA's behalf inasmuch as we have no personnel available for the certification of lend lease transportation of personnel and cargo.

3. It is requested that the War Department, in the absence of State Department representatives, certify such transport in the interest of the FEA and in accordance with paragraph "1b" of the attached cable.

4. The FEA is forwarding directly to the ATC as well as to the State Department detailed instructions respecting criteria of lend lease ability for air transportation.

5. Particular attention is invited to the fact that the cost of travel for FEA personnel attached to the Allied Commission and under competent orders of the Commission are to be borne by the War Department and not by the FEA.

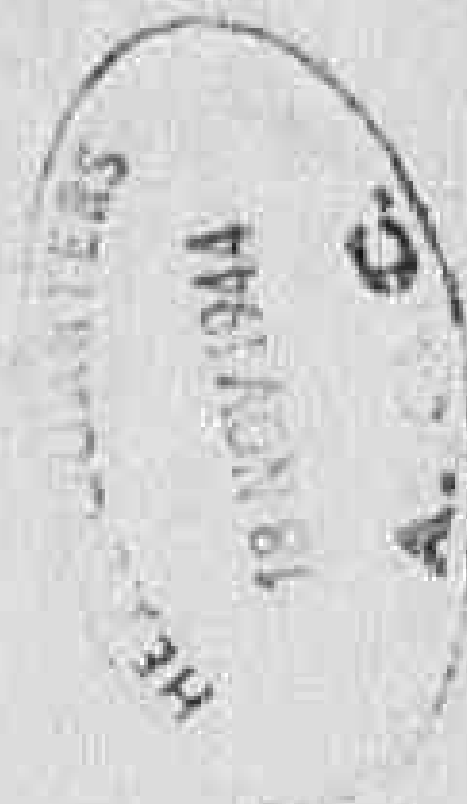

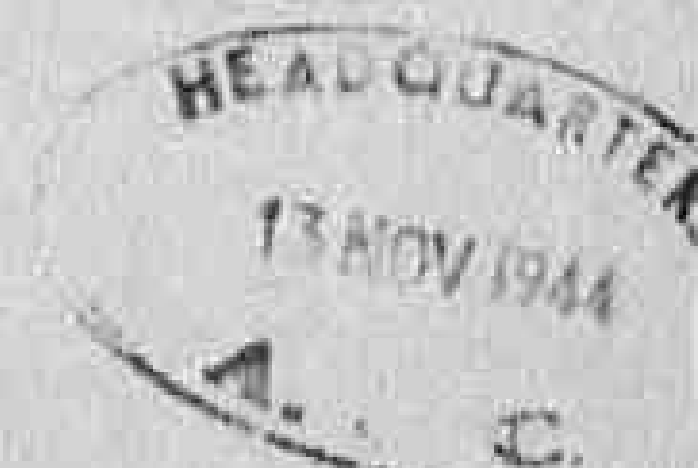
