ITALIAN SEARCHLIGHT CREWS WITH RAF

Consequent upon the release, by AFHQ, of 18 Italian searchlights and crews for service with the RAF (AAI signal SD 1071 of May 25th 1944 refers) your advice, upon two points which have arisen, would be appreciated.

2. (i) Identity Cards. Are these Italian personnel to be in possession of Identity Cards, and, if so, who supplies them? What action is to be taken to obtain them?
- (ii) Rations. This Headquarters has been asked - on the recommendation of the Army Liaison Officer in charge of these personnel (letter from 205 Group, RAF refers) - to approve the supplementation of Italian rations by a free issue of 1 lb of bread per day, for those searchlight crews. A support for this request is that the crews will be working at night, and, in fact, all night.
3. Your early attention to the above queries is invited.

1. It is intended to move the following tps from SARDINIA to the ITALIAN Mainland and to SICILY during the next few months.

2. The rate of movement is not likely to exceed 20000 a month.

3. In view of the fact that SARDINIA is believed to be intensely malarious from June onwards, it is essential that these troops are in possession of anti-malarial equipment etc as soon as possible.
