1. The Finance Sub-Commission has had a request from G-4(B) for a policy decision on the disposal of property purchased from AC/AMG funds.

2. The attached telegram from Sicilia Region is an example of the problem that will face AC/AMG as regions close down.

3. I assume that before any property is disposed of, the HQ Commandant or corresponding officer in the various regions will be allowed to transfer any items needed for continued use by AC/AMG.

4. Two methods of disposal are open: sale on the open market or turn-over to the Italian Government. I strongly recommend the latter on several grounds: (a) inasmuch as AC/AMG expenditures are charged to the Italian Government, that Government should be allowed to decide whether it will keep office machinery, furniture, etc., for its own use or sell it to private interests. The Italian Government undoubtedly has large demands for equipment for reorganized departments and offices, and it would be a measure of economy to retain for its own use the equipment received from us, especially in view of the increasing scarcity and cost of such items. (b) a hand-over of purchased equipment en bloc to a designated official of the Italian Government will spare the few AC officers left in regions recently closed of the laborious task of selling the various

items, collecting and accounting for the proceeds, etc. (c) inasmuch as AC/AMG property records are far from complete, it would be dangerous to begin selling property which, it may develop, was never purchased but regularly or irregularly requisitioned. It would be far better merely to hand over physically all such property and put the "sorting-out" responsibility onto the Italian Government, who will in any case, by AFHQ decision, have the job of settling all unpaid bills and requisitions of the Allied forces. ④

5. If you are in agreement, I would suggest that the types of property listed in the attached cable be turned over to the Intendente di Finanza, Palermo, against a complete descriptive, quantitative receipt. Two copies of such receipts should be sent to this Sub-Commission. } Jack C.M.P.
