This "War Diary" was initiated for the purpose of keeping a record of work done in the newly established Liaison Division for a sufficient period of time to determine whether the volume and character of services performed were sufficient to justify the continuence of the Division as a separate component of the Civil Affairs Branch, the Regional Control and Military Government Section, and the Commission. 2. As of this date, the biary covers a period of about three months and is believed to reflect a fair crosssection of the type of work in which the Division has engaged. The desirability of continuing limison work as a special activity seems to be generally accepted, and the original reason for initiating and maintaining the Diary has accordingly largely disappeared. 3. Officers engaged in limison work have also become well-acquainted with the personnel at this Headquarters and at headquarters of "lisisees" and the collateral function of the Diary as a reminder of names of persons dealt with, has consequently become less important. 4. Lt. Col. Bowman, Chief, Liaison Division, has assumed additional duties to a degree intermingling with and separable from liaison per se, and it is felt that as fer as his work is concerned the Diary as a report of lisison work, as such, would from this time on be more misleading than helpful. 5. Major Enoch Brown, who will henceforth handle the bulk of the daily work of the Liaison Division has been requested to continue to maintain a day-to-day record of matters handled by him. Liaison engaged in in the future by Colonel Bowman will, if of sufficient importance, be reflected by memoranda and letters in the Civil Affairs Branch and Liaison Division files. 6.
