1. I sent you a telegram today re the above as your letter, 2128/G(0) dated 25 Jul only reached me yesterday.
2. I am very sorry I cannot agree to your proposal re General LOMBARDI.
3. I have strict instructions that I must reduce the ⁴⁰²² number of Italian generals drastically. In consequence the agreed policy that the older and reserve generals must go first is obviously sound and right. LOMBARDI comes within that category and I do not want to start a precedent by making individual exceptions.
4. Moreover, TARANTO is not an important military command and, compared with others, it is considered that the rank of Colonel is adequate for its Commander.
5. I may say that the retirement of Gen. LOMBARDI in no way reflects on the performance of his duty, which I fully realise he has carried out very well.

3. I have strict instructions that I must reduce the number of Italian generals drastically. In consequence the agreed policy that the elder and reserve generals must go first is obviously sound and right. LOMBARDI comes within that category and I do not want to start a precedent by making individual exceptions.

4. Moreover, TARANTO is not an important military command and, compared with others, it is considered that the rank of Colonel is adequate for its Commander.

5. I may say that the retirement of Gen. LOMBARDI in no way reflects on the performance of his duty, which I fully realize he has carried out very well.

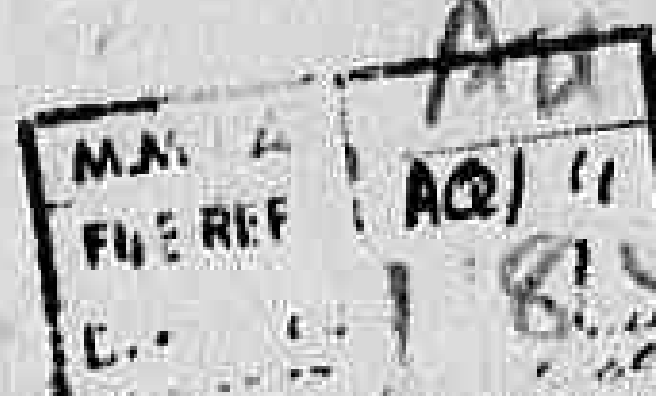

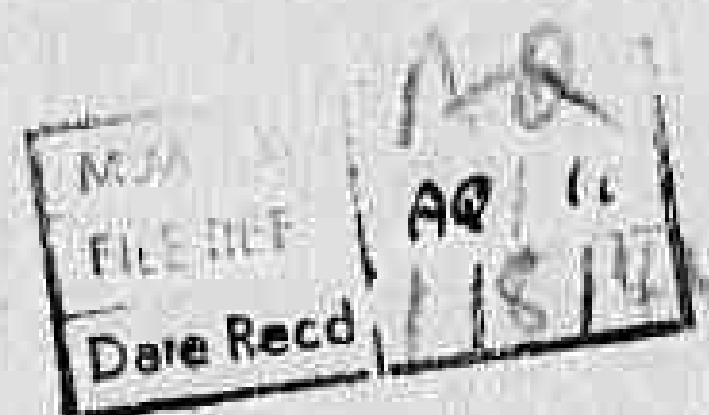

Subject : 922(Italian) Dock Operating Company.

1. Reference is made to the memorandum from the O.C. No.1 Docks Group,R.E. DG5/111 of the 9th July 1944, calling attention to the behaviour of the O.C. of this Company, Maggiore Fumagalli Robastiniano.

2. Since the 19th July this Company have been under my command at Bari and have commenced to work in the docks. Although they have been here for so short a time it is obvious that under their present Commander they will not be satisfactory, in fact it is not possible, with the supervision available to this Group, to make them work in a reasonable manner.

3. Little satisfaction can be obtained either from the O.C. or the Second-in-Command of the Company and I am satisfied that this attitude will persist until the command is taken over by an officer who is a good disciplinarian.

4. It is requested that the replacement of Maggiore Fumagalli Robastiniano be treated as an urgent matter. I shall be glad to know when the officer to replace Maggiore Fumagalli Robastiniano may be expected.

5. I am not prepared to accept the present Second-in-Command of this Company in replacement of the present O.C. From the little that has been seen of him he is not suitable to exercise command of the Company.

