REGIONAL ORDER NO 2

TEMPORARY WAGE ADJUSTMENT

Whereas by Proclamation No. 8 of the General Officer Commanding the Allied Forces in Occupied Territory, a general limitation on wages was declared, and the Allied Military Government was given power in Article II thereof to alter rates of wage,

Now, therefore, I EDGAR ERSKINE HUNT, Colonel, General Staff Corps, United States Army, Regional Civil Affairs Officer, hereby order as follows:

ARTICLE I

WAGE ADJUSTMENT FOR GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES

(i) Employees of permanent and temporary status of the State, Province, Communes, Enti Para-Statals, and Public Institutions and Concerns (Aziende) which are administered by any of the foregoing governmental units shall receive a temporary wage adjustment which shall be calculated upon the base of present total salaries (base plus ordinary and extraordinary indemnities which normally represent an integral part of their total salary) as described in Article IV below.

(ii) The adjustment specified in paragraph (i) above shall become effective as of 1 December 1945.

ARTICLE II

PERMISSIVE WAGE ADJUSTMENT FOR PRIVATE EMPLOYEES

(i) Private employers may now grant increases in both salaries and wages with effect from the date of this order which shall not exceed the percentages described in Article IV hereof. Such increases shall be calculated upon the salaries and wages fixed by in the Collective Labour Contracts which were in effect upon the 1st day of September, 1942. However, within the limits of the city of Naples the said percentage increases shall be based upon the contract wage so fixed plus the indemnity of Presenza. These increases shall in no way affect or be effected by the Assemblei Familiari.

(ii) Any increases of salaries and wages which were received by any employees after the first day of September 1942 shall not be included for the purpose of calculating the percentage increases specified in Article IV hereof which are permitted herein.

(ii) The adjustment specified in paragraph (i) above shall become effective as of 1 December 1943.

ARTICLE II

PERMISSIVE WAGE ADJUSTMENT FOR PRIVATE EMPLOYERS

(i) Private employers may now grant increases in both salaries and wages with effect from the date of this order which shall not exceed the percentages described in Article IV hereof. Such increases shall be calculated upon the salaries and wages fixed by in the Collective Labour Contracts which were in effect upon the 1st day of September, 1942. However, within the limits of the city of Naples the said percentage increases shall be based upon the contract wage so fixed plus the indemnity of Presenza. These increases shall in no way affect or be affected by the Assegni Familiari.

(ii) Any increases of salaries and wages which were received by any employees after the first day of September 1942 shall not be included for the purpose of calculating the percentage increases specified in Article IV hereof which are permitted herein.

(iii) Any disputes which arise between employers and employees under this Articles shall be adjusted in accordance with the provisions of Regional Order No 1 for the region of Campania and Naples issued by the Allied Military Government and which became operative upon the 10th day of December 1943.

ARTICLE III

EXEMPTION FOR EMPLOYEES OF ALLIED FORCES

This Order does not apply to persons directly employed by branches of the Allied Armed Forces or by contractors rendering service to said forces.

ARTICLE IV

SCALE OF WAGE ADJUSTMENT

The foregoing provisions shall be applied in accordance with the following scale :

(ii) In respect to salaries or wages which exceed L. 5,000 per month, no increase in excess of L. 1900 shall be granted.

ARTICLE V

PENALTIES

Any person violating any provisions of this order shall upon conviction by an Allied Military Court be liable to punishment by imprisonment or fine or both.

ARTICLE VI

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Order will become operative in each of the provinces of Naples, Avellino and Benevento on the 11th day of December 1943.

1. At the meeting of the Central Economic Committee held 27 December 1943 it was determined that wage rates for railway workers should be made uniform throughout occupied portions of the Italian mainland. It was further determined that indemnities relating to bombing and the war situation should be eliminated in those areas where conditions no longer warrant their payment, and that this policy should be considered in establishing uniform wage rates.

2. Will you please make the necessary investigations and prepare the directives required to implement this policy.

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SUMMARY OF RAILROAD WORKERS WAGE SITUATION
FOR CENTRAL ECONOMIC COMMITTEE

Meeting 27 December 1943

1. The wage structure of a railroad worker is composed of the following:

- (a) Base Salary. Attivo
- (b) Supplemento di Servizio (added to base salary and considered part thereof for active service).
- (c) Assegno temporaneo di guerra (war supplement).
- (d) Agguinta di famiglia or carovirieri (family allowance).
- (e) Ad personam (paid to adjust individual differences in pay in exceptional cases).
- (f) Indennita di economia (special bonus for saving fuel).
- (g) Indennita di kilometrage (to cover expense for food and lodging on the road).

Note: (f) and (g) above are paid to travelling personnel only.

