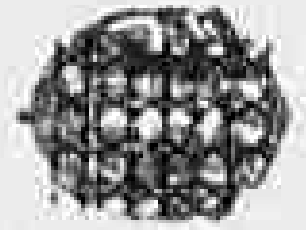

SUBJECT: Move of HQ. 9 Corps, Italian Army, from building at BARI.
TO : Army Sub-Commission, A.C.C. Main HQ (MLIA) LECCE (LECCE).

Reference signal No. 2081 addressed to you of 14 March.

This matter appears to still be undecided. In the interest of everyone, it is considered it should be settled forthwith.

In a telephone conversation with Col. MORIARTY at the end of March it was understood that HQ. 9 Corps would not have to leave the building.

Attached is copy of a letter which gives No. 2 District point of view. There are several items in this with which I am sure you will not agree. In addition, it is repeated that one of the reasons for Comando Supremo in wishing for HQ. 9 Corps to be removed is one of morale. The old Capital of BARI has had a Corps HQ. there for 50 years at least, and the building has gradually become organised completely for their use. NOT?

Comando Supremo stated that the Carabinieri Building at BARI was in every way suitable and it was understood from Captain THRUPP (conversation at LECCE recently) that in fact, there was room in BARI for HQ. 2 Region without having to turn out the Corps HQ. Secretary General's PA (Lt. PETRILLO) was informed of these points on the 2nd of April but so far no decision has been received in this office. It is suggested that if you agree to the advisability of retaining the Italian 9 Corps HQ. at BARI, that you will represent the matter to the Executive Commissioner at NAPLES HQ. as soon as possible.

A copy of Ministry of War letter 3358/11 dated 20 Mar has been received at this HQ.

1. It is not considered that HQ 9 Corps are in any way necessary to the functioning of Services and Labour assisting No. 2 District. It is the Territorial HQ of 9 Corps (virtually the Sub Area HQ) which cooperates with my Sub Area in BARI and which the Ministry of War propose to move, which is essential to the functioning of Services and Labour.
2. None of the three alternative premises are suitable for HQ No. 2 Region for the following reasons -
 - (a) PALAZZO ACQUEDOTTO PUGLIESE, is essential to the War Effort as it controls the Water supply in S ITALY
 - (b) PALAZZO DELLA PROVINCIA is the Prefectura and the only part occupied by the Allies in that containing HQ ACC of the Province.
 - (c) The necessity for this building is explained in para 1 above.
3. I am still satisfied that the only solution to the satisfactory act of II Region in BARI is to transfer HQ 9 Corps to MATERA in place of II Region. The living accommodation occupied by HQ 9 Corps in addition to the office accommodation will be required. This will not in any my opinion prejudice the operation of the Services and Labour in BARI.

1. We have been requested by the Army Sub Commission A.C.C. to requisition the LEQUILS Communal Orphanage to meet expansion of staff.

2. The Orphanage was taken over by the Italian Red Cross (HQ at BARI) as an emergency hospital for civil and military air raid casualties. During the past 12 months only 50 patients have been admitted, the last being on 15 Aug 1943.

3. The property includes a church as part of the block of buildings: this is now used by the local inhabitants and is maintained by five nuns. It has, however, a separate entrance and would remain undisturbed. The nuns could be found alternative accommodation in LEQUILS if they prefer not to remain in the Orphanage when it has been taken over. The Archbishop of LECCE has been approached and has stated that he will raise no objections to the property being requisitioned for the Army Sub Commission.

4. It is considered that an emergency hospital in LEQUILS is no longer necessary, and that local hospital accommodation in the area is sufficient to deal with any emergency which may arise.

5. Under No 2 District Adm Instr No 4 para 11(b) it is requested that you will inform the President of Committee,

In a recent inspection of your staging areas it was found that the sanitary arrangements were generally very unsatisfactory, particularly at GROIA TAURO, SOVERIA MARCELLI and SPEZZANO ALBANESE. In view of the approaching hot weather, it is essential that much more care be taken to minimise the breeding of flies and mosquitoes by adopting the following precautions:--

1. Latrines.

- a). Must be of deep trench type (at least 3 metres deep)
- b). All latrine seats must be fly - proof. Commando units have details of required design, some of which are already in use (i.e. at ARATO RIVER). New latrine seats should be constructed so that the hinged seat cannot be left open, and when the latrine is not in use the seat will automatically fall ^{48.1} the closed position.
- c). Latrine seats must be kept clean by frequent scrubbing.
- d). Disinfectant (e.g. chloride of lime) must be provided in adequate quantities and must be used daily.