In June 1940, Italy joined the 2nd World War - only 2 years later on the 13th June 1942, I was again arrested in Turin and accompanied to Rome to be tried by the TRIBUNALE SPECIALE (Mussolini's and the Party's special court) and sentenced to life imprisonment on 14.12.42 on the following charges: -

- of having been during the winter 1935-36, in touch with the British Consul in Turin (Mr Leach) as a paid British spy - The charge is false.
- of listening to London Radio - the charge is true.
- of having always criticised the institutions of the Fascist Regime - The charge is true.
- of having criticised, also in writing the alliance with Germany and the methods of war followed by Germany during the Polish Campaign (1939-40) - the charge is true.
- of not having changed my religion - evidence my Baptism Certificate from an Anglican Church -



On September 8th 1943 an U.S.A. Commando released me from the worst Italian jail that of S. Stefano di Ventotene, with a batch of other political convicts, which was brought over to Capri. The rest were sent to G.H.Q. Palermo, and I was retained in Capri and put to work with the local A.M.G. O.T.; then transferred to Naples. My prison file, I believe, has been sent over to G.H.Q.

These are the facts - According to Italian Law - life imprisonment means civil death, no more rank, no more honours, no pension etc; and I am also afraid that my home & property in Turin have been confiscated.

As I have got into this scrape, only on account of my feelings and of always having been very proud and stuck to my English origin, I should very much like the British Government to be informed of my very unhappy situation and I firmly believe that only the 'Foreign Office' can testify that I have never been a spy or a paid agent of that State department. Anyhow the former Consul in Turin could give evidence in regard to this.

During the last world war, as an Italian Staff-officer when British troops came over to Italy, autumn 1917, I was attached to Lord Cowan's H.Q. I was then awarded the M.C.

Legal Position. I am out of jail, but although the sentence of the Tribunale Speciale is null my legal position should be fixed and my reputation restored.

Administrative Position. I should be reinstated in rank and pension so from March 1936, and when possible my property should be restored to me.

Subject: Issue of POW certificates to deserters from
Iti units located on the mainland.

It has been discovered recently that some Iti Military sent on leave to Sicily have reported to the Allied Authorities and obtained a certificate as POWs on parole.

These men have thus been able to avoid being arrested as deserters and fulfilling their military duties. The following specific cases are quoted.

1. Infantry man MILITELLO Giuseppe, 1921 class, of the Brinisi Labour Gp. Sent on 30 days leave to ~~XXXX~~ Lercara Friddi on 12 Dec. 43, and has never returned to his unit. On Jan. 21st last he reported to the Allied Authority at Palermo and obtained from them POW parcel certificate No. 27540.
2. Gunner PETRUSSO Salvatore, 1920 class of the 551st Ack Bty, charged with being AWOL. The local Carabinieri report that he is in possession of POW on parole Certificate No. 27760, issued by the Allied Authorities on the 7th Feb last..

The case is serious, not only due to the repercussions it may have, but also because more such cases may take place. We would be very grateful therefore if you would kindly approach the said Allied Authority in Sicily in order that the two POW certificates may be cancelled, since they were only obtained under false pretences to elude mil. duties, and the two men sent back to their units under Carabinieri escort.

