TO : All Units this Regiment.

In accordance with MTOUSA Circular #115, dated 24 September 1945, paragraph 8, letter, this headquarters, file and subject as above, dated 27 September 1945, is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

"8. No officer may, at any time, be considered eligible for promotion unless he is a Class A or Class B officer. Officers contemplating promotion as a result of signing Class A or Class B Certificates, are to be warned that signing the irrevocable statements is by no means a guarantee of promotion. There are no provisions made whereby an officer may withdraw his certificate to Class A or Class B for any reason, including disapproval of promotion."

SUBJECT: Redeployment of Officers.

TO : All Units this Regiment.

1. In accordance with the latest instructions received from MTCUSA concerning redeployment of Officers, the following information is published for the guidance of all Officers of this Command.

2. Effective 1 October 1945, the critical score for release for all Officers, regardless of rank, is reduced as set forth below. ASR scores computed as of 2 September 1945 will be applied in determining the status of each individual Officer.

a. Male Officers, except Medical Corps, all ranks including Warrant and Flight Officers - 75 points.

b. Male Medical Officers with ASR scores equal to, or in excess of the following, ages equal to or in excess of the following, or with other criteria as listed below will automatically become non-essential and eligible for release:

- (1) Medical and Dental Corps Officers with ASR score 80 or age 48 to nearest birthday.
- (2) Medical and Dental Corps Officers (except those with primary or secondary MOS: A, B, or C 3106; A, B, C or D 3130; A, B, C or D 3132; A, B, or C 3158; A, B or C 3303 (who entered active military duty prior to 7 December 1941).
- (3) Medical Corps Officers who have primary or secondary MOS listed in (2) above and who entered active military duty prior to 1 January 1941.
- (4) Veterinary Corps Officers with ASR score 80 or age 42 to nearest birthday, or entered active military duty prior to 1 January 1941.
- (5) Medical administrative and Sanitary Corps Officers with ASR score 70, or age 42 to nearest birthday, or entered active military duty prior to 7 December 1941.

3. Officers are to be hereafter classified for the purpose of redeployment as follows:

a. CLASS A - (An Officer who signs the irrevocable statement to remain on active service for the duration plus six (6) months.)

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Ltr. 370, Redeployment of Officers, Contd

b. CLASS B - (An Officer who elects to remain in his present assignment for a definite period of time for the purpose of completing his assignment.) Officers may become CLASS B Officers by signing a certificate to remain on duty to any date they elect which falls between the dates 6 September 1945 and 5 March 1946.

c. All other Officers will, as of 1 October 1945, be declared automatically non-essential and eligible for redeployment under the point system. Such Officers will be known as Class X, for Regimental purposes only.

4. In order to clarify the position of the three classes, as indicated in paragraph 1, the following information is submitted:

a. CLASS A Officers will remain assigned to this Regiment until such time as they may be declared surplus to the needs of the Regiment. Surplus Officers of this class will be made available to the Theater Commander for reassignment within the Theater. If surplus to the Theater, they will be made available to the War Department. If declared surplus by the War Department, they will be released from active duty.

b. CLASS B Officers, as previously indicated, must sign up to remain on active duty with this Regiment for a definite period which must fall between the dates 6 September 1945 and 5 March 1946. It is to be understood that a CLASS B Officer may be declared surplus prior to his elected termination date and be redeployed. After the termination date elected, a CLASS B Officer is automatically declared non-essential and redeployed under the point system.

c. An Officer electing immediate release, and having an ASR score above 75, may not be held for any reason by his Unit Commander or Section Director, except in cases of investigations, courts-martial or medical treatment. Those Officers, known as CLASS X, become automatically non-essential as of 1 October 1945 and will be redeployed according to the point system. Officers having the highest ASR score will be redeployed first.