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- c). Latrine seats must be kept clean by frequent scrubbing.
- d). Disinfectant (e.g. chloride of lime) must be provided in adequate quantities and must be used daily.
- e). General cleanliness must be insisted on by Commanders of staging areas, with co-operation of their medical officers.

2. Rubbish Pits.

A simple type of incinerator should be constructed at each staging area so that all rubbish, tins etc., can be burned. After burning, tins should be dumped in the rubbish pits. Disinfectant should be used daily.

3. Coy Houses and Mess Rooms.

These must be kept much cleaner and tidier. In some cases, e.g. at SPEZZANO AIDANESE and SOVERIA MARINELLI, cooking facilities could be improved considerably by small adjustments by local commanders.

4. Waste Water.

Every effort must be made to prevent pools of stagnant water collecting. In cases where it is impossible to drain away existing pools of stagnant water, a film of oil (used engine oil) on the surface of the water will prevent breeding of flies and mosquitoes.

5. Please ensure that the above recommendations are enforced forthwith, to safeguard the health of all personnel, both Allied and Italian, using the staging areas.

Reference your QS 267 of 18 April with inclosure of letter from General Infante.

1. Billeting of Italian Troops in Campania falls under two headings:
 - (a) Italian troops under Allied Command
 - (b) Italian Administration

2. The billeting of troops under Allied Command is a responsibility of the Allied Commander concerned and is not, repeat not, a matter for discussion by this Sub Commission, unless the Italian Command desires to have this Sub Commission represent any views it may have to the Allied Commanders in those cases where the Italian command considers the billets allotted to such Italian troops are inadequate in size or otherwise inappropriate.

The majority of Italian troops in Campania are under direct Allied Command.

3. Accommodations in Campania for Italian Troops used for Italian Administration can only be considered when the Combined Chief of Staff has decided on the exact number to be allowed, and this has not been decided as yet. Such troops as are allotted to Campania must be within the total ceiling for the entire Italian Army. Obviously the required number will not reach a figure as mentioned by General Infante. Therefore any discussion on this matter is out of place until the decision of the Combined Chief of Staff is received and implemented by instructions from the Allied Commander in Chief, who is also the C in C of the entire, repeat entire, Italian Army.

4. Information is requested with reference to the "Military School" mentioned by General Infante. No such school is authorized.

In my own opinion there is little doubt that the Italian Army in CAMPANIA, especially in the NAPLES area, are badly off for accommodation particularly when the question of further arrivals from SARDINIA is considered.

My dear Captain Stone,

1. Among the measures that should be taken in order to obtain more efficiency from the Italian forces in face of the increasing Allied demands, the problem of their billeting in Campania is one that should be taken into serious consideration.

The solution of this problem does not only concern the better efficiency of units, but also the more even functioning of Commands, garrisons, depots, stores, field hospitals, which are indispensable to the smooth working of units in the field.

This Command deems it necessary therefore to present the problem in its present phase with suggestions as to its solution by the Allied authorities.

2. The exigencies of billeting of Commands, garrisons, depots, stores, and hospitals in Campania were faced by the Allied authorities sometime ago when last September they occupied totally all barracks still inhabitable and all buildings adaptable to billeting.

The Allied Commands (5th Army, AFHQ, PBS) have shown that they understood the importance of the problem, but in reality only the problem of billeting these units in Campania, which are being directly used by the Allies, has been solved.

For all the requirements of a territorial character the above Commands have provided for differently in the conviction that these questions are not intimately connected with their needs.

Lately however the PBS has shown better understanding. The solution of the problem has not however been faced squarely as demanded by the exigencies of the situation and in the common interest of the Allies and of ourselves.

3. At the present moment Italian troops possess in Naples:

The Palazzo Salerno, where are stationed the Command of the Command

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3. At the present moment Italian troops possess in Naples:

The Palazzo Salerno, where are stationed the Command of the Campania Forces and nearly all offices and sections belonging to it; a few modest "locales" next to the Giregile Erosleo, the Paisiello, and feminine schools, occupied respectively by the Military Police 3400 and MP office 120; by the sanitary company and by the administrative office of the Naples garrison; by the Naples Military hospital.

The Transit Camp occupies a few private premises in Via Morghen 31 which holds approx. 150 men. The 10th Motor Group occupies a few premises at "Large Ferrandino, Chiaia (holds approx. 60 men). The 31st Infantry and 10 Artillery are housed in insufficient premises of the S. Martino Museum. The Naples military garrison occupies the only room of the Garrison Officers Club at Pizzofalcone.

