TERMS OF PETROLEUM PRODUCE FOR THE USE OF ITALIAN CIVILIANS

AND ITALIAN ARMED FORCES.

I. SCOPE

1. The provisions of this Memorandum will extend to the issue of, and accounting for, petroleum products issued for Italian civilian and Italian Armed forces use in Italy, Sicily, and Sardinia.

II. REQUIREMENTS - CIVIL.

2. The requirements of the civilian users for various areas in Italy, Sicily, and Sardinia will be computed and forwarded to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO) not later than the 20th of the month preceding that in which delivery is required where they will be reviewed and appropriate allocations of produce made.

3. The following headquarters will be responsible for requirements as stated in paragraph 2 above, for the respective areas under their control.

- a. All 15th Army Group. (Forward of rear army boundaries.)
- b. Headquarters AMG. (Rear of army boundaries in areas not controlled by Italian Government.)
- c. The Italian Government through AMG. (In areas controlled by Italian Government.)
- d. Sicilian requirements. (By controlling agency.)

II REQUIREMENTS - CIVIL

2. The requirements of the civilian users for various areas in Italy, Sicily, and Sardinia will be computed and forwarded to Petroleum Section, AFHQ, Advanced (FLASBO) not later than the 25th of the month preceding that in which delivery is required where they will be reviewed and appropriate allocations of products made.

3. The following headquarters will be responsible for requirements as stated in paragraph 2 above, for the respective areas under their control.

- a. AMG 15th Army Group. (Forward of rear area boundaries.)
- b. Headquarters AMG. (Rear of area boundaries in areas not controlled by Italian Government.)

g. The Italian Government through ASC. (In areas controlled by Italian Government.)

d. Sicilian requirements. (By controlling agency.)

f. Sardinian requirements. (By Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia))

4. Petroleum Section, AFHQ, Advanced (FLASBO) will consolidate these requirements as forwarded by the various agencies above and publish allocations of petroleum products to the responsible distributing and releasing agencies.

III ALLOCATIONS

5. Petroleum Section, AFHQ, Advanced (FLASBO) will transmit monthly allocations of petroleum products for civil use through appropriate channels to the D.D.S.T., FLASBO; G.S., F.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; and Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia), authorizing the release of specific quantities to G.I.F. These allocations will specify the releasing and receiving agency or

agent in each particular geographical area.

6. Where local stocks are imperilled by the allotments so made or where other questions arise in a particular allotment, the matter will be referred directly to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANCO) for decision.

IV DISTRIBUTION

7. Civil distribution will normally be accomplished in rear of Army boundaries by member companies of C.I.F. (Comitato Italiano Petroli). In the event that unusual circumstances prevent C.I.F. from accomplishing adequate distribution because of lack of transport or other reasons, special arrangements for the release of petroleum products for civil use may be arranged by referring the matter to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANCO), stating full particulars of the difficulty encountered.

8. In no instance will stocks held by the military be released to the Italian civil population without adequate authority originating from Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANCO) except where operationally necessary.

9. Forward of rear boundary of Army areas, Headquarters 15 Army Group AMG, will be responsible for accomplishing the distribution of petroleum products for civil use, and will make such distribution as is deemed necessary until such time as operation by C.I.F. can be arranged and implemented. Receipts for all products so distributed will be obtained. Headquarters 15 Army Group AMG will advise Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANCO) of such distribution as is made, and receipts forwarded with advice.

V AUTHORIZED USERS

10. Authorized users of petroleum products in Italy, Sicily, and Sardinia are presently defined in AFHQ Advanced Administrative Regulation 4669.

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the release of petroleum products for civil use may be arranged by referring the matter to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO), stating full particulars of the difficulty encountered.

8. In no instance will stocks held by the military be released to the Italian civil population without adequate authority originating from Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO) except where operationally necessary.

9. Forward of rear boundary of Army areas. Headquarters 15 Army Group AGO, will be responsible for accomplishing the distribution of petroleum products for civil use, and will make such distribution as is deemed necessary until such time as operation by C.I.F. can be arranged and implemented. Receipts for all products so distributed will be obtained. Headquarters 15 Army Group AGO will advise Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO) of such distribution as is made, and Receipts forwarded with advice.

