MEMORANDUM:

TO : Colonel Fiske.

Recommendations:

1. To move to the Majestic Hotel 31 American officers from the Flora and 20 American officers from the California and Bella Vista, thus making a total of 101 Americans at the Majestic, where an all-American mess will be established.

2. To move 22 British officers and civilians from the Bella Vista to the Flora where, together with the 95 British officers and civilians already there, an all-British Mess can be formed of 117 officers and civilians.

3. The Inghilterra Hotel is at present occupied entirely by American officers and civilians, with the exception of 5 beds.

4. Approval of this recommendation will therefore have the following results:

- (a) The derequisitioning of the California and the Bella Vista.
- (b) The Flora will be completely British with a British Mess and accommodation for 223 persons.
- (c) The occupation of the Majestic Hotel.
- (d) The Majestic and Inghilterra will be completely American with an American Mess and accommodation for 209 persons.

SUBJECT: Garage Located at Via Tommaso Campanella #10

TO : Commanding General, Rome Area Allied Command,
APO 794.

ATTENTION: Real Estate Section

1. Formal request is hereby submitted for the derequisitioning, to Italian Ministry of Interior, of garage located at Via Tommaso Campanella #10, Rome, which has been occupied for some time by Allied Commission.
2. This garage has been used by G-4 (A) Section of A.C. to store and maintain civilian requisitioned vehicles.
3. In accordance with instructions received from higher headquarters some two hundred civilian vehicles have been transferred to the Ispettorato Compartimentale della Motorizzazioni of Rome and since the above mentioned agency has been unable to locate space to store these vehicles, it was agreed with the Ministry of Interior to permit the Ispettorato to use this garage at Via Tommaso Campanella when it had been derequisitioned, for disposition of these cars.
4. At present G-4 (A), A.C. have removed all other property from these premises which now contain original inventory stock plus the two hundred transferred vehicles.
5. It is therefore requested that these premises be derequisitioned as soon as possible to the Italian Ministry of Interior. It is emphasized that besides allowing the Ispettorato to expedite return of these vehicles to their owners, this garage is urgently needed by the Italian Police Force under the Ministry of Interior.
6. It will be greatly appreciated if this matter be given your immediate attention.

SUBJECT : Requisition of Villa Ily.

TO : Lt. Col. G. L. Warren,
Deputy Commissioner, Naples Commune.

It has come to my knowledge that Villa Ily at Ponte Grande Catanzaro was requisitioned last Monday 1 October 1945 by the Prefetto of Catanzaro for a group of British Engineers.

Villa Ily, actually the property of Signora Mariato, has been rented during the last ten years to Baronessa Marincola, an American citizen, and all the furniture, house-linen, silver and private possessions such as jewels, furs, clothing etc. belong to her.

Villa Ily was derequisitioned on 20 August 1944 by A.M.C. which had used it as Headquarters since September 1943.

In view to the fact that the above mentioned Villa was requisitioned for so long a period of time and that, after it was derequisitioned, Baronessa Marincola spent a large sum of money for repairs, would it not be possible to avoid this happening again? If this should not be feasible, considering that everything in the house belongs to Baronessa Marincola who is an American citizen, could her own property not be protected? At any rate a full inventory should be made as required by regulations.

1. We have received many inquiries from owners of requisitioned vehicles asking us if there is any chance of their vehicles being returned, and if not, what is the chance of their being paid for the vehicles.
2. Those holding regular requisition slips, we have referred to the Genio Militare through civilian channels.
3. If you have any information regarding the ultimate disposal of these cars, especially those requisitioned by Allied Commission, we should be glad to have it so that we may pass the information on to the former owners.
4. A copy of a sample requisition is enclosed. The owner of the car, Baron Alberghetti Tommaso, states that the car is now in Florence and has asked if there is a chance of his getting it back. This is a typical type of requisition and a typical request, and is forwarded to you for your information.

In December 1942 the Civil Engineers Office, located in a specially built building owned by the State in Via Marchese Capodisola 21, was moved, in view of military operations, to several unsuitable rooms in the National Museum of Naples. The office is still temporarily set up in these rooms and endeavoring to overcome difficulties which greatly reduce its working efficiency. Moreover, the said rooms have been requested by the Ministry of Public Instruction which had placed them temporarily at the disposal of the Civil Engineers.

Since the "Ispettorato Superiore" of the Civil Engineers of Naples has informed us that the building in Via Capodisola, at present used as barracks by the R. Navy, are shortly to be evacuated, we wish to request you to examine the possibility of restoring the said building to the Civil Engineers in Naples.