2. Temporary wage adjustment was granted to railroad workers in regions I, 2 and 3 and by the Italian Government (Apulia). Increases were in accordance with the following:

3. Temporary wage Adjustment.

(a) Region 1 (Sicily)

- (1) Wage increase retroactive to 1 November 1943.
- (2) All recurrent indemnities including indennita di presenza or bombardamento were included in the wage structure upon which increases in pay were based.

(b) Region 2 (Calabria and Luccania)

- (1) Wage increases retroactive to 1 December 1943.
- (2) Wage structure upon which increases in pay were based similar to 3 (a) (2) above.

(c) Region 3 (Compartimento of Naples which includes Salerno)

- (1) Wage increases retroactive to 1 December 1943.
- (2) Wage structure upon which increases in pay were based similar to 3 (a) and (b) above.

(Note: It has been reported, however, that by administrative error of Region 3 Hq. the increase was made retroactive to 1 November 1943).

(d) Region 4 (Foggia)

- (1) No wage increase order yet issued.
- (2) AMG Labor Officer now making survey and will present report to AMG 15th Army Group.

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(c) Apulia (Italian Government)

- (1) Wage increase retroactive to 1 November 1943.
- (2) Wage Order granted increase but at the same time abolished *indennita di presenza*, which made increase in pay for workers in many cases negligible and among the lower paid workers actually represented a decrease. (The amount of this indemnity varies from place to place within a province and represents a minimum payment of 22 Lire per day and a maximum of 60 Lire per day.
- (3) Increase was based upon the following wage elements only: base salary, *supplemento di servizio attivo*, *assegno temporaneo di guerra*, *ad personam* (normally paid only in exceptional cases) and *aggiunta di famiglia* or *carovirieri*.

4. Summary.

- (A) Region 1 and Apulia wage increase retroactive to 1 November 1943, while Region 2 and 3 retroactive to 1 December 1943.
- (B) Not increase to workers uniform in Regions 1, 2, and 3, but less in Apulia where Italian Government abolished *indennita di presenza* in the same order that authorized wage increases, and also eliminated other indemnities from the base of calculation.

SUBJECT: Christmas Loan to Italian State Railway Employees.

1. With further reference to the proposal of General di Raimondo that a loan of 500 lire be granted to employees of the Italian State Railways, it has now been ascertained that the substantial increase in wages for these employees was made effective 1 December 1943 instead of 1 November 1943. It has also been learned that the Italian Government has already agreed to this loan in the territory under its jurisdiction.

2. In view of these facts, and since no change in rates of pay is involved, the proposal would appear to be a matter chiefly to be decided by the management, and this section sees no objection to it.

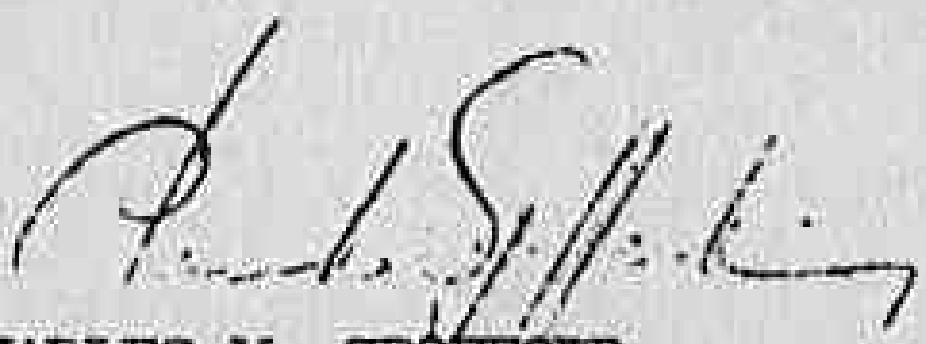

Whereas in Sicily by General Order No. 8 and in Calabria, Lucania and the Province of Salerno by Regional Order No. 5, the Fascist Corporative Syndicate System was dissolved and a method provided for reestablishing and assuring freedom of labor organization;

Now, therefore, in furtherance of the objectives of said General and Regional Orders, I, CHARLES M. SPOFFORD, Colonel, G.S.C., Deputy Chief Civil Affairs Officer, hereby order as follows:

