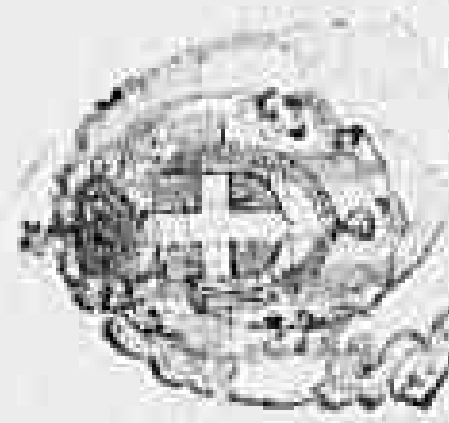

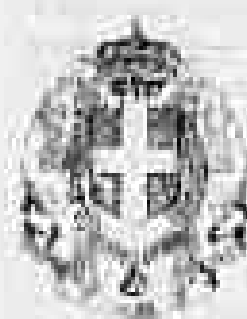

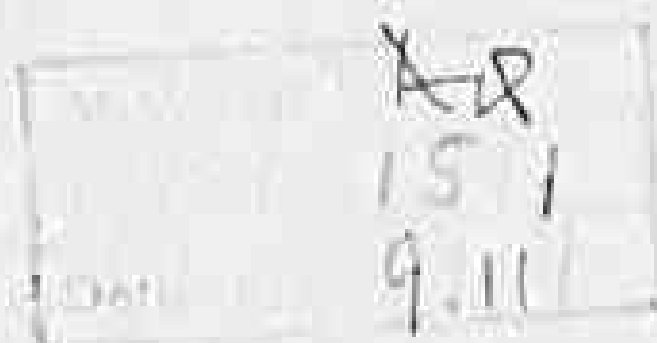

1. It is reported by CREMONA that due to a shortage of repair materials, clothing and equipment at present in use are in very poor condition.
2. Although British uniform is now being issued it seems desirable that Italian uniforms are maintained in a good state of repair so as to be of some value when finally discarded and returned to depots.
3. A demand was submitted on 20 Oct to the Director of Supplies, Campaina HQ for repair material, but it is understood that SMRE have instructed CREMONA to the effect that such demands must be submitted through the B.L.U.

4. The demand was for the following items :-

Cotton (White, Black, Greygreen)	80,000 m
Shoemakers twine	20 kg
Leather	150 kg
Pine wax	4 kg
Shoemakers nails	150 kg
Tacks	30 kg
Needles	200 packets

This is based on 8 m of cotton, 15 gr of leather, and 2 grs of Shoemakers twine per capita strength of the Gruppo.

5. It would be appreciated if steps may be taken to obtain release for all or part of this indent.

1. You will recall that some time ago the question was raised regarding the provision of denims for personnel of the Gruppo employed on vehs and in Workshops. At that time it was decided, in view of the extremely short supply of denims, to retain Italian Uniforms as fatigue dress when battle dress had been issued.
2. Whilst this solution provides a means of keeping battle dress clean, it is now realised that there is at least one important draw back in that the Italian uniform cannot be worn over battle dress as is the case with denims.
3. This will entail drivers changing completely before carrying out maintenance on vehs, and as you know, in forward areas particularly, it is not unusual for drivers working on vehs to be called for duty at short notice.
4. As a result it seems likely that either drivers will carry out maintenance dressed in battle dress or else they will often be compelled to drive in Italian uniforms which to say the least have seen better days. Neither of these alternatives appear desirable.
5. A solution would appear to be the provision of overalls from Italian sources. In the past there seems to have been an excellent blue overall (combination pattern) in issue which would be admirable for this purpose.
6. It is estimated that 1800 pairs would be required to equip all personnel concerned with vehs and it would be appreciated if steps can be taken to obtain a release for this number from Italian sources.
