SUBJECT: Security Cases Pending before AMG Courts

TO : Chief Commissioner, Allied Commission, APO 394, US Army.

1. This headquarters is making every effort to effect a rapid disposition of the cases of Allied security prisoners held in the Rome Area. With reference to those persons arrested during 1944, I wish to call to your attention the cases listed in paragraph 2. In the first two cases, AG personnel are making the necessary preparations for trial; in the last three cases, GIC have completed the preparations. All of the cases are to be tried by an AMG court under your general supervision

1. It is my view that a proper request from the Italian Government for Allied intervention should be acceded to only if the disturbance or disorder endangers allied personnel, allied property, or installations, whether allied or Italian, which would have adverse effect upon the prosecution of the war.

2. The measure to be adopted in the event that such a request is acceded to, is the reinstitution of Allied Military Government in the political subdivision or subdivisions effected, that is to say, province, commune or governorate.