ARTICLE I

Right of Organization

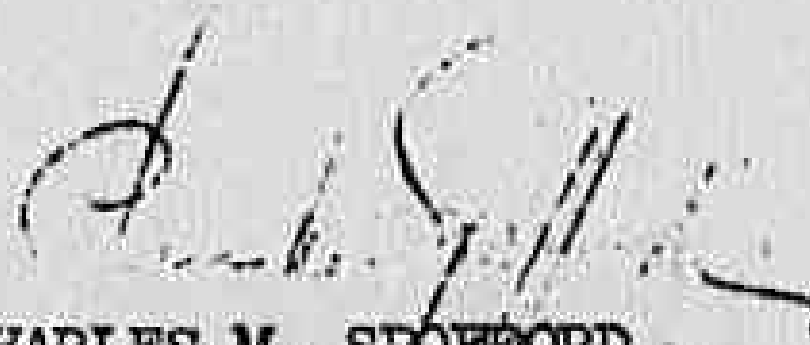
Employees shall have the right to organize, hold meetings, and select representatives of their own choosing for the purpose of collective bargaining with respect to all matters pertaining to or connected with their employment, including such matters as concern hours, wages, working conditions, grievances, disputes and mutual social and economic assistance.

This Order shall become operative in Sicily, Calabria, Lucania and the Province of Salerno on the date hereof.

His staff shall be composed of civilian clerical staff, labour economists, labour investigators and such other selected personnel as he may require and the Regional Civil Affairs Officer may approve.
3. The powers duties and functions of the Regional Labour Office for the said region will be as follows:
 - a. To co-ordinate the functions and activities of the various Provincial Labour Offices.
 - b. To act in an advisory capacity to Provincial Labour Offices.
 - c. To compile statistical information on employment, child labour, wages and labour relations (including disputes, mediation, conciliation and arbitration) in the region of Campania and Naples such statistical information to be based upon information supplied by the Provincial Labour Offices and checked and compared with all other available information.
 - d. To report monthly to the Regional Civil Affairs Officer on the labour situation generally in the said region.
 - e. To publish quarterly in the form of a report to the Regional Civil Affairs Officer a summary of and deductions from the statistical information so compiled and to make such report available by and publication to the public.
 - f. To act as or to appoint conciliators, mediators or arbitrators in any labour dispute referred to it by any labour office or by the Regional Civil Affairs Officer, but so always that any conciliation, mediation, arbitration or other decision given in any such dispute shall be submitted for approval by the RCLAO. Any decision which appears adversely to affect the interests of the Allied Forces in the territory, or which is in conflict with any policy affecting the public interest in the territory may at the discretion of the RCLAO be reviewed or reopened by him for further evidence and consideration.

g. To consider forthwith the most practicable and expeditious method of re-establishing and assuring freedom of labour organization and representation throughout the region of Campania and Naples.

h. To deal with such other matters relevant to labour and labour relations in the said region as the Regional Civil Affairs Officer may refer to it.

PROVINCIAL LABOUR OFFICES

4. The Provincial Labour Office for each province will be established in the capital city or town of the province or in such other city or town as the Provincial Civil Affairs Officer may direct.

5. Each Provincial Labour Office will be in the charge of a civilian director to be known as the Director of Labour to be appointed by the Prefetto and approved by the Provincial Civil Affairs Officer. His staff shall consist of clerical employees and such labour economists and investigators as he may require.

6. The powers duties and functions of a Provincial Labour Office will be as follows:

a. To compile statistical information on employment, unemployment, child labour and wages in the province.

d. To report monthly to the Prefetto and the Provincial Civil Affairs Officer on its work in the past month and on the labour situation generally in the province.

e. To institute forthwith a study of wages in the province.

f. To establish such sub-offices and to appoint such representatives as efficient administration may require.

g. To deal with such other matters relevant to provincial labour and labour relations as the Prefetto or the Provincial Civil Affairs Officer may refer to it

RECORDS AND FILES OF DISSOLVED INSTITUTIONS

7. The records and files of the Institutions dissolved by Article I of Regional Order No. 1 shall be delivered to the Director of Labour for the region of Campania and Naples or as he shall direct.

ASSETS OF DISSOLVED INSTITUTIONS.

8. a. Provincial Civil Affairs Officers will furnish to the Assistant Controller of Property assigned to their respective provinces a list of all property of the said institutions and inventories of contents, stating:

