2. DCS AFHQ states that there are now adequate stocks of seals - railway 5mm wire - in the country.
3. Standing Instructions to RTOs and Train Guard Staffs state that unsealed box cars will not be accepted for movement owing to the high rate of pilferage which is occurring. Orders are being issued that this will be strictly enforced in future.

- (c) All ventilators are secured.

Mackinaws were reported as having been shipped on the Kemp Battle, Salmon Chase, Highland Princess, The Apuania, and the Lt. Lawrence; while mackinaws are reported as having been received on the Salmon Chase, Highland Princess, and the Apuania only. This would indicate some misunderstanding at either Sardinia or Naples in regards to the ships upon which mackinaws were actually shipped and received. There is a possibility that some similar variations exist in respect to other items.

4. Will the MMLA LO Naples please make a further check of his records with the view of locating the substantial shortages and determine whether or not items were received in addition to those reported as per Appendix 'B' attached. Will the MMLA LO Sardinia also make a further check of his records, and furnish any supplementary information that will assist the MMLA LO Naples in locating the reported shortages.

1. In compliance with the provisions of ALIA cable AG 2473 dated 28 December 1944, the following will "explain why two hundred (200) tons of jute sacks were included in shipment" which left Cagliari on S.S. San Paugh, 24 December 1944:

a. Technical explanation as to advantage of such shipment from the standpoint of efficient loading is contained in detail in statement of Major G. F. Fossett, U.S., inclosed herewith.

b. Memorandum from 21/C dated 22 December 1944, paragraph 16 of which suggested that no further shipment of jute sacks is desired, was received here 24 December after loading was completed with exception of final deck load. It was inconceivable that the slow loading reported in my memorandum of 19 December should be further retarded by unloading the entire cargo.

c. No specific instructions have ever been issued to this office by ALIA (Main) as to just what items should be shipped. A general directive to "send everything" has been repeated verbally and in writing. The War Ministry has given no specific instructions to the Italian Headquarters here. In the absence of such directive, ships are loaded with what is available. Jute sacks have been stored locally and are at hand. Clothing and most other equipment, scattered in numerous depots all over the island, is being packed, hauled, or baled - largely by civilian labor of low efficiency - and is reaching Cagliari much more slowly than the availability of space on ships makes desirable. In some cases stores are being assembled from outlying points by carts. Every effort has been made to economize shipping space. Goods of all sorts have been loaded in vehicles and wedged in between, under, and over vehicles. Whether or not storage space is available in Naples for what is sent is not believed an acceptable criterion for selection of load at this end. The jute sacks belong to the War Ministry. If they should remain in Sardinia, we had not been so advised and the Italian command desired them on the mainland to use in various harvests, etc.

d. No effort has been observed to make possible an intelligent evacuation of materials from Sardinia. Instead of a ship being dispatched when a cargo is ready (as the result of a specific bid for actual space) this office has been subjected to a succession of transportation feasts and famines. As has been pointed out previously, a ship cannot be loaded here at the present rate of arrivals without loss of time. This is due partly to inadequate port facilities in both equipment and personnel and partly to slowness in the preparation and transportation to Cagliari of goods to be shipped. We could have loaded vehicles on ships with no other cargo, leaving gross tonnage to later ships but that practice received no consideration because of the waste of space involved.

e. Decisions as to loading have not been made, as has been implied, without due consideration to all factors involved. However, it is admitted freely that our aim has been to crowd everything available into any ship with open hatches rather than have partial loads dispatched.

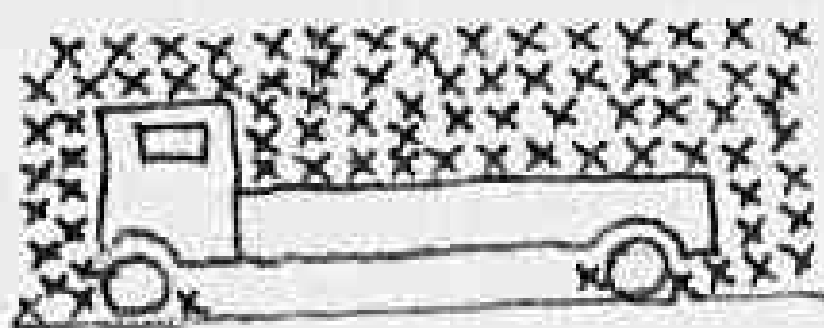

1. Reference cable AQ/2473, the 200 tons of jute sacks were loaded because it was necessary to have some material to load in and around the trucks. This was to protect them in case of movement due to scarcity of lashings. They were also used to level off the loading in the hold so that other items could be loaded on top. See sketch:



2. Dunnage was not available in port so bags were used as substitutes.
3. No items of clothing and equipment were available in Cagliari to be used instead of jute sacks.
4. All clothing and equipment that was ready, was loaded on ship, including that which arrived during the process of loading the ship.
5. Loading of jute sacks did not shut out a single item of clothing or equipment.

