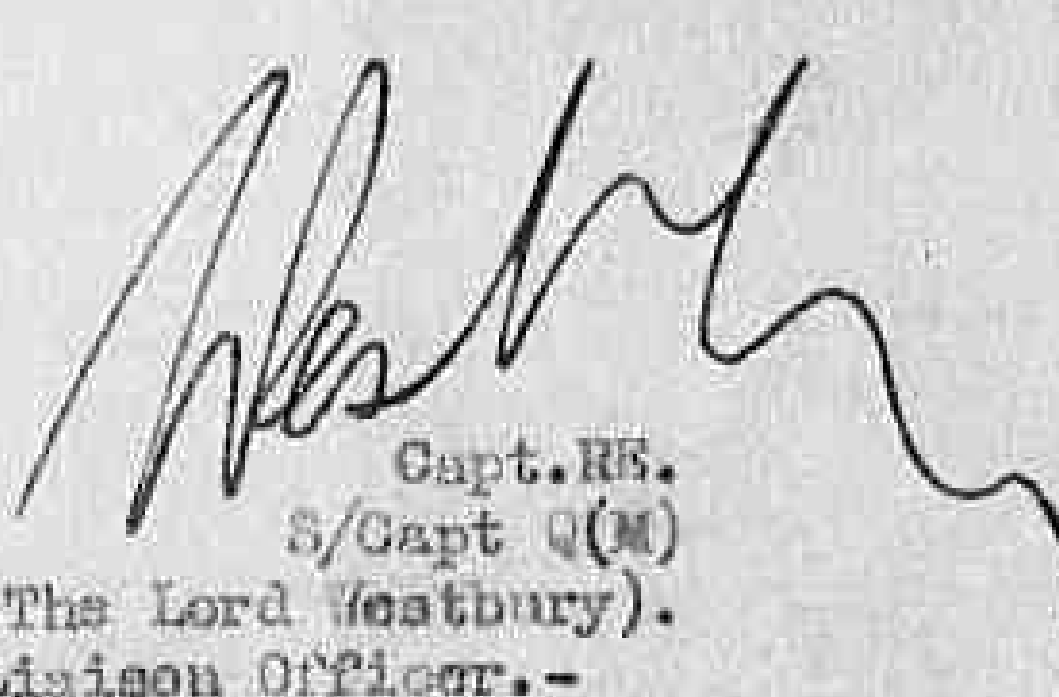

- (a) Approximately 30 days before the commencement of each 30 day maintenance period planned loadings are received at AFHQ from the UK and USA for the vessels scheduled to arrive in the relevant period. Q(Maint) in conjunction with G-4 (Mov & Tn) AFHQ and in consultation with Services decide the allocations of vessels to either NAPLES or HEEL.
- (b) Twenty seven days before each period written bids will be submitted to Q(Maint), AFHQ, by MAAF (RAF) and Services, AFHQ, for all intra-Mediterranean sea movement (except in respect of GREECE which is maintained on a thirty day basis, bids being due on the dates 5YS applicable to the first ten day maintenance period in each month.) Date chart at Appendix 'I' refers.
- (c) Twenty seven days before each maintenance period, Q(Maint), AFHQ, collate all bids from MAAF(RAF) and British Services AFHQ, and after screening pass to G-4 (Mov & Tn).
- (d) Twenty five days before each maintenance period the bids under (c) above are considered by G-4 (Mov & Tn) and Tn (A) in the light of:-
- (i) Availability of shipping
(ii) Acceptance at the ports concerned.

- (a) Approximately 30 days before the commencement of each 30 day maintenance period planned loadings are received at AFHQ from the UK and USA for the vessels scheduled to arrive in the relevant period. Q(Maint) in conjunction with G-4 (Mov & Tn) AFHQ and in consultation with Services decide the allocations of vessels to either NAPLES or HEEL.
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- (d) Twenty five days before each maintenance period the bids under (c) above are considered by G-4 (Mov & Tn) and Tn (A) in the light of:-
- (i) Availability of shipping
 - (ii) Acceptance at the ports concerned.
- (e) If bids are not acceptable under either (d)(i) or (d)(ii) above, Q(Maint) in consultation with MAAF (RAF) and Services will impose priorities.

