SUBJECT: Requisitioned Vehicles

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394

1. On 6 March a letter was sent to Allied Commission ref T-13 on the subject of "Requisitioned Vehicles." This letter authorized 750 vehicles to be held surplus to TE/WB for civilian personnel attached to the A.C. and outlined a detailed procedure whereby all vehicles theretofore requisitioned were to be returned to the Italian Government and loaned back by it to the Allied Commission for essential operations. It is understood that action has not been completed in this manner. At a conference held at this HQ on 19 May 1945, at which members of G-4(A) and G-4(B) of Allied Commission were present, it was determined that a total of 1,410 Italian vehicles have been requisitioned by or for AG/AMO personnel for civil affairs operations. All these vehicles are presently accounted for by the 2675th Regt. Allied Commission (Cvhq). It was explained that only 780 of these 1,410 vehicles are presently possessed. Of the remainder approximately 40 are unaccounted for.

2. If such action has not already been taken it is requested that the Allied Commission, by exchange of letters with the Italian Government, obtain agreement that all requisitioned vehicles now or previously requisitioned by U.S. or British agencies for use of AG/AMO shall be deemed to have been delivered to the competent Italian authorities under legislative decree No. 46 of 1 Feb 1945 and that all liability in respect thereof rests upon the Italian Government. Arrangements should at the same time be made whereby 750 vehicles authorised by our letter of 6 March and such additional requisitioned vehicles as may be necessary to fill deficiencies in A.C. authorized TE/WB will be loaned to the allied Commission for essential purposes. Sufficient documents covering the requisition of vehicles now or previously held by allied Commission should be furnished to the Italian government, with a statement that such vehicles were acquired for joint US/UK use. The undertaking of the Italian Government should provide for similar treatment of vehicles hereafter requisitioned for use of A.C.

2. Shipping tickets made out to Major Maunder for all vehicles shown in paragraph 1 (a) above, are attached herewith. Major Maunder will sign and return one (1) copy of each shipping ticket and thus be the responsible

officer to G-4 (A) for the accountability of these cars assigned to him. In event of transfer, Major Maunder will notify this office of transfer of property may be made to his successor and Major Maunder relieved of his responsibility.

3. In event that any of the presently assigned serviceable vehicles become unserviceable, authority to turn these vehicles over to the Inspectorate Compartimentale must be obtained from G-4 (A) in writing.

4. An officer should be designated to handle all administrative matters concerning assigned requisitioned cars and all pertinent data in Establishment Memorandum, salvage certificates, transfer receipts, all attached for information and guidance. Special attention is directed to monthly Return to reach this Headquarters not later than 5th of each month.

5. Any question concerning vehicles assigned to your province will gladly be answered upon written request.

SUBJECT: Disposition of Scrap (Requisitioned Vehicles).

TO : See Distribution.

1. Many Regions have written to this headquarters requesting instructions for proper disposal of remnants of requisitioned vehicles which have been scrapped, also stating that these hulks of vehicles could not be used advantageously.

2. All Regions having any such property will make arrangements to turn it over to the Italian Government Authorities in their respective areas and will obtain official receipts signed by competent Italian Government officials. Receipts will be obtained in triplicate and a copy sent to G-4 (A), this headquarters.

3. Provincial Commissioners should be made familiar with these instructions immediately in order to expedite turnover of such property in the areas under their jurisdiction.

4. The Regional Requisitioning Officer in each Region should be the officer designated to effect such transfer of property as he is responsible for all requisitioned vehicle records.

SUBJECT: Assignment of Civilian Requisitioned Vehicles.

TO : Headquarters Commandant.

ATTENTION:

1. It has been agreed that in order to avoid the duplication in records within this headquarters the Headquarters Commandant as Headquarters Transportation Officer be responsible for making direct assignments of civilian vehicles to those authorized by Establishment Memorandum 31, dated 25 November 1944. To date all such assignments have been made by G-4 (A).

2. That will leave only two (2) units having vehicles on direct assignments from G-4 (A), the 1st Truck Battalion and D.P.A.R. Sub-Commission. The reason for retention of direct control of the vehicles on strength of these two units is that G-4 (A) is better equipped to handle the necessary paper work and accounting procedure for these vehicles which for the most part operate outside of Rome.

3. Memorandum Receipts held by G-4 (A) for these vehicles now on direct assignment (see Appendix A) will be transmitted to Headquarters Commandant who will in turn sign Memorandum Receipts to G-4 (A) for same vehicles. Headquarters Transportation Officer should notify those persons to whom vehicles are permanently assigned that they are responsible to Headquarters Transportation Officer. Headquarters Transportation Officer becomes then responsible to G-4 (A).

4. Completion of the above will be effected as soon as possible.
