MEMORANDUM FOR THE POLITICAL SECTION A.C.

Subject: Officers and men of the "Aqui" Division
fallen or dispersed in Greece.

The Ministry of War have interested the Land Forces Sub-Commission A.C. (M.M.I.A.) in the possibility of sending to the Islands of Cefalonia and Corfu an Italian Mission charged with recovering and giving adequate burial to the bodies of the soldiers of the "Aqui" Division.

This Division, which at the time of the armistice was in the Island of Cefalonia (Greece), refused to surrender to the Germans and from September 15th to September 22nd held out against overwhelming enemy forces until complete destruction.

A great number of officers and men of the Division were killed in action, the remainder decimated on large scale. A few managed to escape and joined the partisans on Greek soil.

The greater part of the bodies, according to reports of eyewitnesses, were piled up one over the other, spread with petrol and burnt; several others were left unburied for a long time and it has been therefore practically impossible, except in very few cases, to identify them.

In these conditions and bearing in mind the anxiety of thousands of families who have no news concerning the fate of their relatives, the Italian Authorities feel it their duty to give worthy burial to so many thousands of dead and to trace, where possible, the living.

The Land Forces Sub - Commission have been therefore wandy requested to authorize the sending of a special mission to Greece, interesting to this effect the representatives of the Greek Government on the Consultative Committee for Italy.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs beg the Allied Commission to support with the M.M.I.A. a favourable answer to this request.