V AUTHORIZED USERS.

10. Authorized users of petroleum products in Italy, Sicily, and Sardinia are presently defined in AFHQ Advanced Administrative Mobilization Administration Instruction No. 12. Attention is directed to this Instruction, and compliance therewith in Italy, Sicily, and Sardinia is directed.

VI ACCOUNTING PROBLEMS - MILITARY

11. D.S.S.T., FLAMBO; C.G., P.B.S.; D.S.S.T., No. 1 District; and Petroleum Officer, Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia); will obtain receipts from C.I.F. for all petroleum products released against authorized allocations in their respective areas. These receipts will be transmitted at the end of each month to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO).

12. Receipts will cover quantities and types of products delivered to the C.I.P. Prices will not be included on any receipts so prepared.

VII PRICES

13. Actual prices of petroleum products will be established by Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMMO) based on the following factors:

- a. Landed cost of product.
- b. Allowable industry margin.
- c. Authorized government taxes.
- d. Retailer's margin.
- e. Unknown factors.

14. Retail prices will be established by C.I.C. Any difference desired for economic or other reasons between price computed in paragraph 13 above and published retail price will be cleared through C.I.C.

15. Any arrangements relative to price adjustment under the provisions of paragraph 14 above, will be so ordered so as not to affect the factors listed in paragraph 13, items b, d, and e.

VIII REPORTS OF FLAMMO

16. D.D.S.T., FLAMMO; C.O., P.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; Petroleum Officer, Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia); and Supply Officer, AMO 15 Army Group, will forward monthly to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMMO) a consolidated report of issues made during the month against authorized allocations. In addition to releases made in accordance with authorized allocations, the reports will include such products as have been placed at the disposal of D.D.S.T., FLAMMO; C.O., P.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; Supply Officer, AMO 15 Army Group; and Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia), by the C-in-C, Mediterranean or any other source.

g. Unknown factors.

14. Retail prices will be established by C.E.O. Any difference desired for economic or other reasons between price computed in paragraph 13 above and published retail price will be cleared through C.E.O.

15. Any arrangements relative to price adjustment under the provisions of paragraph 14 above, will be so ordered so as not to affect the factors listed in paragraph 13, items b, d, and g.

VIII REPORTS OF ISSUES.

16. D.D.S.T., FLAMBO; C.O., P.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; Petroleum Officer, Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Cardinia); and Supply Officer, AMO 15 Army Group, will forward monthly to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO) a consolidated report of issues made during the month against authorized allocations. In addition to releases made in accordance with authorized allocations, the reports will include such products as have been placed at the disposal of D.D.S.T., FLAMBO; C.O., P.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; Supply Officer, AMO 15 Army Group; and Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Cardinia), by the C-in-C, Mediterranean or any other source in accordance with allocations issued by Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO).

IX CIVIL REQUIREMENTS FOR MILITARY ACCOUNT.

17. Requirements for civil contractors working for Allied military account will be drawn through C.I.F. No direct issues to contractors or to civilian owned motor vehicles working for military account will be made from military stock.

18. The D.D.S.T., FLAMBO; C.O., P.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; Petroleum Officer, Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Cardinia); and Supply Officer 15 Army Group AMO, after verification of requirements of civilian contractors, will issue letters of authorization to the contractors, authorizing him to draw petroleum

products during the current month in a designated quantity. Copies of these letters will be forwarded to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLABSO). Letters will state the approximate location from which the contractor will desire to draw products for the month.

19. The contractor will present this letter to the Local Rationing Authority who will issue the necessary circulating permits and deliver the required coupons authorizing the contractor to draw products from C.I.F. at the official civilian price.

20. Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLABSO) will make available those additional quantities to C.I.F. in the area specified in letters of authorization. These allocations will be in addition to civil requirements specified in paragraph 5 above.

21. In the event that stocks are restricted by any consideration, the requirements for these contractors will take priority of issue over pure civilian use.

22. The Local Rationing Authorities will forward monthly to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLABSO), detailed summaries in triplicate of coupons issued against authenticated letters.

X ITALIAN MILITARY REQUIREMENTS.

