The authority for making such demands will be A.F.H.Q. Dangle PX 68656 of 1 May 1945.

3. Individual Refugee Centre Commanders, except in exceptional circumstances, will NOT approach Army Services except through their respective Regional Headquarters.

4. All stores equipment and assistance supplied by Army Services will be reported to F.Q., D.P. & R.S.C. weekly as at 1200 hours each Saturday.