In S. Maria Capua Vetere:

The 10th Engineers regiment depot occupy an exiguous portion of that regiment's own barracks.

In Salerno, Benevento, Avoras, Avellino, Caserta, Nola, commands of garrisons and depots possess a few small rooms hardly sufficient for their office space.

4. In order to insure that normal working of garrisons and depots in accordance with the exigencies determined by enlisting, recruiting, the recovery of stragglers, etc. it is necessary that each garrison in Naples, Avallion, Benevento, Avaras, Salerno, Nola and Caserta be able to possess premises to hold at least 300 to 500 men and that the following depots: the 31st Infantry (Naples), 10th Artillery AA (Naples), 10th Artillery df. (Caserta), 15th Inf (Salerno), 39th Inf (Caserta), 12th Artillery (Nola), might also be able to possess living space for 300 to 400 men to be equipped, for discharge, or who are apt to war conditions, etc.

Furthermore the Naples Transit Command should be able to dispose of a "locale" to hold at least 1000 men which is, in general, the number of soldiers to be billeted.

Lately the Allied authorities have granted us a bombed building which was once the seat of the "Ischiragene" works and which once repaired will hold approx. 1500 men. It was intended to place the Transit camp in this building and also the 31st Infantry depot, but in these last few days following the arrival of the 121 division the Allied Command has occupied this building in part and making it impossible to arrange for the Transit Camp, as the work is being delayed.

However if the "Ischiragene" building were returned totally to the Italian Armed Forces the problem of the transit camp and of the 31st Inf. Regt. would then be solved.

5. So that if we consider the problem of housing the Transit Camp and 31st Inf. Regt in the "Ischiragene" building, the following exigencies will still have to be met.

In Naples:

Premises for the 10th Motorised Group, for the military garrison of the 10th Artillery Regt. (a total of about 1200 to 1500 men)

The 10th Engineers regiment depot occupy an exiguous portion of that regiment's own barracks.

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In Naples:

Premises for the 10th Motorised Group, for the military garrison and for the 10th Artillery Regt (a total of about 1200 to 1500 men).

In Salerno:

Premises for the garrison and 15th Inf Depot (Approx. 600-1000 men).

In Caserta:

Premises for the garrison and 39th Inf and 10th Artillery Depots (about 1000 to 1500 men).

In Nola:

Premises for the garrison and 12th Artillery Depot (about 800-1000 men).

In Benevento, Avorsal and Avellino, premises in each locality for about 100 to 150 men.

To above exigencies it will be necessary to add a few modest rooms of the "annunziatelle" in Naples for the exigencies of the Military School.

If necessary this command will be able to furnish detailed information regarding the above suggestions by putting at the disposal of the competent Allied Organs a few officers of the Campania Armed Forces.

This Command trusts that the Allied Commission will examine this billeting problem in order to give it a satisfactory solution.

1. The strength of the British and U.S. personnel of the part of this HQ based on LEQUILE is now 62 officers and 178 Ors/E.M. and necessitates a considerable increase in accommodation both for officers, and for living and messing.

2. Maximum use is being made of available houses and other buildings in conjunction with the Town Major of LECCE. The use, however, of the Orphanage is essential if considerable further drastic requisitions of houses in LEQUILE now occupied by civilians is to be avoided. Exhaustive search has proved that other empty buildings do not exist and the alternative of moving to LECCE would involve extensive requisitioning in a town already overcrowded.

3. The Orphanage was taken over by the Italian Red Cross (H.Q. at BARI) as an emergency hospital for civil and military air raid casualties. During the last 12 months only 30 patients have been admitted, the last being on 15 August.

There is a Church as part of the block of buildings and now used by the local inhabitants. It has, however, a separate entrance and would remain undisturbed.

The Church is maintained by 5 Nuns who also run the village school and would act as nurses if any patients should be sent to the hospital. The Nuns could be found alternative accommodation in the village if they prefer not to remain in the Orphanage when it has been taken over.

4. I consider that an emergency hospital in this village is no longer necessary as the chance of enemy air action, sufficient to cause casualties beyond the normal hospital accommodation of the area, is remote.

5. I therefore consider that a request to take over this building, less the Church, is fair and reasonable. In view of the urgency of the situation I ask that the necessary arrangements may be made for my H.Q. to move into this building at once.

Subject: Prison Accommodation

To : Chief Legal Officer, Sub-Commission, ACC, Salerno.