23. Army units serving directly with Allied military forces will be supplied with petroleum products as required by the Force Commanders with which they serve. Wherever practicable, records of such issues will be maintained and transmitted monthly to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLABSO) through appropriate channels.

24. Army units not included in paragraph 23 above, will be supplied petroleum products as follows:

22. The Local Rationing Authorities will forward monthly to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANDS), detailed summaries in triplicate of coupons issued against authenticated letters.

X ITALIAN MILITARY REQUIREMENTS.

23. Army units serving directly with Allied military forces will be supplied with petroleum products as required by the Force Commanders with which they serve. Wherever practicable, records of such issues will be maintained and transmitted monthly to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANDS) through appropriate channels.

24. Army units not included in paragraph 23 above, will be supplied petroleum products as follows:

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1. Requirements - The Military Mission to the Italian Army will be responsible for the collection and submission to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANDS) of requirements for the Italian Army exclusive of those units included in paragraph 23 above. These requirements will be submitted so as to reach Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLANDS) by the 20th of the month preceding that in which delivery is required and will specify geographical areas in which the units are located. Requirements will also be submitted for Italian armed forces in Sicily and Sardinia. The vehicle basis on which these requirements are computed will be indicated.

b. Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO) will transmit to D.D.S.T., FLAMBO; C.G., P.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; and Petroleum Officer, Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia), monthly allocations authorizing release of approved quantities of petroleum products to the C.I.P. for Italian Army account in the respective areas concerned.

g. The C.I.P. will deliver to the Italian Army on a contractual basis charging only the distribution cost (including any imposed Government taxes) but not including the cost of the petroleum product.

4. D.D.S.T., FLAMBO; C.G., P.B.S.; D.D.S.T., No. 1 District; and Petroleum Officer, Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia), will submit monthly reports to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO) of releases made against these allocations, and will collect and transmit to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO) receipts signed by C.I.P. as agent for the Italian Army.

XI ITALIAN NAVAL AND AIR FORCE REQUIREMENTS.

25. The Navy and Air Force will be issued special petroleum products as directed by C-in-C, Mediterranean, and C-in-C, M.A.A.F. respectively. Records of such issues will be reported monthly to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advanced (FLAMBO).

26. Naval and Air Force Ground POL will be issued to the Navy and Air Force on the request of C-in-C, Mediterranean, and C-in-C, M.A.A.F. respectively through the same procedure as detailed in paragraphs 23 and 24 above. Records of such issues will be maintained separately by C.I.P. but in the same form and transmitted in the same manner as specified for Army POL Products.

Petroleum Officer, Petroleum Section, AFHQ (Sardinia), will submit monthly reports to Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advance (FLABO) of releases made against these allocations, and will collect and transmit to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advance (FLABO) receipts signed by C.I.P. as agent for the Italian Army.

XI ITALIAN NAVAL AND AIR FORCE REQUIREMENTS.

25. The Navy and Air Force will be issued special petroleum products as directed by C-in-C, Mediterranean, and C-in-C, M.A.A.P. respectively. Records of such issues will be reported monthly to the Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advance (FLABO).

26. Naval and Air Force Ground POL will be issued to the Navy and Air Force on the request of C-in-C, Mediterranean, and C-in-C, M.A.A.P. respectively through the same procedure as detailed in paragraphs 23 and 24 above. Records of such issues will be maintained separately by C.I.P. but in the same form and transmitted in the same manner as specified for Army POL products.

It will be seen that the exemption of part of the tax (L 328) for agriculture and marine consumers had the effect, that the sales price was about 1/3 of the normal price. This was, however, not due to a subsidy.

The new price for illuminating purposes is L 1400 per 100 L; for agriculture and fishing purposes the price will be lower, to the extent of the tax exemption of L 328 per 100 L or L 1072.

2. Paragraph 2 of letter from Major J. O. Dodds dated 12 January 1944.

This Section has no authority to issue free petrol. Presumably the Bishop of Avellino will buy through C.I.P. and the latter must receive payment. If however A.M.G. wish to reimburse the Bishop for sums paid out by him then this is a matter for their own arrangement.

