MEMORANDUM FOR VICE PRESIDENT, ESTABLISHMENT SECTION.

Subject: Assignment - Capt. J. R. B. Turner,
Sardinia Region

1. Captain J. R. B. Turner, Regional Commerce Officer, Sardinia Region, has applied for transfer to the Mainland.

2. The Regional Commissioner states that Capt. Turner has done excellent work in the Region and he does not wish to stand in the way of a move for him as he has been in Sardinia for over one year. If the transfer is made, however, the Regional Commissioner states he will require a capable replacement to be in charge of Commerce and Labor. The Port of Cagliari, previously run by the Allied Garrison, is an additional commitment.

3. Commerce S/C does not agree that a replacement is required in the Region and, furthermore, state they urgently require the services of Capt. Turner at this headquarters in the Foreign Trade Section.

4. Industry S/C are also of the opinion that no replacement is necessary as the Coal Division officer in the Region can look after their interests.

5. Labor S/C, however, state that Capt. Turner acted as Labor Officer and a replacement would be essential, but they have no officer available as a replacement. The replacement need not be a trained labor officer so long as he has some economic background.

6. G-1 (B) state that there is no Labor Officer available for replacement.
