The following WFOUSA c333, PX 52457, dated 9 November 1945 is quoted for the information of all concerned

"Clarification second sentence paragraph 2 Dated FX 50262 regarding Civil Affairs officers which reads 'date agreed on must be subsequent to date officer becomes eligible for relief from active duty' follows.

'Date officer becomes eligible for relief from active duty' is date critical score is equal to or below officers adjusted service rating score. One whose Mos is included on list of scarce categories officer specialists may be retained 6 months beyond date of his separation eligibility without his consent. Same officer may be continued on extended active duty beyond 6 months period referred to in preceding sentence with his consent by signing specified volunteer statement.

If an officer whose Mos is on list scarce categories of officer specialists consents to remain on active duty for a period which expires less than 6 months from date of his separation eligibility he may be retained without his consent for remaining portion of 6 months period but not longer."

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Section IV, Circular #67, MTOUSA, cs, as amended by Circular #118, MTOUSA, cs, is quoted for the information, guidance and compliance of all concerned:

"IV - USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Motor vehicles will be used only for official business, including the special uses set forth in paragraph 2c and 2d, below.

2. Motor vehicles owned or operated by the US Army or by agencies under its control will not be used to transport civilian personnel except the following:

a. United States citizens employed by US Government agencies or by the American Red Cross, and members of the immediate families of such citizens.

b. Members of the immediate families of US military personnel.

c. When transportation is available without detriment to official business, entertainers and party guests may be transported in connection with properly authorized group activities of a recreational welfare and moral building nature. In the interest of economy, personnel in this category will, whenever possible, be transported by groups in large vehicles, rather than singly or in small numbers in several small vehicles.

d. In vehicles being used for official business, but only when their presence is necessary for the accomplishment of the official business for which the trip is being made. Transportation of employees to and from work will be considered to fall in this category but only when such transportation is actually necessary in order to obtain needed labor.

e. Officers and enlisted personnel of Allied or co-belligerent nations may be transported. They may be required to exhibit adequate identification and official documents showing them on leave or travel status."

2. Specific Provisions a. Only the following officers of this Regiment have authority to authenticate trip tickets for the transportation of civilians under the provisions of paragraph 2c above:

- (1) Commanding Officer, 2675th Regiment.
- (2) Executive Officer, 2675th Regiment.
- (3) Company Commanders.

(4) Company Executive Officers.

(5) Company Motor Transport Officers (American only).

b. Officers designated in a(3), (4) and (5), will in no case delegate this authority except upon written approval of this headquarters.

c. Members of immediate families transported under the provisions of paragraphs 2a and 2d above, and civilians transported under the provisions of paragraph 2c above, will be required to read and sign the release form contained in Appendix "A" hereto, which will be prepared in both English and Italian by using units. These signed release forms will be retained in unit files for a period of one (1) year after which they may be destroyed.

d. Trip tickets will be made out to a definite destination and the names of civilian passengers will be entered either on the trip ticket or on a separate sheet of paper attached thereto. Officers designated in paragraph 2a above will satisfy themselves that the civilians listed on the trip ticket are authorized to use Government motor transport under the provisions of this directive and have signed the release form attached as Exhibit "A".

SUBJECT: Application for Temporary Duty in the United States.

TO : All Units this Regiment.

1. Effective with the month of November 1945 this organization will have a monthly quota for qualified personnel to be returned to the United States for temporary duty of 45 days duration.

2. All personnel who possess the following qualifications may apply for this temporary duty.

a. Officers.

- (1) A minimum of 18 months continuous overseas service.
- (2) Must be in one of the following categories; Regular Army, Class "A" Volunteer, or ASRS of below 70.

b. Enlisted Men.

- (1) A minimum of 18 months continuous overseas service.
- (2) Must be in one of the following categories; Regular Army, Class I Volunteer, or ASRS of below 45.

3. Applications may be submitted without regard to quota. In the event the number of applications exceed the quota allocated to this headquarters for any particular period the most deserving cases, determined from information submitted by applicants, will be approved first.

4. Applications will be submitted on the form appended to this letter as Appendix #1. It is necessary that each statement in the letter of application be completed.

5. The application will be forwarded to the person under whom the applicant actually performs duty for accomplishment of the 1st Indorsement, who will in turn forward it so as to reach this headquarters not later than the 15th of the month preceding the requested effective date.

Maintenance for T/E vehicles of 2675th Regiment, Allied Commission (Ovhd)...I

I---MAINTENANCE FOR T/E VEHICLES OF 2675TH REGIMENT, ALLIED COMMISSION (OVHD)

1. Under authority contained in MTOUSA cable, FX 20055, dated 9 July 1945, this Regiment has been authorized to draw from P.B.S. Ordnance Base Depot a fifteen day supply of spare parts (including third echelon) for the maintenance of W.D. vehicles presently included in the regimental T/E.
2. The Regimental Transportation Officer has drawn the initial fifteen day supply based on the regimental T/E. This supply will be apportioned to the active companies, except Co. "J", "M" & "T", in accordance with their needs, taking into consideration the amount of available supplies.
3. All companies of this regiment, except Co. "J", "M" & "T", will forward their initial requisition without delay, to the Regimental Transportation Officer, showing parts on hand and required. Requisitions will be based on T/E WD vehicles (not civilian requisitioned vehicles). A certificate will accompany each requisition stating that parts required are to be used ONLY on WD vehicles.