1. It is requested that definite instructions be issued to all concerned, regarding the handling of petroleum products for civilian consumption by C.I.P. (Comitato Italiano Petroli) the civil organization recognized by this Headquarters for petroleum distribution.
2. This request is necessitated by the fact that this Headquarters Administrative Instructions Nos. 6, 9, 11, and 12 issued on 10, 19, and 27 November and 1 December respectively, have evidently not reached down to C.A.O.'s or even S.C.A.O.'s. It is further known that in cases where C.A.O.s and S.C.A.O.s were called upon by officers of this Headquarters for the purpose of explaining fully the functions of C.I.P. that due to change of officer personnel and A.M.G. Provincial reorganization, C.I.P. representatives were not recognized.
3. An even more serious point is the fact that notwithstanding this Headquarters Administrative Instructions and the visits to S.C.A.O.s in all provinces of officers of this Headquarters that in more than one case action was later taken to introduce local petroleum rationing.
4. It is further requested that action be expedited to put into effect the issue of vehicle permits and petroleum ration coupons as laid down by this Headquarters. Supplies of all forms already being in the hands of the Regions.
5. Appendix "A" attached gives names and addresses of C.I.P. representatives appointed to date.

SUBJECT: Retail Price of Petroleum Products

1. The following memorandum deals with the 3 main oil products, i.e. gasoline, kerosene and gas oil. Once the principals for the fixing of retail prices have been established, they can easily be adapted for fuel oil, lubricating oils, greases etc. the sales of which will be small in comparison to the 3 main products.

2. It is advisable, that the actual prices should be fixed at a self-supporting level, and should therefore be sufficiently high to cover:

- a. Taxes and imposts payable to the Italian Government
- b. The distributing cost
- c. The landed cost price

3. The taxes and imposts are the following:

gasoline	Lire 4.40	per liter
kerosene	" 3.70	" "
gas oil	" 3.60	" "

N.B. Any of these products used for agricultural or fishing purposes pay lower taxes and imposts as follows:

gasoline	Lire 0.44	per liter
kerosene	" 0.30	" "
gas oil	" 0.32	" "

4. Distributing costs. Whereas insufficient data ^{are} at present available to make an accurate calculation of the distribution costs, it is estimated, that on the quantities to be released to C.I.P. for civilian distribution during January 1944, these costs will be approximately as follows: 1652

gasoline	Lire 4.20	per liter
kerosene	" 4.30	" "
gas oil	" 4.20	" "

These charges are expected to cover:

- Salaries of administrative and technical personnel engaged on distribution
- transport from ocean installation to inland depots
- transport from inland depots to consumers
- Filling in drums and cans
- current repairs and maintenance of distribution equipment and facilities
- margin for re-sellers
- leakage

They do not cover, however, interest and amortization of equipment and facilities, nor costs of major repairs due to war damage.

5. Landed cost price. No definite landed cost price has yet been established, but information received, indicates that provision has to be made for the following landed cost price, which are considered to be maxima:

gasoline Lire 6.50 per liter
 kerosene Lire 5.50 " "
 gas oil Lire 5.50 " "

6. The data given in para 3, 4 and 5 would give the following retail prices:

7. Whereas retail prices on this basis would cover C.I.P.'s ~~16.50~~ ^{16.50} share on distribution, it would not cover C.I.P.'s total expenses, since important amounts are being spent by C.I.P. in operating installations and depots for the military authorities. It is preferable, that these expenses and also the remuneration to which C.I.P. is entitled for the use of these facilities, are settled by a special agreement. It appears that under the Armistice terms the Italian authorities will make all such facilities available for allied use and C.I.P. must therefore look forward to the Italian government to receive payment of

expenses and remuneration, and it is proposed that an agreement between C.I.P. and the Italian government is to be made to this effect. Such an agreement would provide for payment to C.I.P. of certain rents and throughput charges.

8. C.I.P. is at present without any liquid cash resources. It is essential therefore that any amounts due to C.I.P. under such an agreement are not only paid at once, but also that at the end of each month C.I.P. will receive a certain payment on account, against invoices to be rendered and approved.

