They had not any details and Melson accordingly asked me to phone Brig. Henn, which I did, and also apoke to Col. Lewin-Harris. As I understand it, the position is that although they approve the suggested ranks and numbers of officers and ORs, they are unwilling to support the recommendation of HQ 15th Army Group that such personnel should be transferred to their Increment. will in no way however affect their dual functions as being on the Staff of DCCAO and G-5."



To be dishonorably discharged the service, to forfeit all pay and allowances due or to become due, and to be confined at hard labor at such place as the reviewing authority may direct, for eighteen months.

The sentence was adjudged on 25 September 1944.

The findings of guilty under Charge I and its Specification are disapproved. The sentence is approved, and, Article of War 50% having been complied with, will be duly executed. The Eastern Branch, United States Disciplinary Barracks, Groonhaven, New York, is designated as the place of confinement, but pending further orders the prisoner will be held at MTOUS. Disciplinary Training Center.