5. An Officer electing to remain on active duty under the classification of A or B must sign the appropriate certificate, as indicated below. The certificates are to be signed in quintuplicate and forwarded to this Headquarters without delay. Unit Commanders are directed to contact immediately all Officers in order that they may express their desire in writing. The contents of this letter are to be thoroughly explained to each Officer prior to requesting his decision. Preliminary rosters will be forwarded by the most expeditious means, to reach this Headquarters not later than 8 October 1945. This roster will clearly indicate the desire of each Officer within the Command. This roster will be followed up by a confirmation copy with the appropriate certificates attached. This directive is to be given top priority. No reason for delay in compliance will be accepted. It is to be noted that there are no provisions made for the withdrawal of a statement for CLASS A or CLASS B, once it has been submitted. A CLASS B Officer, however, may elect to change his classification to CLASS A.

6. An Officer having submitted application for release from active duty under the provisions of Circular 485 will not necessarily be affected by this directive, except as follows:

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Ltr. 370. Redeployment of Officers. Contd

a. Officers having an ASR score of 75 or above will be released by the earliest authority.

b. Officers having ASR scores below 75 will be released upon approval of their applications under Circular 485.

7. In reference to marriage, Officers are eligible to submit applications as follows:

a. All CLASS A Officers are eligible.

b. CLASS B Officers are eligible if the processing of the application, the ninety (90) day waiting period, and the marriage can be completed prior to his elected termination date from duty. Applications now pending may be abandoned if desired.

c. No delay in shipment under the provisions of redeployment will be granted CLASS X Officers because of an outstanding marriage application. New applications may not be submitted by an Officer under this classification.

8. No Officer may, at any time, be considered eligible for promotion unless he is a CLASS A Officer. Officers contemplating promotion as a result of signing CLASS A certificate, are to be warned that signing the irrevocable statement is by no means a guarantee of promotion. There are no provisions made whereby an Officer may withdraw his certificate to CLASS A for any reason, including disapproval of promotion.

3. While these figures do not meet your request, they do correspond to the current normal spread of grades specified by the War Department. This adjustment will allow a limited number of promotions in those most worthy cases.

4. It is realized that stagnating of promotions has an adverse effect on the morale of officers; however, this situation exists in all units in the theater. Current promotion policy precludes up-grading allotments to provide spaces for promotion, except in most exceptional cases, and where such up-grading is definitely justified in order to place the unit on a normal spread of grades corresponding to that authorized by the War Department.

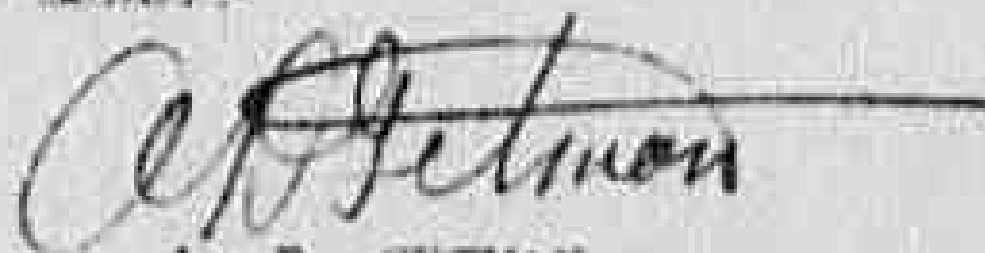
TO : All Units and Staff Sections, This Command.

1. The present War Department and Theater policy is that redeployment of personnel will be based entirely on ASRC scores. No authority will be granted to units or staff sections of this headquarters to retain high score personnel (ASRC score 85 or over, and 40 years of age) by declaring them essential. Such personnel are automatically declared non-essential. Highest ASRC personnel will go home first in the order of their ASRC.

2. An immediate survey will be made indicating the effect this procedure will have on operations. Command activities are expected to continue as usual and no slow-down will be accepted because of lack of key personnel lost by the application of this policy. This will require immediate planning. Necessary adjustments of personnel must be made in advance to insure that there will be no slow-down resulting from loss of high score personnel.

3. It is again repeated that no one will be permitted to retain high score personnel in this command. As additional information on this subject is received, it will be disseminated to all echelons. It is anticipated that all high score enlisted personnel with scores of 85 or more will be called for shipment by the end of September.