9. The conclusion of such an agreement with the Italian government will take some considerable time, and in the meantime C.I.P. will have to continue incurring these expenses, which are moreover likely to increase as a result of the wish of the military authorities to revert more and more to civilian operation in order to release military personnel.

10. To provide C.I.P. with the necessary cash resources in the meantime, it is proposed to fix the retail prices of oil products slightly higher than those mentioned in Par. 6 as follows.

11. The amounts under Par. 10 b will be fixed charge, revisable every 3 months for the next period in the light of new data available. The amounts under Par. d will be used by C.I.P. to meet their other expenditure, and all amounts collected will be deducted from the amounts which are receivable by C.I.P. under the agreement with the Italian Government. The amounts under par. g will be set aside by C.I.P. to meet the invoices of the Allied authorities. Should the landed cost price eventually prove to be lower than has been provided for, any surpluses will ~~first~~ be used as follows:

- In the same way as amounts under 10 d.
- After approval by Allied authorities for payment of claims by C.I.P. for services rendered since July 10th.
- Any possible balance, according to the wishes of the Allied authorities.

12. To the Pet. Sect., AFHQ Adv. Ech. will be attached an accountant, who will be charged to control the bookkeeping of C.I.P. and to give advice on proposed changes for distributing costs at the beginning of each quarter, and on the changes for throughput and rent to the Italian Government under

the proposed contract.

13. The proposed retail prices compare as follows, with those in use before Allied occupation:

MEMORANDUM FOR: Petroleum Section, AFHQ.

SUBJECT: Civilian Petroleum Distribution.

Retail Petroleum Prices

Under General Order No. 2 issued by the Allied Military Government, the payment of all National, provincial, and municipal taxes, etc., payable in the occupied territory is made mandatory and accordingly the Finance Officer of A.M.G. Region III (Lt. Col. Neilson) has given written instructions to Dott. Ing. Marghiaradino Pietro, the tax collector, to collect taxes on the sales of all petroleum products sold for civilian purposes.

The question therefore of having the retail prices adjusted is a matter of urgency, as under the proposed arrangement made with C.I.F. for petroleum distribution, the present retail prices would not be sufficient in the case of petrol, to cover the cost of distribution plus the total amount of the various taxes let alone the cost of the product.

Distribution

The question of transportation is also a matter of great urgency as was brought forth during recent discussions between the undersigned and A.M.G. officers of Regions II, III, IV, and 15th Army Group when the following points were noted:-

a. That there is a definite shortage of petroleum products in quite a number of Districts for civilian essential services.

b. That C.I.F. have practically no transport at present.

c. That A.M.G. officials, in view of AFHQ Petroleum Section letter re Petroleum Allotments (Ref. A/B 73 Nov. 10, 1943) expect C.I.F. to collect and deliver the petroleum as and when required and to the points they indicate, the total quantity being determined by the allotments made by AFHQ Petroleum Section.

d. That A.M.G. Regions have not got the necessary transport to handle the petroleum.

Further discussions with P.B.S. (Capt. Schooler) and the 57th Army Hq. (Major Archard) elicited the information that P.B.S. had no transport available for A.M.G. or C.I.F. and that Major Archard who had been giving some transport assistance, now had definite orders that such assistance must cease.

The question of transport must therefore be brought before some

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higher authority for a decision as to what procedure is to be adopted to secure transport to cope with the present situation, which as time goes on will become more serious, especially when any existing stocks which civilian users may have, become exhausted.

The return to G.I.s. of some of the Petrol Company vehicles, especially Road Tank Trucks and Rail Tank Cars, which may have been taken by the Allied Armies and the Italian Army, would of course considerably help in solving the present problem. The following suggestion advanced by Major Archard is worthy of consideration -

That transport pools suitable for petroleum distribution be formed at selected points for both military and civilian use, using thus to full advantage such available transport.

SUBJECT: Collection and Return of Empty 5 gallon Petrol Containers.