SUBJECT : Security of Civil Supplies.

TO : All concerned.

1. The attention of the Allied Commission has been called by AFHQ to the need for compliance with the standard procedure prescribed by PBS Cargo Movement, regulating the use and distribution of motor transport dispatch orders for haulage from docks to, inter alia, AC warehouses.

2. PES regulations prescribe that three copies of the dispatch order shall be prepared to secure safety of the, load and its proper delivery. The correct use of the three copies, as outlined by PBS in the extract of movements SOP quoted below, is designed to reveal shortages in the loads on the illegal diversion of entire truck loads.

"10 When cargo is dispatched by truck, the M/T dispatching orders will be accomplished in triplicate in form of Annex "E". The white (original) copy will be retained by port dispatcher as a record of cargo dispatched. The pink and green copies will accompany the driver.

11 Services receiving shipments by truck will properly and legibly receipt M/T dispatch orders returning the pink copy to the driver to be surrendered to the port dispatcher unless major discrepancies in count or type of cargo in which case the driver will be detained and Transportation Section (Port Highway Office) notified. The green copies of M/T dispatch orders will be returned by receiving Supply Service directly to the port highway office within 24 hours

2. PES regulations prescribe that three copies of the dispatch order shall be prepared to secure safety of the load and its proper delivery. The correct use of the three copies, as outlined by PES in the extract of movements SOP quoted below, is designed to reveal shortages in the loads on the illegal diversion of entire truck loads.

"10 When cargo is dispatched by truck, the M/T dispatching orders will be accomplished in triplicate in form of Annex "I". The white (original) copy will be retained by port dispatcher as a record of cargo dispatched. The pink and green copies will accompany the driver.

"11 Services receiving shipments by truck will properly and legibly receipt M/T dispatch orders returning the pink copy to the driver to be surrendered to the port dispatcher unless major discrepancies in count or type of cargo **359** in which case the driver will be detained and Transportation Section (Port Highway Office) notified. The green copies of M/T dispatch orders will be returned by receiving Supply Service directly to the port highway office within 24 hours to be matched with white copy for discrepancies."

3. The importance of returning to the port, thru official channels, the triplicate (green) copy properly signed, and stamped with the appropriate stamp, cannot be over emphasized. The primary purpose of these M/T Dispatching Orders is to ensure the safe delivery of the load. The diversion of the green copy to any other purpose, such as depot accounting, defeats this purpose and should not be permitted. Until the green copy has been matched with the original at the port, the correct delivery of the truck load has not been shown.

4. All AG/ALG officers, EM/ORS, and Italian governmental agencies concerned with the receipt and accounting for supplies will ensure that the warehouse accounting staff and all other interested personnel comply with the above mentioned regulation in all cases involving supplies carried by Port Military authorities or IBS organizations.

1 Attention of this Section has again been drawn to the failure of Depots receiving civil supplies through the Port of Naples to comply with the instructions on Supply Security issued by this Headquarters. Letter AG 400,73/087 GDS-O of 19th February 1945 refers.

2 Provision by the port military authorities for the safe-guarding of cargo from port to warehouses is dependent on the prompt and correct handling of the triplicate (green) copy of the M/T Truck Dispatch Orders. These are to be properly receipted and stamped by the receiving depots and returned to the Port Highway Office within twenty-four hours.

3 It is requested that this matter be vigorously pursued and complete compliance to the regulations be assured.

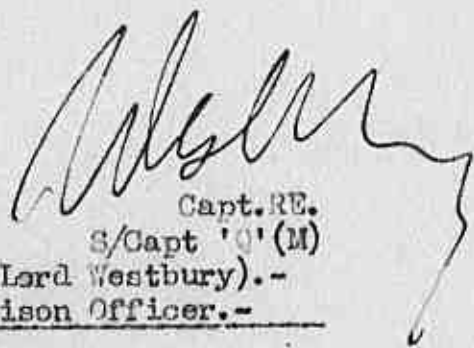