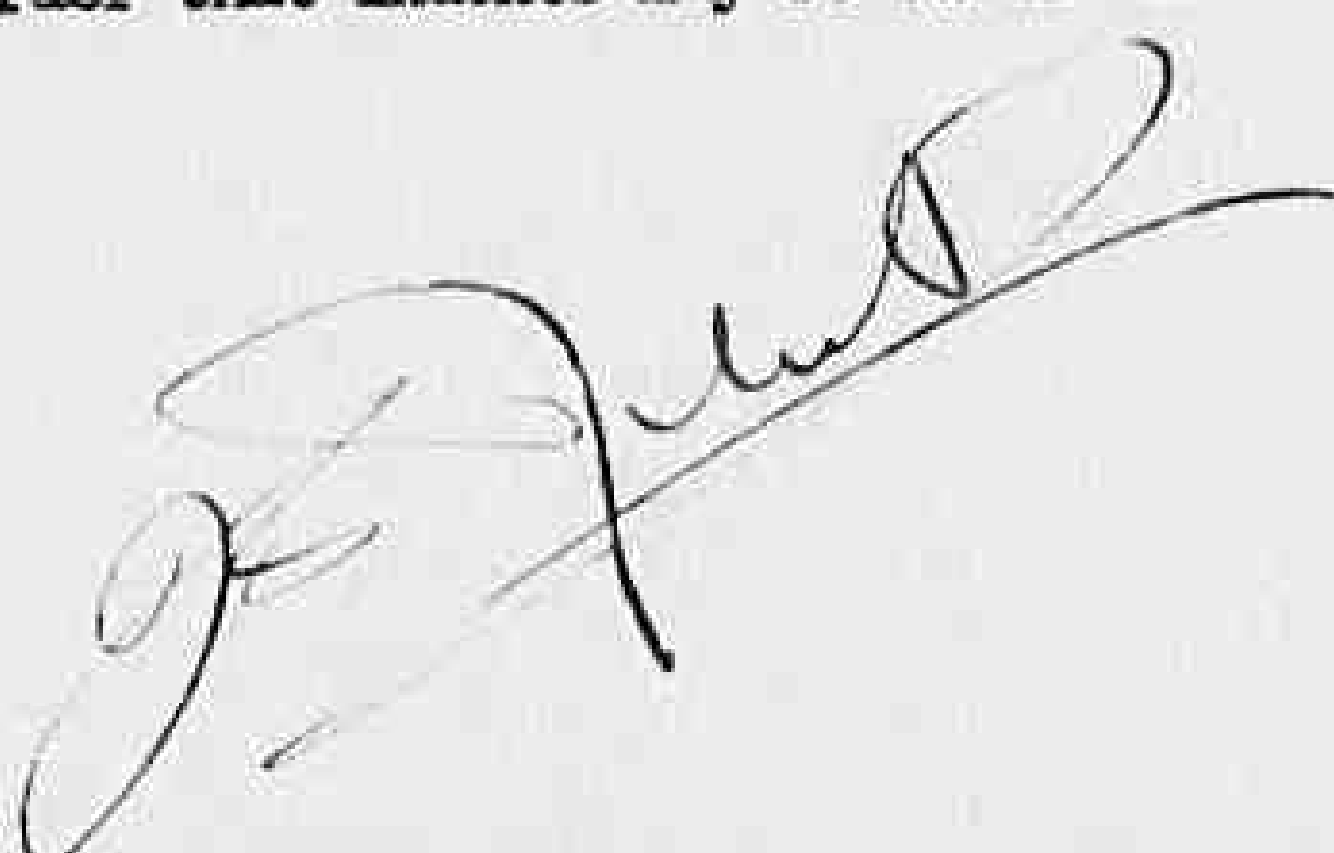
