Adv Headquarters Force 133 report. Food situation DALMATIAN Islands now critical as normal sups from mainland YUGOSLAVIA and ITALY cut off. Population includes refugees now amounts 71000 in addition to Partisan troops. Understand FLAMBO released approximately 10 days supplies but unable undertake permanent commitment. Immediate requirements are 3000 tons with monthly commitment 2000 tons thereafter. Adv Headquarters Force 133 report that this amount can be handled Port MONOPOLI and state DCAO Adv AFHQ agrees this would not count against Force 133 tonnage allotment. Fully prepared to assist in view operational importance but:

(A) Permission release supplies will have to be obtained from TROOPERS as those will have to come from stock pile for AT (B). IFD.

(B) There are difficulties provision shipping to MONOPOLI due restricted draught and therefore requirements will probably have to be accepted as part of normal tonnage to HUEL Ports.

The following will be provided from British Army stocks; mainland, tinned meat, 119; and evaporated milk, 30. Meat and milk from British stocks will be replaced from NORTH AFRICA in KMS 37. On above, by careful rationing for various age groups and classes of workers, sufficient food value is included. Keep this Headquarters informed of developments.
