1. It has been brought to our attention by Depot 591 that our inventory of 11 October is in error in regard to the item 106-A Socks, Cotton (N or P/W). Our count was 260 pairs of socks. The Depot has since informed us that they had frozen 1500 pairs of socks for the Palermo shipment and 475 pairs for the Kombo Division, which were set aside and not counted in the inventory.

2. The correct inventory figure then should be 2935 pairs of Socks, Cotton (N or P/W).