1. During operations in the Calabrian Peninsula, relatively high numbers of 5 gallon returnable petrol containers are reported to have been left behind the Army in its advance northward.
2. It is suggested that these containers are now held either by the Italian Army, the civil population, or are lying abandoned in the countryside.
3. In order to regain control of these containers for reuse and refilling, it is desired that they be collected and forwarded to either TARANTO or NAPLES, consigned to the respective petrol depots.
4. Request that necessary arrangements be put in hand for collection of returnable petrol containers, and forwarding thereof to Taranto or Naples for inspection, salvage, or repair, and refilling.
5. Further, request Petroleum Section, this Headquarters, be kept advised of progress made along these lines.

MEMORANDUM TO: Major J. A. Todd, M.G.S.(AFHQ)

Herewith copy of memorandum prepared by Captains Fagan and Borrego dated 15 November last relative to views, discussions, etc., leading up to the drafting of the directive concerning the licensing and rationing system to be imposed in connection with the issue of petroleum supplies for civilian use.

Herein we established the general policy to be followed from the AMG point of view. As we have previously informed you, we interviewed various heads of subcommissions before leaving Palermo HQ. and obtained information and recommendations from the affected sub-commissions which were incorporated as far as practicably possible in preparing the proposed directive in question and now under discussion. Here in Naples we also consulted with AMFA, Finance and Taxation AMG representatives as well as the Supplies and Economics Chiefs of Region 3.

SUBJECT: Civil Petroleum Distribution

MEMO TO: Petroleum Section, AFHQ.

1. OPERATING PROCEDURES

It is agreed that the proposal setting up the marketing organization C.I.P. is feasible and satisfactory under present conditions.

It is however recommended that certain considerations pertinent and related to the various sub-commissions of H.Q. Allied Commission be tied in and commonly agreed on, governing rationing, licensing, taxation duty, property control and prices.

2. TAXES & DUTY

As A.M.P.A. are at present advancing money to local government bodies etc. for essential services, such as the City Corporation of Naples, who must maintain and repair damage to waterworks drainage, garbage disposal and all public services, it is recommended that taxation as heretofore imposed be continued and further that import duties previously in effect be similarly continued.

To this end discussions with both A.M.P.A. and Finance branches of A.C. have disclosed that this general policy is being made applicable in other fields. Such being the case it is recommended that all monies collected by C.I.P. under this heading be separately accounted for and deposited in the Accredited Bank, for disposal to the various authorities as and when decided by the proper A. C. unit.

3. PRICES

In view of the above statement, the question of the retail prices at present being changed must be considered with a view to possible adjustments to meet the changed conditions.

4. RATIONING & LICENSING

Investigation has shown that the exigencies of the agent, has made it impossible to establish a satisfactory system by which circulation and licensing of vehicles is closely related to petroleum supplies, estimates and distribution centers. The ramifications involved are such that before a satisfactory decision can be made and an operating policy

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established, it is felt that further discussion and thought be given to this item; before specific and definite instructions are issued to those concerned, for instance the following suggestion is one which might meet the situation:-

The licensing authority should be A.M.G. and the rationing should be based on the H.P. and type of vehicle with a basic allowance fixed for each type, but where satisfactory evidence can be produced to prove that the basic allowance is insufficient, then a supplementary allowance can be granted. Authority for the drawing of the petrol allowance should be given through A.M.G. at the same time as the licence is issued. Future allowances should be made from month to month and A.M.G. could obtain from C.I.P. if necessary, information regarding the applications, as it is believed that C.I.P. would have records of commercial consumers previous consumptions.

5. ESTIMATED REQUIREMENTS

It is recommended that general instructions and if possible, a pro-forma be issued to all A.M.G. Regions in regard to the manner in which future requirements should be submitted to A.F.H.Q., Petroleum Section. This should show the number and type of vehicles, and industries, etc. for which products are required.

6. PROPERTY CONTROL

It is essential that records be kept by C.I.P. with respect to properties physically taken over by them so that same be available for the property controller of A.C. These records should show the following information:-

- (a) Ownership and location of property i.e. NAFTA, SIAP, etc.
- (b) Date on which property was taken over by C.I.P. for their use.
- (c) Condition of installations, equipment and Rolling Stock.
- (d) Expenditure on repairs to damaged property.
- (e) Expenditure on maintenance of property.

7. FINANCE

Should it be found that the accredited Bank are not prepared to advance C.I.P. or that they cannot obtain sufficient funds to commence operations, application can be made to A.M.P.A. for such accommodations as may be required.

