SUBJECT: Attachment of Company "G", 2675th Regiment, AG, to 5th Army
TO : SCAG, AMG, 5th Army.

1. Reference is made to your 11/5, of 6 January 1945, to C.O. 2675th Regt., A.G., and as the undersigned is also the C.O. of this regiment, this reply will be considered as the answer from Hq. A.G. and Hq. 2675th Regt. A.G.

2. The question of attachment of Company "G" to Special Troops, Fifth Army, has been fully discussed with the staff sections concerned, and with the Chief of Staff.

3. Applicable in this case, are the provisions of:

a. General Orders No. 5, AMG, 24 Jan. 44, which states:
"THE DISBANDMENT OF HEADQUARTERS ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT, 15th ARMY GROUP: RESPONSIBILITIES OF ALLIED CONTROL COMMISSION."

1. Headquarters, Allied Military Government, 15th Army Group (now Allied Central Mediterranean Force) is disbanded. Headquarters, Allied Military Government, Fifth and Eighth Armies, will operate under the operational command of Commanders Fifth and Eighth Armies and under the technical control of Headquarters, Allied Control Commission.

2. All Italian territory not under Allied Military Government will be administered by the Italian Government, under the direction of the Allied Control Commission.

3. A Regional Organization on the present lines will be maintained until further orders. The responsibility for all territory now under Headquarters Allied Military Government passes to Headquarters, Allied Control Commission."

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(Attachment of Company "G", 2675th Regiment, AC, to 5th Army - Cont'd)

b. Administrative Memorandum No. 38, AFHQ, 8 September 1944, which states:

"5. b. The provision in Paragraph 1 of Section III, AFHQ General Orders Number 5, 1944, to the effect that Headquarters, Allied Military Government, Fifth and Eighth Armies, will operate under the operational command of Commanders Fifth and Eighth Armies and under the technical control of Headquarters Allied Control Commission, is confirmed."

4. It is fully appreciated that, from an administrative point of view, the action proposed would tend to reduce and simplify the administrative problems of AFHQ 5th Army. However, the problems which would arise from such a change of administrative structure, insofar as this Headquarters and Headquarters 2675 Regiment is concerned, would appear to be such as to make the proposed changeover inadvisable. The essence of smooth and successful operation of AC/AMG is in the close knitting together of its component units and it is not considered that, were this change to take effect, this end would be served.

3. For consideration, also, is the fact that attachment of Company "G" to 5th Army, for administrative purposes, might well be deemed at variance with the directives cited in paragraphs 3a and b, above.

MEMORANDUM:

TO : Brigadier M.S. LUSH, Chief of Staff,
Allied Commission.

Reference the letter I handed to you from Gen. HUME, about Company "G", 2675th Regiment, herewith are some thoughts on the subject:

1. The attachment of Company "G" to 5th Army would mean that both the Regiment and the Allied Commission would lose complete control of both equipment and personnel in Company "G". The Regimental S-1 would not be affected to any great degree by such a step as it might lessen the work of the S-1 Section by about 5 or 10%.

2. However, from the viewpoint of G-1 Allied Commission the disadvantages far outweigh any advantages. For example, such attachment would mean that officers in particular would be lost so far as Allied Commission was concerned. That is, the Sub-Commissions would not know the exact duties and locations, etc., these officers are doing. Subsequent procedure for transfers, etc., would have to go through the 5th Army which would delay any changes in personnel that might be made.

3. From the supply angle I will speak only of administration because at the present time the rations and PX are already taken care of by the 5th Army. However, when we come to the property control it must be borne in mind that the Regiment and Allied Commission would lose all control of jeeps, etc., At the present time 5th Army AMG has 41 jeeps. The proposed T/E drawn up by the Regiment gives the 5th Army AMG 19 jeeps. Now the, if Company "G" were attached to the 5th Army it must be understood that their excess, that is the difference between 19 and 41, be returned to the Regiment. It can be clearly seen that such an attachment would completely sever Company "G" from the Regiment and all its functions of Allied Commission from Allied Commission.

MEMO:

TO: Col. Parkin.

1. Attached is copy of transfers out of Co. G (AMG 5th. Army).
2. At no time were any transfers made with the consent of AMG 5th. Army.
3. An analysis of the figures shows 1 EM went to Det. of Patients; 4 EM on rotation and the transfer of 6 EM was agreed to or asked for. Over a period of 8 months there 6 transfers of EM out of Co. G. This could hardly be termed "frequent turnover".
4. The statistics for the officers show: 2 O. to Det. of Patients; 4 O. Rotation; 2 O. Repl. Depot; and 15 O. transferred. All of these transfers were either agreed to or requested by AMG 5th. Army.
