We have notified all the outlying H's of the repeated violations of existing regulations on the control of movement which are being committed by military en route to, or caught in the "Army Zone".

Each case has been carefully examined and the proper disciplinary measures have been taken against the culprits.

Since in spite of all the warnings and punishments given so far, these deplorable incidents continually repeat themselves, and this with an intensity which can be called unsettling, the problem will have to be faced from a different point of view.

The question- although it answers requirements of an understandable or rational nature- assumes also a moral and humane aspect which cannot be disregarded. It seems impossible to deny those who have their family living in now liberated territory to visit them or have news from them, after so many months of anxiousness and uncertainty.

With this in view NMIA- whose active and deep interest in all questions submitted by me I ~~shall~~ ~~know~~ appreciate- has stated verbally and unofficially through the L.O.'s the new directives which will be issued in this respect, and whose execution will, in some cases and for some units, such as for example the Combat Groups and the auxiliary units, allow access even to the Army Zone.

The application of such new ~~measures~~ and, in the meantime, the serious measures to be taken against violators, should bring about, in my opinion, a decrease, if not the end, of the deplorable inconvenience.

I shall thus appreciate it if I could have, as soon as possible, official confirmation of the s/m directives, so that they can be applied.

With reference MCLA letter AG/17, subject as above, dated 20 December 1944, signed (illegible) for DA. & CGS, you are advised that the delay in the demobilization of the three officers concerned has been due to the specific request of the undersigned at the instance of Major C. A. Hall. The subject officers are important members of the 13 Auto Parco and, at the date of the request (24 October 1944), were considered indispensable to the program being conducted by Major Hall. Upon the return of the latter, which is expected in a few days, the question will be reopened.

Under these conditions, and unless otherwise directed, the subject officers will be retained until the completion of vehicle reconditioning in current progress here.

2. In connection with the above, it is believed that this and other similar situations should be decided on the basis of immediate need and effect upon the progress of activities affected rather than by the application of a directive which implements a vengeful spirit against a former adherent of another political creed who is now most useful to the Allied effort.

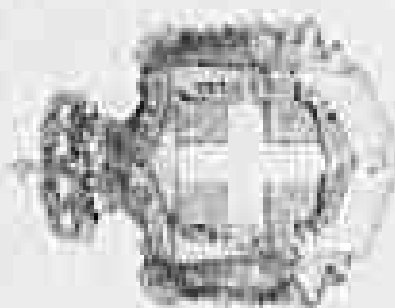

1. Certain difficulty has arisen in planning the movement of the troops to the port for embarkation on U.S. ABRAZZIA.

2. The Italian War Ministry is faced with the problem of moving men from all over Italy and Sicily to Naples with no knowledge if they will be shipped or, when they do get to Sardinia, if they will be shipped back to the mainland.

This will cause congestion at the ports and the absence of men from duty for extended periods.

3. It is therefore requested that, always subject to the requirements operational moves of allied troops, a firm allotment of places on the ABRAZZIA may be made to the Italian Military Authorities. As the capacity of the ABRAZZIA is some 250, it is suggested that the allotment be 50 as a start and subject to review when the system has worked for a period.

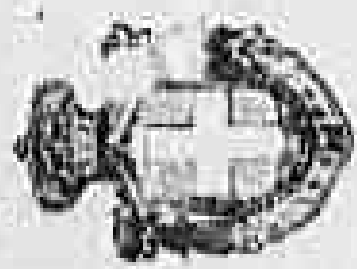

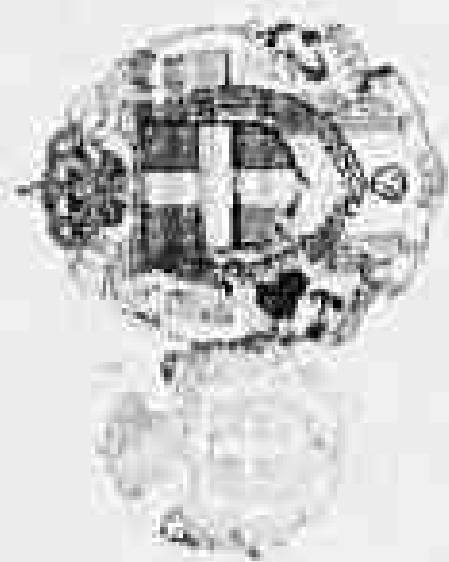

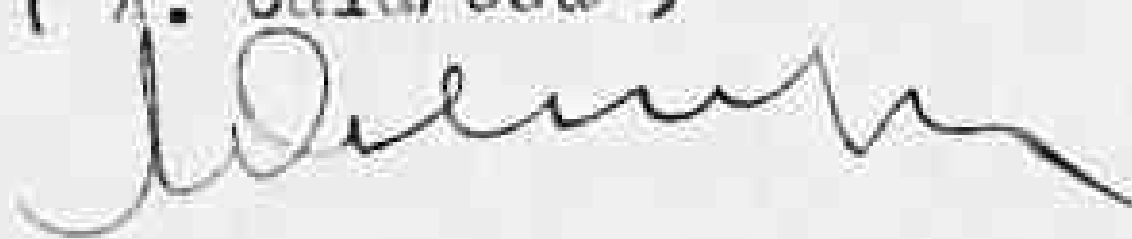

1. In accordance with AFHQ letter, File CR/3896/61 (Br) of 18 Sep 1944, instructions have been issued to the Italian Minister for War regarding leave of Italian personnel. Regular leave to Sardinia is not authorized. Compassionate leave, in such cases as are recommended by the Minister for War, is authorized. Such cases have been very few.

2. In order to control the difficult situation arising from attempts by Italian personnel to proceed to Sardinia without proper authority, including personnel traveling on duty, personnel are permitted to embark on Italian cruisers in Naples only when in possession of the necessary documents issued by the Allied Commission and MMIA. Likewise personnel are not allowed to land in Sardinia unless in possession of such documents. This is done for the reason that when such personnel desire to return to the mainland, the authorities in Sardinia must issue authority for these people to return on the cruisers. When space on the cruisers between Sardinia and Naples is given to persons on leave, just that much space is not available for personnel who should come to the mainland in accordance with the Allied program.

3. Attention is invited to attached document (Incl 1). The Italian officer concerned did not travel to Sardinia, inasmuch as his leave expired before he could embark on the cruiser. In view of this undated document, which could be easily forged, information is requested regarding the continuation of instructions which have been issued and are now in force and especially the proper authority to issue authorization to travel to Sardinia.

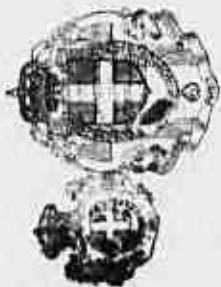

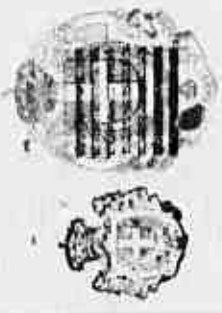