SUBJECT: Redeployment of Officers.

TO : See Distribution.

1. In order to avoid further confusion in transshipment of officers to the United States under redeployment regulations, it is requested that all personnel concerned make immediate preparations for shipment. Frequent delays have been encountered by officers failing to comply with orders for reasons of personal nature and failure to obtain adequate clearance. All officers concerned are advised to clear up their affairs, personal and official, so that shipment may be effected upon 24 hour notice. No officer, however, is to anticipate the command by leaving his present assignment until so instructed by this headquarters. This directive concerns all officers electing immediate release (Class "X") and with ASRC scores of 75 or above, and all officers, Class "E" with termination date of 15 November 1945 or sooner.

2. Identical transport arrangements as utilized in the most recent shipment of officers will be used in the future shipment of large groups of officers insofar as is possible. Tentative shipment date is not known, but will be published as soon as received.

3. Unit Commanders, Senior American Officers of Regions and Sub-Commissions will be prepared to submit manner of performance ratings on officers by cable immediately upon request of this headquarters.

I -- DISCHARGE FROM ACTIVE DUTY OF ENLISTED PERSONNEL

Paragraph 2, Circular Number 110, this headquarters, 1945, is amended as follows:

All statements reading "to the nearest Replacement Depot for transshipment to the United States" are changed to read "to the 7th Replacement Depot for transshipment to the United States".

II - FOOD AND SHELTER FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL

1. Existing theater regulations do not provide per diem for military personnel traveling on orders within the theater, no quarters and messing facilities are available at various American units and installations. It is theater policy, however, that all United States military personnel traveling on competent orders will be given food and shelter as necessity demands.

2. Unit and installation commanders will be held responsible for the enforcement of this policy and will provide food and shelter to such transient military personnel upon request.

III - MONTHLY STATISTICAL VENEREAL REPORT

Paragraph 18, Section V, Circular Number 54, this headquarters, 1945, is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:

"18. Submitted in compliance with AR 40-210, Paragraph 2A, dated 25 April 1944 Units will submit reports promptly at the close of the reporting period. In keeping with transfer of certain medical functions to Headquarters, Peninsular Base Section, the consolidated Reports prepared by the Surgeon of air forces, air force command, base sections and other separate commands for report period ending October 1945 and all subsequent reports will be forwarded so as to reach Headquarters, Peninsular Base Section, APO 782, within two (2) weeks after the close of the reporting period."

IV - SUBMISSION OF MONTHLY SANITARY REPORT AND REPORT OF ESSENTIAL TECHNICAL MEDICAL DATA

Pursuant to transfer of certain medical functions to Headquarters, Peninsular Base Section, APO 782, the following reports submitted through command channels will be forwarded by all commands to the Commanding General, Peninsular Base Section commencing with Reports for month ending 31 October 1945:

a. Monthly Sanitary Report, submitted in compliance with AR 40-275, dated 13 September 1945.

Part of Essential Technical Medical Data: submitted in compliance with LAMOUCA letter, File AG 789/141 SING-O, dated 22 August 1943, subject: "Essential Technical Medical Data".

V -- VEHICLES AND ACCESSORIES

Circular Number 67, this headquarters, 1943, is amended by the addition of the following:

