Many enquiries have been received from Officers of this Commission regarding Post-War Administrative Appointments in European Countries and it is presumed that they refer to appointments in the Civilian Tripartite High Commissions which will eventually replace the Military Governments controlling Germany and Austria.

Although no definite plans have yet been formulated regarding the recruitment of personnel for these Civilian High Commissions applications for such appointments should be forwarded to this Headquarters in order that they may be registered.

Applications will be made on C.A. forms which will be submitted in triplicate.

Recommendations of the senior British Officer of the Region, A.M.S. Army, Branch, Section and etc are required but they will be made in the forwarding letter and NOT on the C.A. form.

A supply of C.A. forms is forwarded herewith.

Conditions of service for Post-War Administrative Appointments in other Countries, for instance, the Colonial Service, will be issued in the course of the next two or three months under an A.C.I. and applications for these appointments cannot be accepted at present.