24 March 1944

1. All efforts by A.C.C. officers to cope with past and future crimes affecting Allied interests in Apulia will from the start be stultified unless an immediate solution is found of the problem as to where to accommodate individuals detained pending trial and after sentence. Moreover, should political disorders occur, this problem will assume a further serious aspect.

2. Attached is a list showing:-

- (i) The prisons in Apulia.
- (ii) Their capacity
- (iii) The use to which they are at present put.
- (iv) The actual numbers of prisoners housed, and the classes of prisoners.

3. It will be observed that in general the prisons are now housing far more prisoners than their maximum capacity - surely an invitation to a serious epidemic which may not confine itself to the prisons' precincts.

4. It will be observed that the position is further aggravated by the large numbers of Italian military prisoners both sentenced and awaiting trial, who are sent to the civil gaols. There is no surplus prison accommodation in any other part of Region 2, and the refugee problem precludes the possibility of adapting buildings as prisons.

5. The problem has been largely caused by the wholesale requisitioning by the Military of civilian gaols, not only for the purpose of accommodating military prisoners sentenced to detention, but even for housing troops; and this has been done regardless of the fact that to adapt a building for use as a prison not only costs a large amount of

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5. The problem has been largely caused by the wholesale requisitioning by the Military of civilian gaols, not only for the purpose of accommodating military prisoners sentenced to detention, but even for housing troops; and this has been done regardless of the fact that to adapt a building for use as a prison not only costs a large amount of money and uses up quantities of valuable material, but also takes a long time. Having embarked upon this policy the Military are constantly reminding A.C.C. of the numbers of crimes left unpunished, and of the fact that it is up to A.C.C. to provide a solution of the problem of prison accommodation, and this despite the fact that the Military are in possession of the prisons and of the controlled stores necessary for the construction of prison camps, and A.C.C. have neither the transport nor personnel to supervise the labour of constructing camps.

6. The following is suggested, and it is felt that it is the only practicable solution:-

All prisons should be de-requisitioned at once, and the camp at Tukuranno, now used as a transit camp for Yugo-Slav refugees (which is said to be able to accommodate 1800 prisoners) should be used as a detention camp for British and Allied military prisoners. Further all Italian military and naval prisoners should be removed forthwith from civilian gaols and housed either at the H.A. prison at Augusta (estimated capacity 1000, and now believed to be used only for the purpose of

storage), or in one or more camps or cages to be constructed by the Italian Army at once. In the latter case, Italian bivouac tents will suffice as cover during the spring and summer, and this H.Q. is informed by the Area Commander at Taranto that there are miles of old barbed wire which could be dismantled and used for the purpose.

7. The use to which the camp at Tutaranno is at present put is a complete waste of valuable accommodation. Refugees are cleaned up and screened at Bari preparatory to being sent to the camp at Lecce, and Tutaranno is used as a half way transit camp for from 24 to 48 hours only, the refugees having to be provided by the Brindisi Sub-Area with motor transport to take them to and from Tutaranno. During the first 12 days of this month this camp was occupied for 48 hours only by 800 persons.

8. It is strongly urged that this matter be tackled at once. It is useless for the Military to take a large percentage of prisons accommodation, to hold on to all controlled stores, and then to say that the problem is one solely for A.C.C. to solve. It is submitted that on the release of the prisoners, if for any reason the prison at Augusta should not be available, the Military must co-operate both in the matter of the provision of transport for the removal of prisoners (unless the Italian Army can provide sufficient) and in supplying adequate personnel to supervise the work of the Italian Army in the construction of camps for their military and naval prisoners.

I would like to point out my reactions to this recommendation.

1. It is not considered that HQ 9 Corps are in any way necessary to the functioning of Services and Labour assisting No. 2 District. It is the Territorial HQ of 9 Corps (virtually the Sub Area HQ) which cooperates with my Sub Area in BARI and which the Ministry of War propose to move, which is essential to the functioning of Services and Labour.

2. None of the three alternative premises are suitable for HQ No. 2 Region for the following reasons -

(a) PALAZZO ACQUEDOTTO PUGLIESE, is essential to the War Effort as it controls the Water supply in S ITALY.

(b) PALAZZO DELLA PROVINCIA is the Prefectura and the only part occupied by the Allies is that containing HQ ACC of the Province.

(c) The necessity for this building is explained in para 1 above.

3. I am still satisfied that the only solution to the satisfactory est of II Region in BARI is to transfer HQ 9 Corps to MATERA in place of II Region. The living accommodation occupied by HQ 9 Corps in addition to the office accommodation will be required. This will not in my opinion prejudice the operation of the Services and Labour in BARI.

