1. Reference is made to your letter A2/3/1 of 28th May, 1944.
2. The strength of the CC.RR and GG.FF, as certified by their Commanding Generals, are shown in enclosures "A" and "B".
3. It will be noted that they differ considerably from those shown in your letter. The Commanding Generals have been shown your strength returns and can only suppose that your figures are based on the number of rations supplied, whereas their own figures include men who are given an allowance in lieu of rations.