Distribution of Civilian Petroleum Requirements

1. It is essential that civilian use of petroleum products be controlled so as to assure the minimum consumption compatible with military necessity and a sound civilian economy. Such control must be uniform in all portions of the Kingdom of Italy thus far occupied and similarly extended to other areas as they fall under Allied influence.

Motor Vehicles

2. All civilian motor vehicles, whether publicly or privately operated, shall be allowed to circulate only on permit and shall be furnished petroleum products only upon presentation of coupons valid for the month of issue. Petroleum coupons and circulating permits will be issued only against applications properly made on Form AMG/PET/FUEL No. 1, copy of which attached. Circulating permits must be numerically synchronized with petroleum permits.

3. The provisions of paragraph 2 above are not intended to modify the procedure outlined in paragraph 10 of Administrative Instruction No. 9, this Headquarters, with respect to the furnishing of petroleum to civil contractors working for military account.

4. Vehicles requisitioned by the military will not be issued petroleum coupons or civil circulating permits. Such vehicles shall clearly display the name of the military unit by which they are used and petroleum supplies therefore shall be issued by the military and included in military requirements.

5. Civil applicants for petroleum for motor vehicles may obtain Application Form AMG/PET/FUEL No. 1 from local AMG officers, from local representatives of C.I.P., or Italian petroleum companies, and other places that may be designated. Petroleum applications shall be given by civilian users to the nearest local representative of CIP. CIP will coordinate with the local AMG officer and will forward the applications for review by the CIP Zone Office. CIP Zone Offices will be responsible for passing Petroleum Applications with recommendations to the proper Regional office of AMG for approval or denial. Approval will be granted in consistency with the principles laid down in Schedule "A" attached, as from time to time amended. 1558

6. CIP shall be informed by the AMG Regional Officer of petroleum permits as issued and CIP will maintain proper records of permits; issues against coupons; and similar information as requested by Petroleum Section, FLANCO, to insure proper control of petroleum distribution.

7. Civilian circulating permits shall be made only in accordance with Form AMG/PET/FUEL No. 2, copy attached, and will be issued simultaneously with coupon Forms AMG/PET/FUEL Nos. 3 and 4, for petrol or diesel oil respectively, copies attached. Record permit card for office control Form AMG/PET/FUEL No. 2 A shall be kept by AMG issuing office. (Copy Attached) Forms Nos. 2, 3, and 4 shall be valid only for monthly periods ~~and~~ such other periods as may from time to time be determined by Petroleum Section, FLASBO.

Industrial and Off-the-Road Users.

8. Applicants for petroleum products destined for non-vehicular use will submit application Form AMG/PET/FUEL No. 5, copy attached. Such include, but are not limited to, non-highway ~~users~~ users, marine and fishing users, dealers in kerosene, wax or pharmaceutical petroleum products who distribute to individual retail consumers. Private household consumers of these products should not submit Application Form AMG-PET-FUEL No. 5. Their demand will be comprehended in the allotments made to the dealers supplying them. Form AMG-PET-FUEL No. 5 shall be submitted in triplicate, one copy being retained by the AMG issuing office and one approved copy for the OIP Zone office.

9. The procedure for handling applications as outlined in paragraph 8 above will be the same as that ~~for~~ described in paragraph 5.

General

10. Requests for civilian allocations of petroleum products not specifically comprehended in this instruction should be referred to Petroleum Section, FLASBO, by AMG 15th Army Group or HQ, AMG, as involved for consideration.

11. Petroleum Section, FLASBO, will maintain close liaison with AMG 15th Army Group and HQ, AMG, so as to properly relate Italian civilian petroleum distribution to the industrial and economic programs of AMG.

