4. SHIRTS

- (a) We are still trying to obtain shirts from the 10 groups of units for barracks. Shirts received through mail is not considered sufficient for them to have action on.
- (b) In the army area there is a lot of olive oil and nuts are not being issued in view of the "Alexander Incorporated" having been extended to 1 yr. I have explained that an additional 500 oil will make the difference between one and two hot meals daily and the subject is being re-opened.
- (c) With the arrival of 44 million units at 3 AM on 13 Mar. and the collection during the period of 4 PM to 400,000 from 1st Div by 2nd Div I think the situation during March for all troops here will be sound. 300 Div are now collecting from 6 AM and preparing to distribute to all concerned.
- (d) Local resources here are unable to help 1st Div to spend the daily 80 lire for improving the ration. Consequently only the shirts who benefit are those in the hills on Route 67 where a certain amount is available for small unit purchases.
