MEMORANDUM

TO : Col. M. E. Fiske.

1. The International Red Cross at present are in possession of two vehicles (their own property) bearing ACC four digit registration certificates which entitles them to POL and maintenance from AC.
2. Their representatives state that continuance of POL issue and service are necessary since they work in conjunction with Sub-Commission of AC in performance of their duties, i.e., delivery of letters to PW's and visit I.D.P.&R. refugee camps.
3. A ruling is requested as to whether or not these certificates should be withdrawn and POL and maintenance stopped. Permits were authorized by Col. Clough at a previous date.

1. Allied Commission through their Public Safety Division has called our attention to the fact that P.W.B., C.I.C. and similar units as well as French and other Allied Commands using civilian vehicles frequently request issue of motor vehicle circulating permits without the accompanying fuel ration cards, presumably because these services procure their POL from military petrol points.

2. These cars are frequently without W.D. number and are being operate as requisitioned or rented equipment.

3. This practise leads to abuse of POL and defets the idea of preventing petrol from going to the black market. It is requested that the following instructions be given.

- ✓ (a) All military or allied units must comply with paragraph 6, Section II of AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No. 59 of 13 December 1944 as regards registration of requisitioned vehicles with a military registration number.
- ✓ (b) Units using vehicles not thus registered will not be serviced at military petrol points and instructions to petrol points should be given accordingly.
- ✓ (c) If units, continue to use unregistered vehicles these will be treated as civilian cars and will procure their POL only through issue of circulation permits, ration coupons and POL will be supplied only upon payment at established civilian prices.