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Motor vehicles will be used only for official business, including the special uses set forth in paragraphs 2c and 2d, below.
2. Motor vehicles owned or operated by the US Army or by agencies under its control will not be used to transport civilian personnel except the following classes:
 - a. United States citizens employed by US Government agencies or by the American Red Cross, and members of the immediate families of such citizens.
 - b. Members of the immediate families of US military personnel.
 - c. When transportation is available without detriment to official business entertainers and party guests may be transported in connection with properly authorized group activities of a recreational, welfare and morale building nature. In the interest of economy, personnel in this category will, whenever possible, be transported by groups in large vehicles, rather than singly or in small numbers in several small vehicles.
 - d. In vehicles being used for official business, but only when their presence is necessary for the accomplishment of the official business for which the trip is being made. Transportation of employees to and from work will be considered to fall in this category, but only when such transportation is actually necessary in order to obtain needed labor.
3. Officers and enlisted personnel of allied or co-belligerent nations may be transported. They may be required to exhibit adequate identification and official documents showing them on leave or travel status.
4. Specific Provisions - a. Transportation of civilians under the provisions of paragraph 2c above may be authorized by commanding officers of separate companies, or by specifically designated field grade officers where a company is part of a larger unit. In headquarters of major commands, authority to authenticate trip tickets for this purpose may be delegated to a limited number of specifically designated field grade officers.
 - b. Members of immediate families transported under the provisions of paragraphs 2a and 2b, above, and civilians transported under the provisions of paragraph 2c above, will be required to read and sign the release form contained in Appendix "A" hereto, which will be prepared in both English and Italian by using units. These signed release forms will be retained in unit files for a period of one (1) year, after which they may be destroyed.
 - c. Trip tickets will be made out to a definite destination, and the names of civilian passengers will be entered either on the trip ticket or on a separate sheet of paper attached thereto.

SUBJECT: Redeployment of Enlisted Men.

TO : All Unit Commanders, this Regiment.

1. In order to have an accurate record of enlisted men of this regiment as pertains to their redeployment status, the following information will be furnished this headquarters as it becomes available. It is the responsibility of unit commanders to insure that prompt notification is made to this headquarters when an individual becomes ineligible for redeployment:

- a. Hospitalized.
- b. AWOL.
- c. In confinement.
- d. Awaiting trial by Courts-Martial.
- e. Undergoing Courts-Martial sentence.
- f. Temporarily held as Courts-Martial witness.

g. Voluntary retention as evidenced by new volunteer statements signed subsequent to 2 September 1945, and statement made in service record of volunteers on page 15, Remarks-Administrative, over signature of enlisted man as follows: "Regardless of the relationship of my adjusted service rating score to the present critical score and such changes as may be made therein, I elect to remain in the Army as a Class ____ volunteer." (one signed copy of volunteer statement will be forwarded to this headquarters.)

2. Pending marriage applications will not be used as a basis for retaining enlisted men in units. As the critical score is lowered and enlisted man becomes eligible for redeployment, his application will be withdrawn and his name will be included with other enlisted men subject to return to the United States, unless he has volunteered prior to the time he becomes eligible for redeployment.

3. Applications for discharges in this theater will be made prior to enlisted man's eligibility for redeployment. As the critical score is lowered, the enlisted man becomes eligible for discharge in the theater, these applications will be forwarded to higher headquarters for necessary action. The enlisted man making such application will be excluded from list of names of enlisted men eligible for return to the United States. If unfavorable action is taken on the application, the name of the enlisted man will then be included on list of names of enlisted men eligible for return to the United States.

4. Only men with ASRC scores below the critical score, or those who have signed as Class I or Class II volunteers are eligible for promotion.

5. It is desirable for the purposes of administration within the organization that information be compiled as soon as possible as to the enlisted men who are Class I and Class II volunteers, in order that this headquarters may know what men will be remaining within the organization and what military specialties it is necessary to requisition as replacements. It is therefore in the interests of the command that the unit commanders encourage men in their organizations not to delay decisions as to volunteering. This headquarters will be unable to consider promotions within the organization until the statistics are available.

(A) Class I volunteer. An enlisted man who volunteers for retention in the military service for the duration plus 6 months unless sooner relieved for the convenience of the Government. Such enlisted man will be informed that this decision once made is irrevocable, and he will not again be considered until after the defeat of Japan.

(B) Class II volunteer. An enlisted man assigned outside the zone of interior who volunteers for duty in the theater to which he is assigned for the length of time he will be required but not to exceed the duration plus 6 months. When it is determined by the theater commander that his services are no longer required, such enlisted man will again be made eligible for separation under the provisions of the Readjustment Regulations.

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