12. Printed forms are being prepared and will be distributed - attached mimeographed forms only samples.

SCHEDULE "A"

Petroleum Issues to Civilians

1. The following categories of civilian petroleum users are eligible for issue of petroleum products.

- a. Agricultural vehicles or machinery.
- b. Commercial fishing boats.
- c. Common carriers of goods and passengers.
- d. Public utilities, including essential vehicles. (Water, gas, electricity, postal, telephone, telegraph, etc.)
- e. Public health and safety. (Physicians, fire, police, ambulance, motor hearses, etc.)
- f. Essential state and municipal government officials.
- g. Industrial vehicles or plants considered essential to a minimum public economy. Each included industry will be reported to this headquarters by Headquarters, AEC.
- h. Dealers in kerosene, wax, candles, and pharmaceutical oils essential for household consumption.

2. Not all applicants in the above categories will necessarily be given petroleum permits. Individual cases must be scrutinized for essentiality and quantity applicable to each instance.

3. Every effort shall be made to conserve fuel by the local pooling of vehicles.

SUBJECT: Italian Civilian Petroleum Organization.

1. As of November 4, 1943, a group was formed by members of the Italian petroleum industry to represent that industry collectively vis-a-vis military or other recognized authorities. It is called the Comitato Italiano Petroli (short name C.I.P.).
2. The C.I.P. has constituted itself so as to be able to contract on behalf of its members for services rendered to military organizations, as well as to receive and account for the disposition of products placed at its disposal to meet Italian civilian requirements. As Italian petroleum personnel and property are increased by the further occupation of territory, their inclusion in C.I.P. becomes automatic.
3. The organization of C.I.P. consists of a Board of Directors of five persons by whom Dott. G. Cola of Naples has been elected president. Functional duties have been divided into five sub-groups dealing specifically with (a) general administration, (b) technical distribution and refining administration, (c) lubricants, asphalt, wax and specialties, (d) motor fuels and fuel oils, (e) accounting and auditing. The headquarters of C.I.P. are at Via del Chiostro, 9, Napoli.
4. To facilitate field contacts and operations, the Directors of C.I.P. have divided the area presently under control into three zones. Zone A covers Sicily with headquarters at Palermo, manager to be announced. Zone B with headquarters at Bari covers Puglia and Matera, manager Mr. L. Margherita. Zone C with headquarters at Naples covers Campania, Calabria, Molise, and Potenza, manager Dott. G. Cola. For the time being the C.I.P. representative on Sardinia will represent the area.

2. The C.I.P. has constituted itself so as to be able to contract on behalf of its members for services rendered to military organizations, as well as to receive and account for the disposition of products placed at its disposal to meet Italian civilian requirements. As Italian petroleum personnel and property are increased by the further occupation of territory, their inclusion in C.I.P. becomes automatic.

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4. To facilitate field contacts and operations, the Directors of C.I.P. have divided the area presently under control into three zones. Zone A covers Sicily with headquarters at Palermo, manager to be announced. Zone B with headquarters at Bari covers Puglia and Veneto, manager Mr. L. Margherita. Zone C with headquarters at Naples covers Campania, Calabria, Molise, and Pescara, manager Dott. G. Cola. For the time being the C.I.P. representative on Sardinia will report direct to the Board. As territorial or operational circumstances warrant additional zones will be established and delegates for C.I.P. named.

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5. C.I.P. is generally prepared to represent the interests of its members on any matter affecting the petroleum field of endeavor. Attention invited to Administrative Instruction No. 6 dated 10 November, 1943 the headquarters as paragraph 1, wherein Petroleum Section, AFHQ Advance Administrative Echelon is designated as the coordinating office for contact with C.I.P.

Dealings with Italian Civilian Petroleum Companies

1. Petroleum Section, Advanced Administrative Echelon, AFHQ is designated as the coordinating office for contact with Italian Civil Petroleum Industry.

2. Petroleum Section, Advanced Administrative Echelon, AFHQ will:

a. Review all future contracts to be made with the various components of the Italian Civil Petroleum Industry, either individually or collectively, before consummation thereof.

b. Review all contracts presently outstanding with the various components of the Italian Civil Petroleum Industry, either individually or collectively.

c. Make recommendations as to changes, alterations, or amendments to those contracts which are indicated as necessary to regularize all contracts with regard to established petroleum practices in Italy.

3. Provisions and facilities belonging to the Italian Civil Petroleum Companies will not be requisitioned, occupied, or requisitioned by any or service other than petroleum created personnel without prior reference to Petroleum Section, AFHQ.
