1. In accordance with cable, this headquarters, Number 45221, dated 30 January 1944, the following information is furnished.

SUBJECT: Requisition of Quarters - CANALE.

TO: Military Mission to Italian Army.

1. Late in November 1943, a British Major, 57 Area, came to AMG Naples City, with Miss Gladys Claisse, member of a British family of four persons recently returned from a village which had come within our lines. Miss Claisse explained that the widow of Doctor Urbani, lessee of the apartment at Piazza Trieste e Trente No. 48, Apartment No. 20, had authorized the family to occupy the apartment. Miss Claisse stated that Signora Urbani told her an Italian family had previously been authorized to occupy the apartment temporarily, pending repair of the apartment of the Italian family.

2. Miss Claisse's family had moved into the apartment, but the Italian family remained. Assistance of AMG was asked to straighten matters out.

3. Following a visit to the premises and conversation with Signora Canale and Miss Claisse, it appeared quite obvious that the Italian family was continuing to occupy the apartment without authority. It was explained to Miss Claisse, however, that AMG could not force one family out of a dwelling to make a place for another family.

4. At about this time the problem of temporary billets for newly arriving AMG Officers was becoming acute. The apartment is only 1/2 <sup>472</sup> block from Headquarters, AMG, Region 3. It was decided feasible to requisition the apartment and arrange to have quarters available for 4 officers. Miss Claisse was engaged to maintain the apartment and keep the quarters furnished and in order for four officers, either on full time or temporary basis.

5. The Italian family was given about 15 days notice. Promise was made to move out on a date first set, then a few days delay was asked. After this the family said they saw no reason to move at all. A final order was then given. It was raining hard the day the family was to move. Another 24 hours was then granted. When the 24 hours was up, the family refused to move and had to be ordered out.

6. The apartment was not occupied by "the widow Canale", but by a son and daughter-in-law and another daughter, with the widow

with the widow Canale added. The family had its living quarters in one room in the apartment. Another son of the Widow Canale had an apartment into which he could take the family. Assistance from other relatives was also available. This was all ascertained in advance.

7. The Italian family was "squatting" in the apartment and wanted to continue to do so without paying rent. The other son didn't want to be inconvenienced by having relatives billeted on him. The bank owner of the premises was about to evict or seize the furnishings for non-payment of rent.

Ciò perché riuscirebbe impossibile collocare altrove gli impianti, i quali è necessario continuare a funzionare sul posto per provvedere alla costruzione di calzature e chiudi per le Forze Armate Italiane, nonché alla lavatura e ricupero oggetti di corredo per le stesse.

Poiché la capacità della casa penale, così ridotta, non venne ritenuta sufficiente, detto Ministero propose la cessione dell'intero edificio del carcere giudiziario, proposta che, in un primo tempo, viene accettata.

Ciò perche' riuscirebbe impossibile collocare altrove gli impianti, i quali è necessario continuino a funzionare sul posto per provvedere alle costruzioni di calzature e chiodi per le Forze Armate Italiane, nonché alla lavatura e ricupero oggetti di corredo per le stesse.

Poiché la capacità della casa penale, così ridotta, non venne ritenuta sufficiente, detto ministero propose la cessione dell'intero edificio del carcere Giudiziario, proposta che, in un primo tempo, venne accettata.

Successivamente però il Comando della 71^ Sub-Area ritornava ad insistere per avere l'intera disponibilità dell'edificio del penitenziario onde il suddetto Ministero si è ora rivolto a questo, per ottenere che siano evitati gli inconvenienti che ne conseguirebbero.

Faccendo pertanto seguito agli accordi verbali presi con il Maggiore MARIGOLD e ritenendo che le casermette di Corigliano d'Otranto, da me già riconosciute, possono rispondere molto bene alle esigenze di impianto di altro carcere, pregherei codesta Missione di voler prospettare tale soluzione al Comando della 71^ Sub-Area.

Soggiungo, al riguardo, che tale soluzione è stata da me direttamente prospettata al predetto Maggiore, con la comunicazione inoltratagli tramite codesta Missione, con fascio 219/C del 17 corrente.

For the information of the Mission we are sending a short summary of a report which has reached the Ministry.

At ROME, on 2 Dec, the American Capt DELL'ONO, of the Local AM Corp, came to the house of the widow CANINI, together with another American Capt, and requested her to clear out of her own room which had been requisitioned.

This old lady is the widow of an Army Col killed in the last war, and mother of a Capt now serving with a unit attached to 5 Army.

As a result of this requisition, Mrs CANINI was obliged to move into a single room shared by her two daughters. If no avail were her protests to Capt DELL'ONO who proceeded with the requisition without taking into account ~~4~~ particular merits which this lady had acquired by virtue of having sacrificed her husband in the last war, while fighting alongside the allies, and who in the present war is a son in the front line fighting against the common enemy.

1. I have received a letter from the Chief of the Italian General Staff asking me to stress the question of accommodation for the eight bns., required for guards and internal security. He points out that they do NOT possess tents.

2. In Italian Depots there are only 280 "officers" tents. In addition there are 76,700 groundsheets, which can be used as bivouac tents. They are, however, only shower-proof and quite unsuitable as permanent tentage.

3. We already know that accommodation is a serious problem in B&I and SARDINIA, and is one of the factors holding up the provision of Port Labour. The addition of these 2ns., will aggravate the problem.



This also in agreement with the american authorities representing AMG in POTENZA.

As the latter had placed at the disposal of the provincial authority the vehicles with which the wksp is eqpt, consisting of 4 Lancia 3/ro, specially suitable for the tpt of the tools, 1 Mercedes Benz, 1 Bianchi Mediolanum, 1 Spa 25/C/10, 1 FIAT 618, we would ask the mission to use its good offices to have these vehicles returned and thus permit the move and subsequent employment of the Hy Mob Wksp.

In this connection the writer would point out that these vehicles belonging to the Mil Adm are used by the FIAT branch at POTENZA, under instructions of AMG, for tpt concerned with the feeding of the province, and that the province itself, where conditions are rapidly returning to normal, in addition to other mil vehicles belonging to the CCRR, & to the civil engrs, also has at its disposal numerous motor vehicles belonging to Messrs SITA, Consorzio Agrario, Messrs Russo, Cerretti, etc.



4. To sum up, once it is decided that Allied requirements are paramount, no resistance by any Italian authority will be tolerated nor will procrastination be permitted.


