E. Conditions under which authority to travel is obtained from AFHQ

(i) Soviet Delegation to ACI - AFHQ authority is normally requested for travel to restricted areas, e.g., Venezia Giulia, or outside Italy.

(ii) Office of Soviet Representative to A.C. - AFHQ authority is obtained before travel orders are issued.

(iii) Soviet Mission to Displaced Persons & Repatriation Sub-Commission - AFHQ authority is obtained for travel to North of ITALY, but not for travel in territory under Italian Government administration.

3. With reference to 2.D. above, it will be appreciated that it is in fact possible for Russian personnel to travel without going through the formality of asking for travel orders. This HQ is not in a position to state to what extent this is done, although in a number of cases it is known to have occurred. 5541