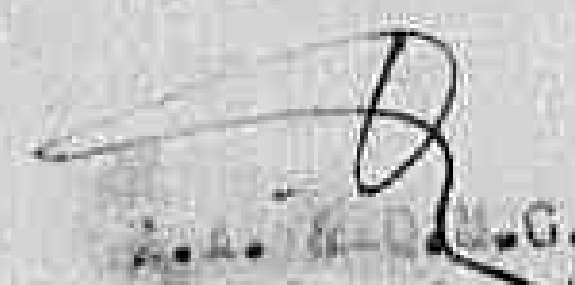

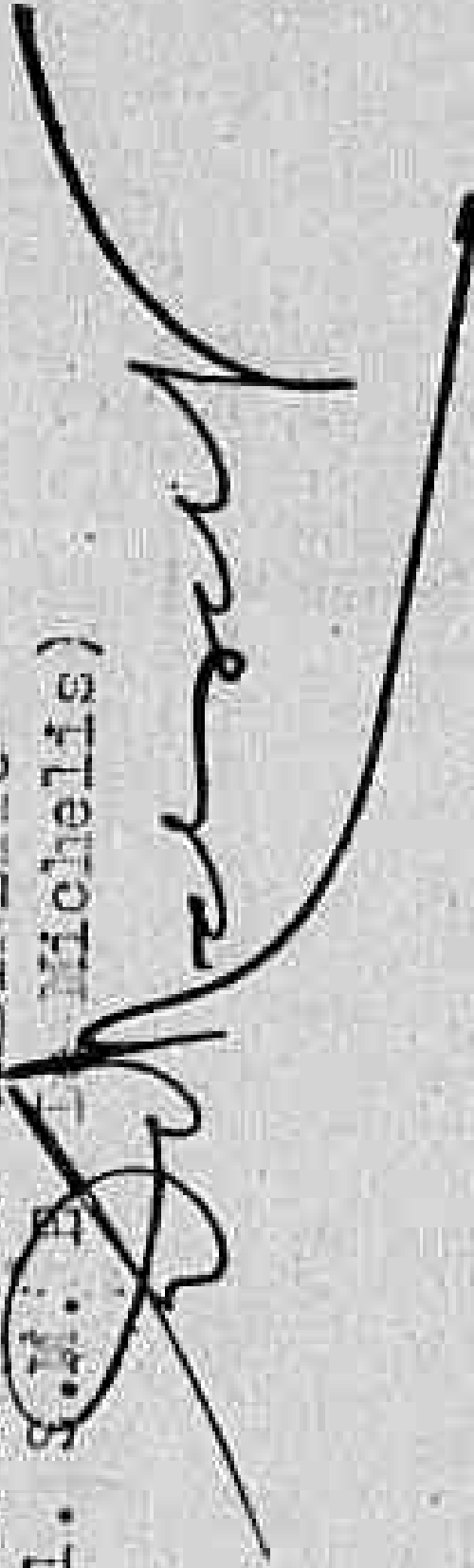

1. Capitano Giovanni Dal Lago, an artillery officer of the Italian Army, is at present attached as "Sostituto Procuratore Militare" to XXXI Italian Corps, Catanzaro.

It would be of the greatest assistance to the organization if he could be released from his present duties with the Italian Army and work for P.W.B. in Catanzaro.

May I ask you to intervene with the Italian Authorities on our behalf in order that he may be assigned to our organization.

Sergeant Calabi has already approached the Army Sub-Commission (ACC) at Catanzaro in order to request for his transfer.

This request was accepted by "Procuratore Militare" Col. Trotta of the XXXI Italian Corps and was forwarded to "Procuratore Generale", Ostuni, Lecce.

The Chief of the Army Sub-Commission told to Capitano Giovanni Dal Lago that he did not think that the Italian Command would release him. I would point however that the arrangement that we venture to propose is only of temporary nature.

Capitano Dal Lago is anxious to work for us and his services in Catanzaro would be of the greatest use to the Allies and to A.C.C., though he would remain on the payroll of the Italian Army.

2. Dr. Emilio Paganuzzi, second lieutenant in the Italian Army with the 16th Infantry, XXXI Italian Corps, Cosenza, has been recently discharged. While he was still in service, he did some important work for this organization. It would be very desirable that Dr. Paganuzzi be called back to duty, assigned to the "Distretto" of Reggio C., and then relieved from his duties at said "Distretto" and transferred on temporary duty to P.W.B., Reggio C.

1. The Flag officer, Taranto Adriatic Liaison Italy, was advised by reference (a) that two Italian workmen employed at the U. S. Naval Operating Base, Palermo, have been arrested for desertion by Italian authorities and that several hundred skilled workmen employed on the base are subject to the same procedure. It is not clear whether the men arrested are actually deserters from the Italian Armed Forces or technical deserters for failure to report for military service.

2. A conference was scheduled to be held in Rome on 2 July 1944, between the Representative of the Commandant, U. S. Naval Operating Base, Palermo, the Army Sub-Commission, ACC, the Navy Sub-Commission, ACC and the Senior U. S. Naval Officer, Italy, to discuss the matter. Pending information as to the out-come of this conference, the following data is furnished.

3. Enclosures (A) to (E) inclusive, outlines the procedure to be followed to exempt skilled workmen employed by the Allied Armed Forces from Italian military service. Enclosure (F) authorizes Commandants of Districts, Base Sections or equivalent formations to approve exemptions and provides that each man exempted be furnished with a certificate as evidence for production to the Italian Military authorities.
