SUBJECT: Regional Requisitioning Officer.

TO : Regional Commissioner,
Piemonte Region,
Allied Military Government.

1. Due to pressure from higher U.S. authority and recent directives governing responsibility and accountability on requisitioned civilian vehicles, it will be necessary that Company Commanders in each Region of Allied Commission be designated as Regional Requisitioning Officer in addition to their other duties.

2. Since all U.S. requisitioned vehicles are now considered to be U.S. War Department vehicles, it will be necessary to include these vehicles in a Property Book, and it is felt that Company Commander being familiar with Accountability Procedure could best do this work.

3. All U.S. requisitioned property including vehicles held in your Region will be shipped to G.O. Company "S" on or about 1 May 1945.

4. All Commanding Officers were notified that this change would be requested at a unit commanders meeting held in Rome on 21 April 1945 and their duties defined and explained.

5. Unit Commanders then, will be responsible in addition to civilian motor vehicles for all property included in Establishment Memorandum Number 5 of 22 March 1945.

6. Therefore it is requested that 1st Lt. J.A. Davis, G.O. Company "S" be appointed the Regional Requisitioning Officer Piemonte Region, and will assume all requisitioning function heretofore handled by Major P.L. Johnson.

7. It is also requested that Paragraph 10 (b) of Establishment Memorandum Number 21 of 3 September 1944 be complied with as soon as possible.
