(Under provision Circular 84, NATCUSA, dated 21 June 1944)

TO : Commanding Officer, Peninsular Base Section, APO 782, U.S. Army.

1. It is requested that a sales account be opened for the ACC Columbia Club, U.S. Army Officers' Club in order that items of subsistence may be purchased by the club's accountable Officer, Henri P. Rancourt, 1st Lt. C.M.F.
2. In conjunction with the above request, the following information is submitted:
 - a. U.S. Officer member strength 150.
 - b. Rations are now being drawn from PRS Supply Point #1, thru R.S.O., 2675 Regiment, ACC.
 - c. This is a regularly established club which has been approved by CG, RAAC, (Commanding General of an Army or Air Force Command).
 - d. It is my understanding that sales of subsistence will be limited to \$5.00 per month per officer member, and that any items purchased will be for sandwich, dessert or beverage purposes. Items within this category will be as prescribed by Commanding General SCG NATCUSA.
3. The club will comply with the provisions of Circular 84, NATCUSA, dated 21 June 1944.