1. Reports received indicate that prisons on the mainland in territory under the administration of the Italian Government are seriously over-crowded.

2. The reports indicate further that a major factor in this situation is the imprisonment of soldiers of the Italian army in the civil prisons. If the soldier prisoners were removed from the prisons, the congestion would be substantially relieved.

3. It is understood that it has never previously been the custom to confine soldiers in civilian prisons.

4. A request has been addressed to the Ministry of War to remove soldier prisoners from civil prisons and to find some other accommodation for them.

5. It is therefore suggested and requested that the Ministry of Grace and Justice take such steps as may be appropriate with the Ministry of War in order to effectuate the removal of soldiers from the civil prisons.

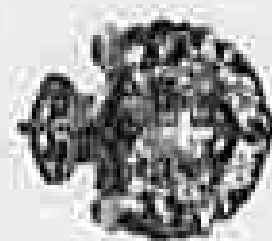

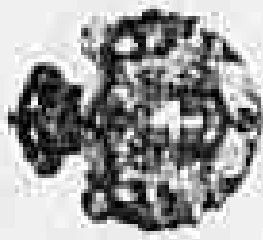

The eye washing service for the soldiers of the military garrison at BARR is carried out by the "DITTA DE NIGRO" (contractor) who is in possession of BARR. This is a washing establishment located at the 3rd BARR street and No. 34 Via S. Maria di Porto.

The Allied with requisitioned the first establishment and assigned the firm to carry out eye washing for some of their hospitals.

Only part of the establishment at Via S. Maria di Porto is at the disposal of the U.S. Mil. Force, and the washing is carried out only for a certain number of the hospitals in the area of the Red Cross Center.

In order to eliminate such inconvenience, the Territorial HQ of Salerno, through request of the Comm. Directorate ordered the requisition (w.c.f. 1000) of the establishment at Via S. 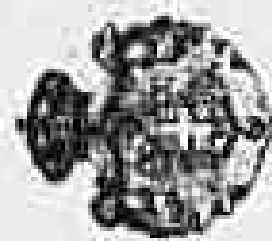

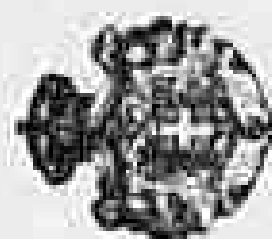

HQ of the Veterinary and Quadruped Section of this Ministry reports that the Allied authority (possibly 6 Base Sub Area) have ordered the huts in which the men of the above mentioned centre are billeted, to be dismantled and removed elsewhere.

The Italian Minister of War has recently established, in part of the Villa Tamborino at SANTA CESAREA, a reception centre for Italian officers of high rank released from Allied imprisonment or who make their way back from German occupied territory. The prime object is to tone these officers up while extracting all possible intelligence from their experiences, and if necessary to re-orient them on co-belligerent policy. This usually demands both mental and physical rehabilitation for which a certain measure of comfort is essential. Reasonable proximity to LEOCE is also of importance.

It now appears that the U.S. Air Corps, who already occupy most of the Villa, desire to take it over entire.

The Minister of War has asked me to represent to you personally that all other suitable accommodation in SANTA CESAREA is taken up by Air Corps or refugees, and that if he has to surrender his share of the Villa, his scheme will be wrecked. He has already vacated hotel accommodation in LEOCE in favour of Allied requirements, including Red Cross, and has nowhere else in the Province to go. I understand that Col. STORACE is fully conversant with this case, and associates himself with the appeal that the Italians be left undisturbed.

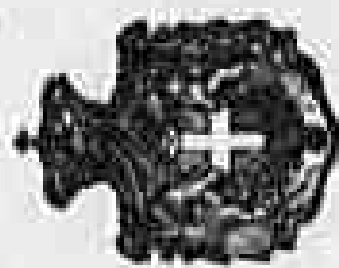

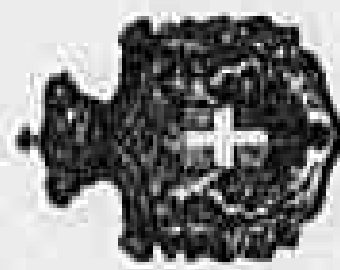

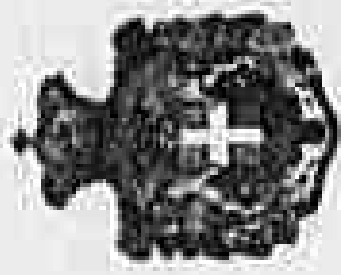
