Please give following further information for our guidance. At conference held in ROME Monday 13 August following proposed vehicle establishment was circulated with agenda. For AMG UDINE 1 staff car 3 cars light utility 26 jeeps 3 lorries 3 ton plus 4 vehicles for US Company HQ. For VENEZIA liaison group including displaced persons 1 staff car 4 cars light utility 23 jeeps 3 lorries 3 ton. Vehicles for proposed BOLZANO liaison group not settled at conference. Am assuming provision of these vehicles is first charge on our existing holding. My notes of conference record that captured vehicles could be held in place of jeeps. In view greatly reduced dependability propose holding 1 and half requisitioned or captured vehicles against 1 WD vehicle on establishment until WD are available for issue.

Reference the attached correspondence.

1. As you know, the two regions concerned are equipped with U.S. vehicles and we shall probably soon receive similar demands from Venezia, which is equipped with British vehicles.

2. You will have observed that 22 vehicles are required, so presumably at least 22 officers are earmarked. If we knew what these officers are doing now, we might find they are using vehicles today which could go with them.

3. Availability from G-4 (B) depends on issues between now and the time when these regions are occupied.

4. At present we have not sufficient vehicles in the pool to cope with Venezia when they need vehicles.

5. Investigation as in para. 2 might produce something, otherwise I can only suggest awaiting new issues, or taking impressed vehicles out of the Headquarter Pool.

TO: Headquarters Allied Commission, (Att: G-4)

1. The number of vehicles requested in the basic letter cannot be met out of the transportation allotted to this Headquarters.

2. A careful survey of the situation and plans indicate that there will be required immediately upon entry into the Region 10 of the vehicles required and the remainder 5 days after entry. The availability of these vehicles at the proper time will be essential if roads, bridges, aqueduct systems, electrical generating plants and lines and communication lines are to be serviced. Without this service these utilities will not function and the AMG/AC Organization will be subject to criticism.

3. Therefore it is requested that the vehicles requested be made available from either military transport or civilian transport in operating condition.

1. I am attaching hereto some correspondence received from the Regional Engineer of Abruzzi-Marche Region regarding his difficulties in obtaining automobiles for his staff. I note particularly that, in the letter of 13th December 1944, the Regional Transport Officer states that he is unable to furnish cars " due to prohibition of further requisitioning".

2. In view of the fact that all Engineer Officers, whether at Headquarters or in Regions, must be able to go to the scene of their activity to make inspections and to carry out their duties, it must be obvious that they just cannot function and be held responsible for the tasks assigned to them, if they have no means of reaching locations of projects.

3. Col. Latimer asks that a passenger car, preferably a WD car, be assigned to his Region for the use of one of his officers. Will you please see what can be done to either : -

- (a) permit Regional Officers to requisition cars locally which would be the simplest way, or
- (b) to furnish transportation form A.C. Headquarters and advise me accordingly.

Dear Dusty,

1. Thank you for your letter of 21 March 1945. I much appreciate you writing to me personally.
2. Regarding the staff car I feel sure that you do not know that the Executive Commissioner promised Colonel Monfort that the Ford staff car would be exchanged for a Humber Snipe when you received a new quota of cars that were expected shortly.
3. If the British personnel had been transferred to the W.E. of Headquarters 15th Army Group it would have been their responsibility to supply adequate transportation for Lt. Col. Stewart and myself which G.D. had promised to do.
4. As however we are remaining on the strength of Allied Commission, it is their responsibility to provide adequate transportation.
5. The Ford staff car is old and although it has been driven well and kept by Dvr. Harvey who has taken a pride in his job and who has been with me for over a year, at the same time it is not in good condition, - far from it. Nevertheless it is preferable to a P.U. or Jeep and if there is not a new Humber Snipe available which the Executive Commissioner understood would be the case, I should be obliged if you would represent to the Headquarters Commandant and to the officer who presided at your conference of 20 March 1945 that I should retain the use of the Ford staff car.
6. Pending hearing from you, I have not written to the Headquarters Commandant.

1. Reference paragraph 2 attached report, it is the opinion of this office that very little differentiation can be made between the thirty four (34) vehicles listed as "Permanently Assigned" from Headquarters Motor Pool and the twenty six (26) vehicles directly assigned from the office of G-4 (A) in accordance with Establishment Memorandum 31, dated 28 November 1944.
2. It is proposed therefore that the Headquarters Commandant, as Headquarters Transportation Officer, take over, for matter of record and to avoid duplication in records, the twenty six (26) vehicles mentioned above.
3. That would leave only two (2) units having vehicles on direct assignment from this office, 1st Truck Battalion and D.P.&R. S.C.
4. The reason for retention of direct control of the vehicles on strength of D.P.&R. S.C. and 1st Truck Battalion, is that this office is better equipped to handle the necessary paper work and accounting for vehicles operating outside of Rome.
5. The details of transfer can satisfactorily be worked out between Headquarters Commandant and this office.
6. Maintenance on all headquarters requisitioned civilian vehicles is still the responsibility of the Headquarters Transportation Officer.
7. Latest figures of G-4 (A) direct assignments are shown in Appendix "A".
8. Reference par 15 (b) attached report, conversion of jeep wheels is not justified as there are jeeps in A.C. without spares.

MEMORANDUM TO: Colonel Clough

1. Confirming conversation Colonel Clough-Major Doe-Captain Volstad today, it is my understanding that you intend to assign 2 or 3 additional weapons carriers to Liguria Region. I also understand that you may be able to let the Region have another 2½ ton 6 x 6. I should be grateful if you could let me know by Monday when this transportation will be available so that I may send drivers down to pick it up.

2. Thank you for your permission to requisition civilian transport in regions other than our own, provided requisitioning has the approval of the regional headquarters in control of the area in which the requisitioning is carried out and provided regular rules issued by ACC HQ covering requisitioning of civilian vehicles are adhered to.

3. In regard to our Ford staff car (British), Colonel Miller stated that if a BLR certificate were obtained from the REHC, that this vehicle, now useless, could be turned in in exchange for another vehicle. Colonel Miller said that he would request Colonel Scoggins to issue a weapons carrier in place of this Ford staff car. This would be acceptable and even preferable to another British vehicle as that would simplify maintenance since all of our vehicles are American except this one staff car. In the event that a weapons carrier in addition to the extra ones to be assigned to the Region cannot be given us in exchange for the staff car, then Colonel Miller's offer of a PU in its stead will be acceptable.

ASSIGNMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

1. In order to provide adequate military and civilian transportation for operational needs of newly activated Regions, it has become necessary to reduce the number of military and civilian vehicles at Headquarters, ACC.

2. With regard to assignment of civilian vehicles in Headquarters, ACC, commencing from this date on, the following will govern:

a. Vehicles will be assigned to Branches, Sections, and Sub-Commissions and not to individuals, with exception of those individuals listed in (b) below.

b. Vehicles will be assigned on the basis of one per each General Officer and Chiefs or Heads of Branches, Sections, and Sub-Commissions and one vehicle for every additional four officers assigned.

c. Requests for assignment of vehicles will be forwarded to Office of O-4 (A), Headquarters, ACC, for necessary action.

3. It is strongly urged that Heads of Sections, Branches, and Sub-Commissions instruct their officers that the vehicle situation is a precarious one and that every effort be made to protect vehicles in their care.