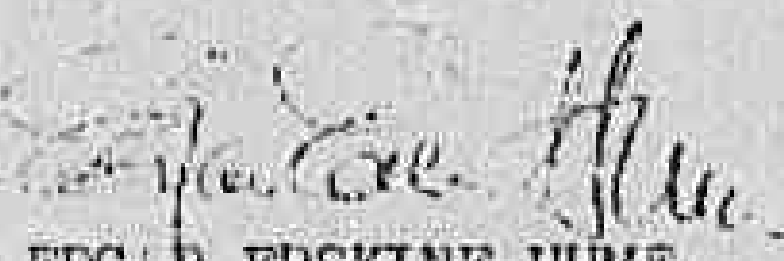

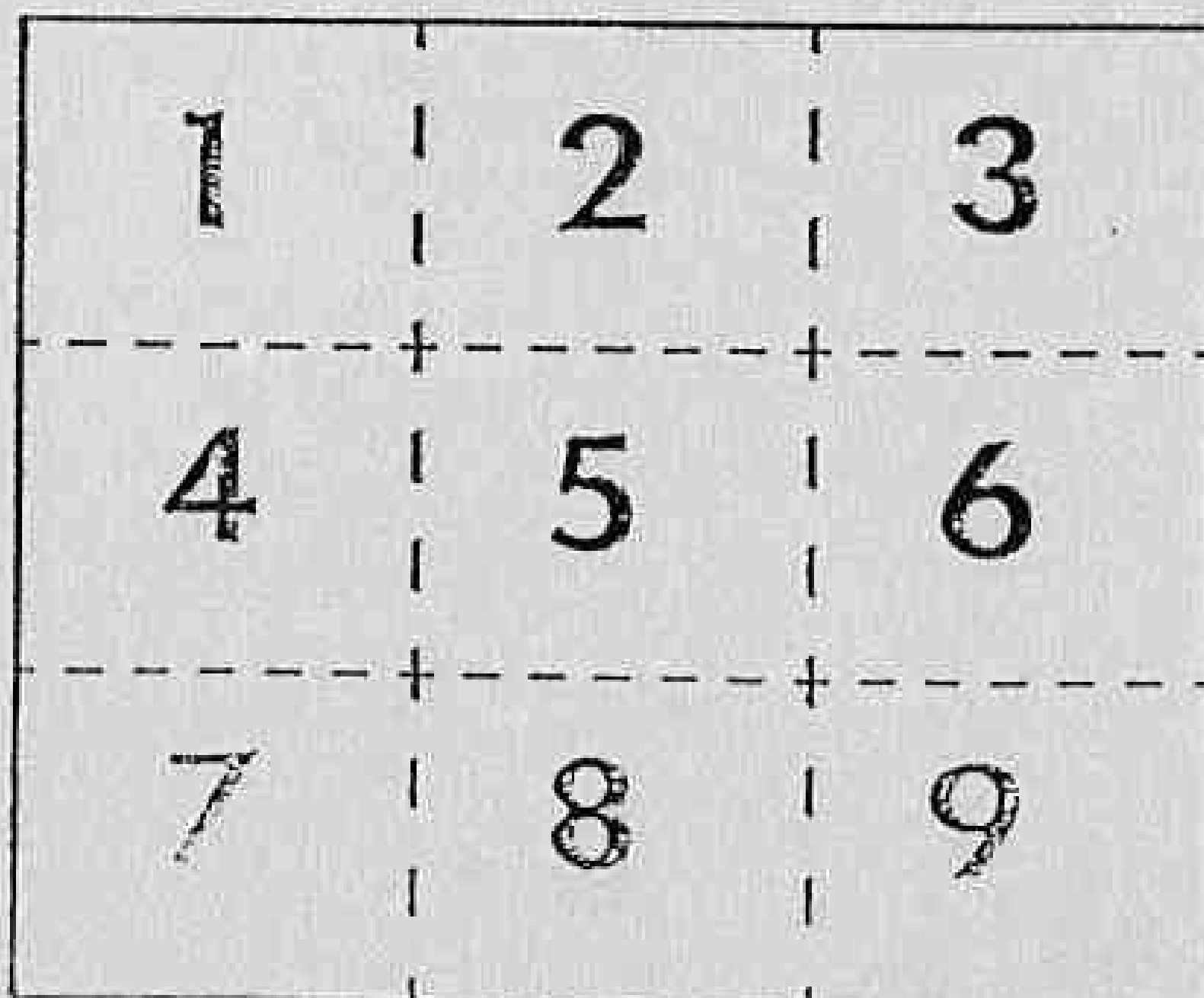

Articolo V

COMPITI DEGLI UFFICI PROVINCIALI DEL LAVORO

Soggetti alle norme ed ai regolamenti che saranno emanati come più sopra accennato, gli Uffici Provinciali del Lavoro verranno ad avere i seguenti poteri, obblighi e funzioni nei limiti delle rispettive Provincie nelle quali essi siano stati creati :

- a) La compilazione di rapporti informativi e di statistiche in materia di lavoro ;
- b) La costituzione di uffici per la registrazione e il collocamento della mano d'opera ;
- c) Funzionare quali conciliatori, mediatori od arbitri in materia di controversie sul lavoro ;
- d) Compiere generalmente tutte le altre funzioni connesse con i problemi del lavoro nei limiti delle rispettive provincie come può essere richiesto.