- a. Co. "M" vehicles will be carried on the strength of Co. "R" and will be given 3rd Echelon M1 at Co. "R".
- b. Co. "J" vehicles will be maintained by the nearest US Army Ordnance.
- c. Co. "T" vehicles will be maintained at Headquarters.

4. Re-supply requisitions will be placed direct on the following sub-depots in accordance with the following schedule:

5. In the event that parts required are unavailable at the sub-depot an unavailability tally-in should be obtained and used as a basis to requisition the required parts from the Regimental Transportation Officer. No Company of 2675th Regiment will place a direct requisition with the Main P.B.S. Ordnance Base Depot.

6. Company Commanders will be held responsible for the accounting of all Ordnance supplies. Stock records (WD, AGO form No. 421) will be kept and periodic checks will be made to ascertain the accuracy of records, as well as the proper use of supplies (sample is attached).

SUBJECT: Applications for Employment in the State Department as Foreign Service Officers.

TO : All Concerned.

1. This headquarters has received from the War Department application forms for employment in the State Department as Foreign Service Officers, available to all members of this command.

2. Foreign Service Officers comprise counselors of embassy or legation, diplomatic secretaries, consul generals, consuls and vice-consuls. All of these positions generally start with a minimum salary of \$2500.00 per year, but may be waived in exceptional circumstances up to \$3400.00. These positions are available to all members of the armed forces, both officer and enlisted personnel providing they meet the qualifications set forth below:

a. Educational - An applicant must have received a bachelor or other equivalent degree from a college or university accredited by recognized national or regional accrediting agencies, or, if his college course in such a college or university was interrupted by his entrance into the armed forces, must have completed approximately three-fourths of the course required for a bachelor or other equivalent degree.

b. Language - An applicant must be able to read with reasonable facility at least one of the following languages, French, German or Spanish.

c. Efficiency Ratings - If an applicant is a commissioned, warrant or flight officer, his last efficiency rating must have been at least "excellent". Official efficiency ratings will not be a determining factor for an enlisted man.

d. The applicant must have been born between 1 July 1915 and 1 July 1924.

e. Citizenship - The applicant must have been a citizen of the United States for at least 15 years prior to 1 July 1945.

f. Marital Status - The applicant may not be married to an alien.

g. Military Service - The applicant must have a minimum of 1 year active military service on 1 July 1945.

Officers or enlisted men who meet the qualifications enumerated above may request an application blank from this headquarters. All persons receiving such application must return them to this headquarters prior to 18 August 1945.

3. Upon receipt by this headquarters, all application blanks will be forwarded to the State Department where they will be screened and if the applicant is selected to take the written examination, he will be so notified through War Department channels as to the date and place of the examination.

4. Successful candidates will be placed on an eligibility list, and may be called to active service if they can be released from the armed forces without prejudice to the war effort.

I-----ISSUING OF UNITED STATES ARMY SUPPLIES

1. To facilitate and expedite the drawing of United States Army supplies, the Regimental Supply Office, this Regiment, will operate a breakdown point at Lehigh for Northern Companies desiring to draw supplies from the Regimental Supply. In order to function properly, it will be necessary for interested Companies to cooperate as follows:

a. Requisitions will be submitted in duplicate so as to reach this Headquarters on or before the 10th and 25th of each month to cover the respective two week periods. Those received after the above dates will be held over for the next drawing period.

b. Quartermaster requisitions will be separated into two (2) groups:

- (1) Initial Issue: Any item not previously drawn or consumed will be listed on the initial issue requisition.
- (2) Replacement Issue: Items consumed such as stationery, cleaning and preserving material, and clothing and individual equipment covered by a salvage certificate or Statement of Charges, will be listed on the replacement issue requisition.

c. Requisitions for Chemical Warfare, Medical, Engineer, Ordnance, and Special Service items will be submitted in the usual manner.

d. Requisitions will be submitted to cover a two week period only.

e. Requisitions received on or before the 10th and 25th of each month will be available for pickup at 1200 hours on the 17th and 2nd of each month at the Stars and Stripes building on Highway #1, Lehigh.

f. Effective with the semi-monthly drawing period beginning 15th July 1945, the new Northern Regimental breakdown point will operate.

II-----ISSUING OF OFFICERS SPECIAL SERVICE MERCHANDISE

1. Effective with August issue Officers Special Service Merchandise, Whiskey Ration, will also be issued from the Lehigh Regimental breakdown point. Rations will be forwarded in the usual manner; cash will be presented at time of drawing and will not be forwarded as previously directed.
