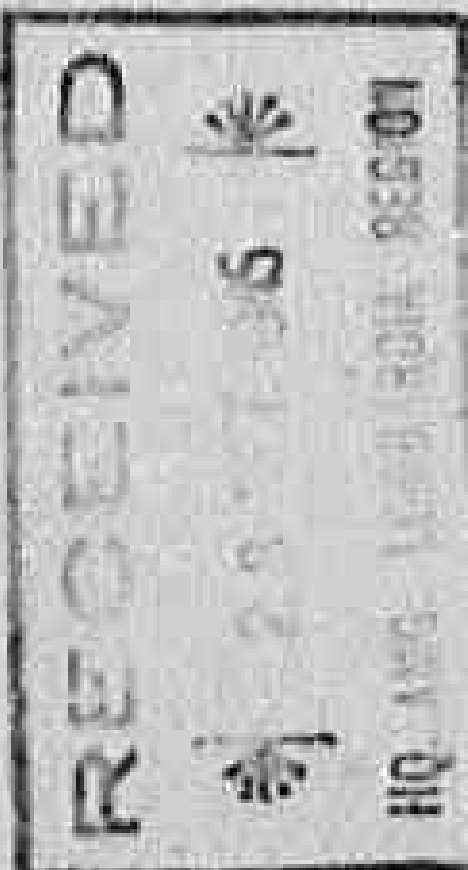

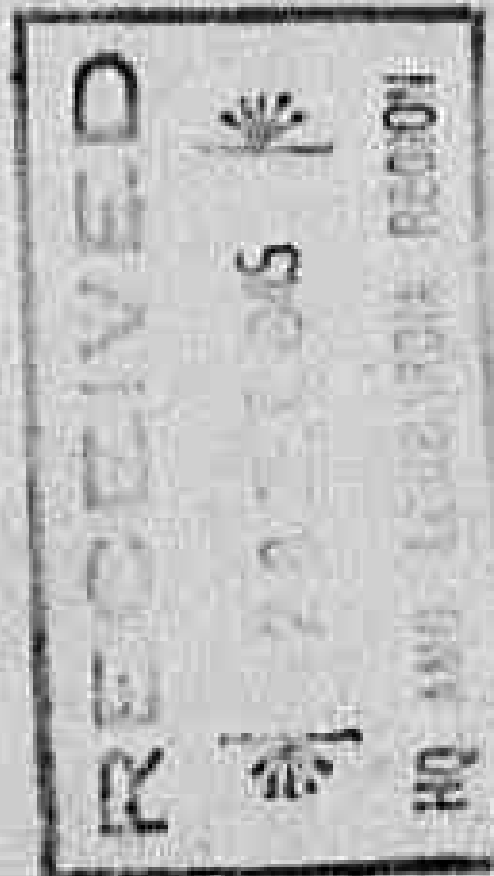

I the undersigned FERRARI Antonino, res. at Sgurgola (Frosinone) bring to your notice the following:

At evening of 5th June I was told that my house had caught fire. At that moment I was with three British Officers of whom I was interpreter. The Officer Commanding (American), who had come to Sgurgola for interview with the Mayor and the Administration of Comune, sent me and a French Officer to see what has happened.

We found a drunk Canadian soldier, who was the author of the fire and who also set fire to a straw-riek near by (that was not my property). The French Officer reported the fact to the above mentioned American Officer, Captain Walter B. Fowler, who told me to make a claim and present it to the British Military Command.

At that time the Canadians were camping on the other bank of the river Sacco.

The house was considerably damaged by the fire and besides some foodstuffs, linen, suits, dresses, animals etc were lost.

My house has given shelter and food to some fugitive British Officers, for more than 6 months.

I have already made a claim, but I do not know whether it has been forwarded to the competent Authority. Therefore I ask you again to compensate me for damages suffered in this incident. I am not rich and my economical conditions are now very bad.

1. Reference your 114/EST of 31 August requesting information "of the grounds upon which payment of these bills, presented to the local Finance Officer before the Region closed, was refused."
2. Please inform this Sub-Commission of the grounds upon which payment should be made. We are unaware that any authority exists under AFHQ instructions for using public funds to pay for hotel accommodation. The only exception that we know of is the case of isolated or touring AMG/AC officers who cannot obtain proper military accommodation. Accommodation for military personnel should be provided in properly requisitioned premises.
3. We do not know why this hotel was not properly requisitioned by AMG. Unless there were special circumstances ruling which prevented the requisitioning, it would appear that the whole position was irregular and this Sub-Commission would require specific authority before payment could be made.
4. If Establishment Section can satisfy themselves that this payment is authorised under AFHQ instructions ruling in the theatre and if the specific authorisation of the Executive Commissioner is obtained, Finance Sub-Commission will proceed to make the payment.
