SUBJECT: Location of Grave of U. S. Airman

TO: CO, Land Forces Sub Commission (MMIA)

1. U. S. aircraft model P-38 (fighter plane with dual fuselage), serial number 42-13414, piloted by 2d Lt Ernest J. Westine, 0737915, 96 Fighter Squadron, 82d Fighter Group, about 1800 hours, 4 September 1943, was hit by anti-aircraft fire, burst into flames, and crashed in the vicinity of Grazzanise, Italy (coordinates NO85768, sheet 172, Italy 1/100,000).

2. Information received from Caiazza Mauro, the caretaker of the Villa Litterno Civilian Cemetery, is that an American airman, believed to be the pilot of the plane described above, was interred in the cemetery during his absence, in an unmarked grave of unknown location. An Italian Military Chaplain is said to have officiated at the burial. The chaplain in question (name unknown) is believed to have been Sicilian and presently in Sicily. U. S. graves registration service is desirous of removing the remains to a U. S. military cemetery, but efforts to locate the grave have failed.

3. It is requested that the Italian military chaplain who officiated at the burial be located if possible and be requested to furnish whatever information he can as to location of the grave. If pertinent information bearing upon the burial is available from any other source, it is requested it be furnished this headquarters.

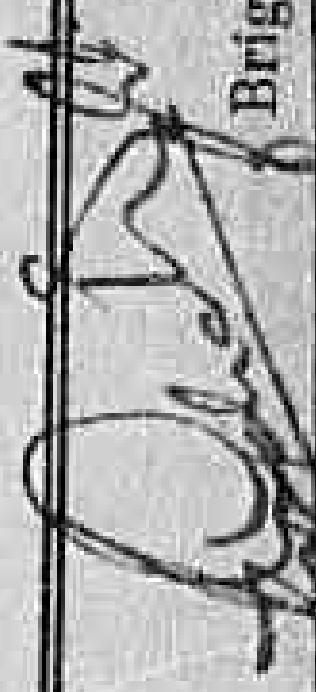

On December 5th, the British Embassy verbally informed this Ministry that the English mil. who have died during the war are buried in temporary cemeteries and expressed its desire to start negotiating for the definite disposal of the question, on the basis of directives of the Inter-government agreement reached in regard to this matter after the last World War and signed in 1922.

As a temporary solution, owing to the urgency of the matter, the British Embassy would appreciate the immediate issuing of a decree similar to the one which was issued 4143) under the same circumstances on July 11, 1918.

Enclosed herewith copies of the needed information, the decree, and the agreement in question. Please study

Enclosed herewith copies of the neutral information, the decree, and the agreement in question. Please study urgently - in harmony with the Ministries concerned - the best way to meet the request of the British Embassy and to arrange the necessary legislation, in the meantime contacting the Imperial War Graves Commission in order to start negotiating, with the aim of reaching a definite agreement on the question.

With a separate letter the Ministry has assured the British Embassy of having asked the Min. of War to contact the Imperial War Graves Commission for the rapid definition of the question and has also expressed an opinion on the suggestion of the immediate issuing of a regulation similar to the one contained in the decree in question.

Please keep this Ministry informed of further developments in regard to this matter which we would appreciate being treated as urgent.
